



They immediately left their nets and followed him.

Today when I think of Jesus as that poor man from Nazareth, especially in his first months of public ministry, who without even performing miracles was capable of captivating so many people. I myself am captivated with how Christ, with just a single invitation to his disciples, drew all these men to leave everything and follow him... what was it about that man from Nazareth that captivated them? Could it be his fresh and revolutionized message of love? Would it be his insurmountable gestures of mercy? Would it be his song of freedom? Could it be his poetic message of love that inspired people to lay down their weapons...? Could it be his relationship with God that was so personal that he invited everyone to relate to God as their own father...? Could it be that his heart burned with one purpose and one direction, to love everyone? Could it be that that sigh of utopia was loaded with reality that beautified souls just by hearing this good news, of a better world, of a family restored with a forgiven heart...



WHO WAS THIS MAN... that so many followed him...?





But you know something, that man from Nazareth who raised so many feelings and expectations, so many opinions and confrontations with his poetic message of love, has transcended so much that even today he continues to make so many people fall in love with him. Many are still able to leave everything and follow Him, just like two thousand years ago. Today there are still people who testify that their lives have radically changed by having an encounter with him, by accepting his message of love. Today he is still the same as he was two thousand years ago. Today he continues to captivate with the same message that does not go out of style because it is a divine word. Today more than ever, in a society full of darkness of bitterness and emptiness, of vanities and superficialities, today more than ever, we need to meet that gaze of love, listen to that message and respond to the invitation: "Follow me." Today we need people with high purposes and such clear goals, with fire in their hearts that they are capable of influencing others with the best adventure known to man, building the Kingdom of God among us, a message of pure love and forgiveness that continues renewing those who receive it. It is embracing the project of God made man, the best project that has ever existed and the one that will never be surpassed: Following the lamb.

Hoy necesitamos personas con propósitos elevados y metas tan claras, con fuego en el corazón que sean capaces de influir en los demás con la mejor aventura conocida por el hombre, construir el Reino de Dios entre nosotros, un mensaje de amor puro y perdón que se siga renovando a quienes lo reciben. Es abrazar el proyecto de Dios hecho hombre, el mejor proyecto que jamás ha existido y el que jamás será superado: Seguir al Cordero.

Countless people have expressed to me, their appreciation of the beauty of our Parish.

Many appreciate the spirituality and solemnity with which we celebrate our faith. This is a very clear sign of our faith and commitment.

Quality is in the details, and it is the small details that make the biggest difference.

We have been busy maintaining the entire campus, but I want at this time to mention just a few of the projects we have worked on, just in our temple. When I arrived, the first thing I noticed was the urgent need to change the Altar Linens. I greatly appreciate the support of PCCW in making that possible.

One by one all the liturgical books were changed.

We also replaced the cables in the sound system several times due to the rats chewing on them.

Finally, we were able to protect them by installing conduit. This was a large investment but well worth the effort.


Our Tabernacle, a piece of art which is an important part of our history, was refurbished and repaired and remains a living statement of who we are as a Catholic community.

The base of the Paschal Easter candle was also polished and resumes its proper dignity .

The liturgical season drapes behind the Altar, and decorations that beautify our church were also added, along with lights to the presbytery to enhance our live streaming.

Three years ago, the steps at the entrance of the church were changed due to the badly damaged tiles from the ice storm. I am so grateful to those who donated to this job, especially Kenjura Tile and their dedicated workers.

Other changes were undertaken, such as the windows in the confessionals, the maintenance of the sound equipment and the bell tower, repairing the plaster on one of the walls, new camera and equipment for our growing live streaming, along with countless







There are many needs remaining, but since my arrival, in my mind and in my heart, I have recognized the need to replace the vestments used to celebrate the Holy Mass and all the other sacraments we celebrate. These vestments are a testament of our love and devotion to our Lord and Savior.

The vestments that I use at mass are my own, they are my personal property. You may remember, Fr. Joven and Father Enrique used their own vestments too. On some occasions I have seen priests who celebrate Mass here a second time, often bring their own vestments. When was the last time we bought vestments for our celebrations? No one knows for sure.

I believe it is time for our parish to have its own vestments, worthy of the celebration of the faith we profess.

Here is a photo of the stole that was used for years in the confessional. At a recent penitential service, the priest who was in the confessional made a comment to me with great charity, and with great reason. "Can this community not have more worthy vestments?"

I know that we have many expenses, but our liturgical celebration has to be a priority.



Below, I present an example of the vestments that I have chosen for our Parish. They are simple yet dignified. They are what we need, and I invite you to put this intention in your heart, and help me to pray and ask God for benefactors, so that we can cover these expenses quickly. 


