

The main entrance to the church of St. Mary, Immaculate Conception has been ceremonially and physically sealed until the Jubilee Mass celebrating the 150th anniversary of our church on November 19, 2020 at 6:00 p.m., when Bishop Joe Vasquez will officially open the doors to the church and to our Year of Jubilee.

On the occasion of the celebration of the 150 years of our parish, and in unity with our bishop, we asked the Holy See to grant us the grace of having a jubilee year with the possibility of acquiring plenary indulgences every day; the Holy See responded favorably and granted us its blessing. As part of the rite, the door that will be consecrated as a holy door or pilgrimage door must be sealed. This was carried out on Sunday, November 1, Solemnity of All Saints, and will be solemnly opened on November 19 in a Mass presided over by our bishop.

A **holy door**, or **porta sancta**, has been used since the fifteenth century as a ritual expression of conversion. Pilgrims and penitents pass through it as a gesture of leaving the past behind and "crossing the threshold" from sin to grace, from slavery to freedom, and from darkness to light.



Often these rituals are associated with prayer, pilgrimage, sacrifice, confession, and indulgences. But a holy door finds meaning only when the believer associates the door with Christ.


Jesus is the Door!

In the words of Pope Francis, "There is only one way that opens wide the entrance into the life of communion with God: this is Jesus, the one and absolute way to salvation. To Him alone can the words of the Psalmist be applied in full truth: 'This is the door of the Lord where the just may enter' (Psalms 118:20)"

The doors will open on November 19

Let it be a reminder to all who pass through that Jesus is the way to salvation. Let it serve as a symbol of God's everlasting mercy and His constant invitation to us to return home to Him.
