And we, do we use logic?

This Sunday's gospel reminded me of a little story I heard in the seminary, full of fiction or maybe not so much, but very much in tune with the feelings that Jesus aroused in his parable to his contemporaries. In a monastery, where the religious community grew and with it the people who came to ask for help at the doors. One summer day, the Abbot, father superior of the religious community, asks all the monks who had taken all the potatoes from the garden. A monk responds that it was he who gave them to a group of pilgrims who were requesting food. The abbot responded: "brother, be considerate of the community, use logic, we no longer have potatoes to eat." Days later, all the eggs that had recently been collected from the chicken coop disappear from the kitchen. The Abbot summoned all the brothers to question them again, to which he discovered that whom had been was the same brother who had now given the eggs to other poor people who approached the monastery to ask for help. The Abbot, a little irritated by the situation that was repeated several times, replied: "brother, use logic, now you have left our breakfast without eggs due to your actions, use logic." A few days later a strong storm comes and with it unexpected cold. In the monastery all the blankets in the storeroom had disappeared. The Abbot once again summons all the brothers and interrogates them again. Upon discovering that it had once again been the same brother who had given it to a group of poor people who had nothing to protect themselves from the weather, the Abbot responded with great irritation: "Use logic! Now we have nothing to cover ourselves with and we will be cold, all because you have not used logic and have given away the blankets we had." To which the small and young brother answers Father Abbot: "Reverend Father, why don't you use logic, what do you expect me to do? If every day you preach to us in the chapel about the importance of helping the poor, loving the needy and sharing our goods. I have only done what you ask us to do, and now you rebuke me for having lived the gospel, father, please use logic."



This world is not going to change because of our opinions, but because of our actions. Living the Gospel does not mean just understanding it, listening to it or preaching it... living the gospel is putting it into action, into work. Good heavenly Father, help us live the gospel in our lives.

¿y nosotros, empleamos la lógica?

El evangelio de este domingo me hizo recordar un pequeño cuento que escuchaba en el seminario, lleno de ficción o quizás no tanto, pero muy en sintonía con los sentimientos que Jesús suscito en su parábola a sus contemporáneos. En un monasterio, donde la comunidad religiosa crecía y con ello la gente que acudía a pedir ayuda a las puertas.

Un día de verano, el Abad, padre superior de la comunidad religiosa, pregunta a todos los monjes quien avía tomado todas las papas del huerto. Un monje responde que fue él, quien se las dio a un grupo de peregrinos que solicitaban comida. El abad le respondió: "hermano, tenga consideración con la comunidad, use la lógica, ya no tenemos nosotros papas para comer". Días después desaparecen de la cocina todos los huevos que recientemente habían sido recogidos del gallinero. El Abad volvió a convocar a todos los hermanos para interrogarlos de nuevo, a lo que descubrió que había sido el mismo hermano que ahora había regalado los huevos a otros pobres que se acercaron al monasterio a pedir ayuda. El Abad un poco irritado por la situación que se repetía ya varias veces le contesto: "hermano, use la lógica, ahora nos ha dejado el desayuno sin huevo por sus acciones, use la lógica". Pocos días después viene una fuerte tormenta y con ellos un frío inesperado. En el monasterio habían desaparecido todas las cobijas del almacén. El Abad nuevamente vuelve a convocar a todos los hermanos y los interroga nuevamente. Al descubrir que había sido nuevamente el mismo hermano quien se lo había dado a un grupo de pobres que no tenían con que protegerse del clima el Abad le respondió con mucha irritación: "!Use la lógica! Ahora nosotros no tenemos con que cobijarnos y pasaremos frío, todo porque usted no ha usado la lógica y ha regalado las frazadas que teníamos." A lo que el pequeño y joven hermano le contesta al padre Abad: "Reverendo padre, por qué mejor no usa usted la lógica, ¿qué espera que yo haga? si todos los días usted nos predica en la capilla sobre la importancia de ayudar al pobre, de amar al necesitado y de compartir nuestros bienes. Yo solo he hecho lo que usted nos pide que ágamos, y ahora me reprende por haber vivido el evangelio, padre, por favor use usted la lógica".

Este mundo no va a cambiar por nuestras opiniones, sino por nuestras acciones. El vivir el Evangelio, no significa el solo entenderlo, escucharlo o predicarlo... vivir el evangelio es ponerlo en acción, en obra. Buen Padre celestial ayúdanos a vivir el evangelio en nuestra vida.

Ethics & Integrity in Ministry (EIM)

Preventing Abuse and Providing Healing

Bishop Joe S. Vásquez and the Diocese of Austin are committed to the prevention of the harm of any of God's People and to supporting those who have experienced abuse. Go to www.austindiocese.org/eim to learn about reporting requirements and procedures if you know or have reasonable cause to believe that abuse of a minor, elderly adult, or adult with a disability has occurred, or if you have concerns about other unethical behavior by Church personnel or volunteers.

Compliance with diocesan EIM policies is required of all clergy, consecrated sisters and brothers, seminarians, employees, and adult lay volunteers serving in ministries.

To be compliant, one must have an account with VIRTUS.org, attend an initial live training, complete the online refresher training every three years thereafter, and consent to a background check every three years.

The more people in our diocese who are trained to spot and report abuse and inappropriate behavior, the safer our parishes, schools, and communities will be for children and vulnerable adults.



HOW DO I KNOW GOD IS CALLING ME?

If you have ever thought about being a priest, these qualities may be clues to a future priestly vocation:

1. GOD HAS PLACED IN YOUR HEART A DESIRE TO BE A PRIEST.

If Jesus has placed a desire in your heart for the priesthood, *no matter what your age*, don't ignore it.

Talk to a priest you admire about how you feel.

2. YOU HAVE A DEEP LOVE FOR CHRIST AND HIS CHURCH.

A priest functions *in persona Christi capitatis*—in the person of Christ, head of the Church. Thus a man who wants to be a priest must love Jesus Christ above all else. And like Jesus, he should have a deep love for the Church, the Bride of Christ.

In general, a man who wants to be a priest will find himself drawn to Church teachings and “all things Catholic.”

3. OTHER PEOPLE HAVE MENTIONED THAT YOU WOULD BE A GOOD PRIEST.

Often other people will notice a “priest’s heart” in a young man and say to him, “Have you ever thought about being a priest? I think you’d make a good one.”

In fact, many men report that they grew tired of people making such comments—but that the encouragement eventually led them to seminary!

4. YOU DESIRE TO LIVE A LIFE OF VIRTUE AND PRAYER.

Pope Benedict recently spoke about what people expect of their priests. To paraphrase, he said that people do not expect priests to be experts in anything but the spiritual life. Thus, a good candidate for the priesthood attends Mass, prays frequently, receives the sacrament of Confession, serves others, and strives to grow spiritually.

5. YOU WANT TO HELP OTHERS GROW CLOSER TO CHRIST.

A priest brings Jesus to people and people to Jesus. For this reason, a man who wants to be a priest must have a deep concern for the people of God.

He wants to help them grow in holiness; he wants to teach them the truths of the faith; he wants to minister to them during the trials of life.

The vocation of priesthood is about leading others to heaven.

As I was at home recovering, I spent time writing the Deacon Corner for the month of July and I received quite a few comments about the subject of "Planning my funeral." And I appreciate that those of you who are wanting to put this into action, you did not want to bother me while I have been recuperating. I am very thankful for your consideration.

Well – **I AM BACK.** I am now able, along with Deacon John and Deacon Steve, to help you to pre-plan for your funeral Service. To pre-plan allows your family to focus on healing, not stressful logistics. It relieves doubt by allowing family members to know exactly what the funeral or disposition should include, leaving no room for doubt. To pre-plan provides more time for love, support, and gathering. Eliminating the time and stress of decision making allows your loved ones to fully focus on the support and shared memories of loving family and friends. If you are sitting on the fence or a little hesitant, I have included these very easy instructions.

Your parish, St. Mary Immaculate Conception, is here for you to help you pre-plan your journey home by providing, not only help at the office, but also by using our website at <https://brenhamcatholic.org/>. On the front page of the website is a tab that says "Funeral" and this tab leads you to a page that will help you to choose your scripture readings and hymns. We have also provided a form for you to fill in with your information to be saved by you and to send to us for safe keeping. After we receive your information, we will call you to gather other pertinent information. And of course, we can also meet with you in person to help you to prepare your wishes.

All of this will create a "Peace of Mind"


