Our Mission

It is not difficult to know what our mission is, since it is the very mission of the Church. This mission is expressed in Sacred Scripture, especially in the Gospels.

“Jesus approached them and spoke thus: “All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go, then, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit and teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you all the days until the end of the world” (MT 28: 18-20).

This mission entrusted directly to the Apostles, today to the Bishops, extends to all baptized people. What we have received, we have to announce. Since I became aware of my being a Christian, I have assumed this task as my own. I have embraced it even more closely since being ordained a priest, and I rejoice that my bishop, Bishop Joe Vázquez, has directly entrusted to me this same ministry to be performed here in our parish.

That is why I state the mission this way:

“In unity with our Diocesan Church of Austin, following the

guidelines issued by our bishop, we seek to **EVANGELIZE, MAKE DISCIPLES, and FORM THE CHRISTIAN COMMUNITY.**”

EVANGELIZATION seeks to provoke the encounter with a God lived and real, through the basic preaching of the Kerygma (Greek for “proclamation” and refers to the Gospel) and prayer. This will take place through initiatives of the pastoral groups and others in the parish.

MAKING DISCIPLES is, undoubtedly, the most difficult task, since it consists in making Jesus the teacher in our lives and learning from Him how to live His teaching faithfully in every area of our life. This we will aim for through a continuous catechesis. The parish seeks to be a place of growth in faith.

FORM THE CHRISTIAN COMMUNITY This goal is the natural fruit of living a personal encounter with God and seeking His kingdom in our lives. We cannot live our faith alone. Rather, we need a community where we can share our experiences and nourish ourselves with the testimony of other brothers and sisters in Christ. St. Mary Immaculate Concepción wants to be a place where faith is lived. We intentionally live this way in the Liturgical assembly, in the ministry and service groups and in our own moments of coexistence and spirituality, koinonia (Christian fellowship or communion) and mystagogy (led through the mysteries of faith).

We are a church on the move that is renewed in the love of God and guided by the prompting of the Holy Spirit.

Nuestra Misión

St. Mary Immaculate Concepción quiere ser un lugar donde se viva la fe. DE manera intencional esto lo vivimos en la asamblea Litúrgica, en los grupos de Apostolado y servicio y en los momentos propios de convivencia y espiritualidad, **KOINONIA Y MISTAGOGIA.**

As Jesus said, "So that they may all be one. Like you, Father, in me and I in you, may they also be one in us, so that the world may believe that you have sent me" (John, 17, 20).

THANKFULNESS. We are able to recognize and be grateful in all circumstances for the blessings that God gives us.

"In all circumstances give thanks, for this is the will of God for you in Christ Jesus." 1 Thessalonians 5:18

HUMILITY. This virtue enables us to acknowledge the gifts we have received from God and to use them for Him with prudential judgment.

"Do nothing out of rivalry, or out of vainglory, but with humility, each considering the others as superior to himself, each seeking not his own interest but that of others" (Philippians 2:3-4).

FAITH. The gift we have received from God through the Church to be exercised in our lives through good works.

"For you have been saved by grace through faith; and this does not come from you, but is a gift of God; it does not come from works, so that no one can boast. Indeed, we are his workmanship: created in Christ Jesus, in order for the good works that God ordained beforehand that we are to practice" (Ephesians 2:8-10).

SUSTAINABILITY. Protect and grow the legacy handed down to us and pass that legacy on to our children.

"So that neither the one who plants is something, nor the one who waters, but God who makes it grow. And the one who plants and the one who waters are the same thing; although each one will receive the salary according to his own work, since we are God's co-workers and you, God's field, God's edification. According to the grace of God that was given me, I, as a good architect, laid the foundation, and someone else builds on it. Look how each one builds!" (1 Corinthians 3:7-10).

SPIRITUALITY. We recognize that without Him we are nothing, and that with Him we can witness even miracles in our lives and in our community.

"Abide in me, as I in you. Just as the branch cannot bear fruit by itself, if it does not remain in the vine; so neither can you if you do not remain in me" (John, 15:4).

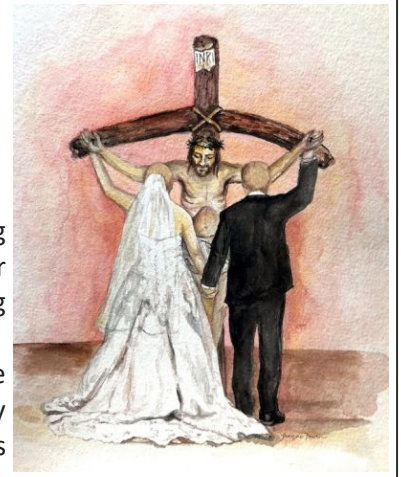

DEACON'S CORNER

The Prenup

A good friend told me her daughter was about to be married, and then started asking about prenuptial agreements. Prenups are sometimes useful. If a couple are marrying later in life and have a lot of assets, prenups can be used to protect the interests of the existing children on the death of one or more of the spouses. But any prenup intended to predetermine actions in the event of divorce are a clear indication that one or both of the parties are not fully committed to the union; that they don't really mean it when they say "as long as we both shall live". So I was quite surprised when my friend said the groom's family was insisting on a prenup.



I pointed out that since they were both young, had no prior children, and this was the first marriage for both, a prenup was a very bad idea and asked why the family was insisting. I was told he was a trust fund baby and the family had a lot of money and they wanted to protect him in case things didn't work out.

So I told my friend that if he didn't trust her not to leave him, he shouldn't marry her; and if he wasn't sure he wasn't going to leave, she shouldn't marry him. And that if the family really wanted to help ensure his happiness, they should cut him off without a cent before the marriage.

That way he would be secure in her devotion; that she would marry him even if he wasn't rich. She would be secure in his devotion by his sacrifice for her. And they could learn to depend upon each other instead of a trust fund. After all, his joy and happiness in life will depend far more upon a good marriage than upon any amount of money.

El acuerdo prenupcial

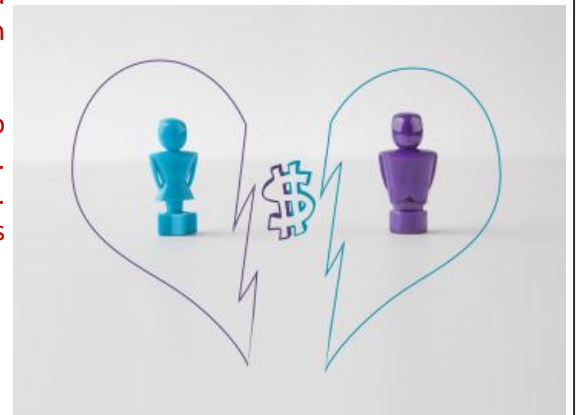

Entonces le dije a mi amigo que si no confiaba en que ella no lo dejaría, no debería casarse con ella; y si el no estaba seguro de que no iba a irse, ella no debería casarse con él. Y que si la familia realmente quisiera ayudar a garantizar su felicidad, deberían cortarlo sin un centavo antes del matrimonio.

De esa manera estaría seguro de su devoción; que se casaría con él incluso si no fuera rico. Ella estaría segura en su devoción por su sacrificio por ella. Y podrían aprender a depender uno de otro en lugar de un fondo fiduciario. Después de todo, su alegría y felicidad en la vida dependerán mucho más de un buen matrimonio que de cualquier cantidad de dinero.
