## ST. MARY'S CATHOLIC CHURCH, BRENHAM, TEXAS BAPTISM

All the paperwork listed below must be turned in to the office at least one week before Baptism.

#### **PARENTS**

- 1. At least one parent must be Catholic, they must attend Mass regularly and be willing to raise the child Catholic.
- 2. If the parent(s) are registered in another parish, a letter from the Pastor is required, stating that you have permission to have your child baptized here, at St. Mary's.
- 3. Parents need to attend a baptism preparation class. Those who attend class in a different parish must provide a certificate or letter from the Pastor stating the date and place where the class was taken.
- 4. A copy of the child's birth certificate from the county is required.
- 5. At our Parish, your Baptism Class must have been taken within the last 12 months.
- 6. A \$25 donation is requested to cover materials and classes.

### **GODPARENTS**

Being a Godparent is a religious responsibility.

- Godparent(s) must be at least 16 years old; practicing Catholic(s) and have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Communion, and Confirmation. A copy of each Sacrament certificate or a current Baptism certificate with sacraments listen on the back is required.
- 2. If married, must have been married in the Catholic Church and the Sacrament certificate from the church is required. If you have children you must be raising them in the Catholic faith.
- 3. Catholics either married outside the Church or living together are not qualified to be Godparents.
- 4. Godparents need to attend a baptism preparation class. Those who attend class in a different parish must provide a certificate or letter from the Pastor stating the date and place where the class was taken.
- 5. At our Parish, your Baptism Class must have been taken within the last 12 months.
- 6. A non-Catholic may serve as a witness along with a qualified Catholic Godparent. This witness must be a baptized Christian and must complete and sign the Baptism Godparent Covenant.
- 7. Only one Godparent is required, however, if there are two, one must be male, the other female.
- 8. Each Godparent must fill out and sign the Baptism Godparent Covenant.

Baptism preparation class is held monthly in both English and Spanish. The class will explain the gifts of the Sacrament of Baptism and the obligations assumed by the parents and Godparents. English classes are held on the third Tuesday of the month at The Cornerstone Conference Room at 6:30 p.m. Spanish classes are held on the third Tuesday of the month at the Education Building AV room at 7:00 p.m.

The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated the first Saturday of each month. English Baptisms are at 10:00 a.m. and Spanish Baptisms are at 11:00 a.m.

### **BAPTISM GODPARENT COVENANT**

As a Baptism Godparent, your role is to encourage the faith of your Godchild, to be a positive role model to them and to reflect with them as they grow, on the meaning of a full Catholic life.

The Code of Canon Law (Church Law) specifies the requirements for serving as godparents at Baptism (Canon 874): You may not be the parent of the person being baptized; you must be at least 16 years old; you must be fully initiated (Baptism, Communion and Confirmation); if married, be in a valid Catholic marriage; and live a life of active faith in the Catholic Church. You must also provide the certificates of your Sacraments.
