



It is such an appropriate time that on the Second Sunday of Lent we meditate on the transfiguration. Both on Ash Wednesday and the first Sunday of Lent we focus to meditate on penance, fasting, prayer, and even on sin. But we must not lose sight of the intention of all of this, that is why it is an opportune time to meditate on the transfiguration which helps us to remember the goal and objective of all Lenten practices. You will hear me repeatedly say during Lent that the most important thing about this time of Lent is Easter! If we lose sight of Easter, it is possible that our Lenten practices become empty actions that, instead of helping, can distract us on the path of conversion, on the path of improvement.

Returning to the gospel, Jesus is transfigured, that is, he reveals his divine aspect, his transcendental aspect, his majesty... and in just that single word "transfiguration" we have an entire catechesis that it is important to meditate on, especially during Lent. It is necessary to understand the meaning of some simple words that will help us grasp the meaning of being transfigured. These words are: Figure,

disfigurement, configuration and transfiguration.

Figure is the way something is designed. We usually say, it has a figure of... Well, in the beginning we had a very clear figure, we were made in the image and likeness of God. We could say that our figure was very good, but unfortunately, sin caused us to become disfigured. That is the second word, disfigurement. We have to understand that sin not only stops God's plan in our lives, but also disfigures us, it causes us to lose brotherhood, it makes us become closed, be more selfish... But in Christ Jesus everything does not end here. Through him and his word we can configure ourselves. The word configure means to make ourselves in the shape of, as if we were molding ourselves according to a model. In computer science language, "configure" is the action of programming the equipment in a desired way, so that it works as expected. Well, for us, the action of configuring ourselves is to imitate Jesus, it is to seek the will of God in our lives, it is to try to recover the original plan, so that one day in Jesus we can be transfigured in him. May he be everything in us.

Many of the holy fathers see in the image of Moses and Elijah, who talk with Jesus, the necessary elements to understand the cross and through it to achieve victory. Moses represents the law, the Word of God. We cannot expect a configuration with Jesus if we ignore the Word of God and his commandments; these are of utmost importance for our life and growth. Elijah represents the prophetic and charismatic action. Nor can we expect a configuration with Jesus, ignoring prayer and the openness to the spiritual life in us. Without this openness the Word of God would be a harsh and heavy law, which would not be understood and would only serve to condemn. In the same way, if we only focus on a spiritual life, ignoring the Word of God and his law, it would just be sentimentalism that would not coincide with anything. Both elements are necessary to grow spiritually and as people. The Word of God and prayer. They are like two wings that help us take flight.

# Figura, desfiguración, configuración y transfiguración

Es muy oportuno que el Segundo domingo de cuaresma meditemos en la transfiguración. Tanto el miércoles de ceniza como el primer domingo de cuaresma nos enfocamos a meditar en la penitencia, ayuno, oración, e incluso hasta en el pecado. Pero no debemos de perder de vista cual es la intención de todo esto, por eso es que es muy oportuno meditar en la transfiguración que nos ayuda a recordar la meta y objetivo de todas las practicas cuaresmales.

Me vas a escuchar decir muchas veces durante este tiempo de cuaresma, que lo más importante de la cuaresma es ¡la Pascua! Y es que, si perdemos de vista la Pascua, es posible que nuestras prácticas cuaresmales se conviertan en acciones vacías que en lugar de ayudar pueden distraernos en el camino de la conversión, en el camino de mejorar.

Volviendo al evangelio, Jesús se transfigura, es decir, deja ver su aspecto divino, su aspecto trascendental, su majestad... y en la sola palabra "transfiguración" tenemos toda una catequesis que es importante meditar, especialmente en este tiempo de cuaresma, para ello es necesario entender el significado de algunas palabras sencillas que nos ayudaran a captar el significado de transfigurarse. Estas son: Figura, desfiguración, configuración y transfiguración.

Figura, es la forma en como algo está diseñado. Solemos decir, tiene figura de... Pues bien, al principio nosotros teníamos una figura muy clara, fuimos hechos a imagen y semejanza de Dios. Pudiéramos decir que nuestra figura era muy buena, pero lamentablemente el pecado hizo que nos desfiguramos. Y aquí está la segunda palabra, desfiguración. Tenemos que entender que el pecado, no sólo detiene el plan de Dios en nuestra vida, sino que también nos desfigura, hace que perdamos la fraternidad, que seamos más cerrados, más egoístas... Pero en Cristo Jesús aquí no termina todo. A través de él y de su palabra nosotros podemos configurarnos. La palabra configurar significa hacernos a la figura de, como si nos moldeáramos de acuerdo a un modelo. En un lenguaje de informática, se dice "configurar" a la acción de programar el equipo de una manera deseada, para que funcione según lo esperado. Pues para nosotros la acción de configurarnos es imitar a Jesús, es buscar la voluntad de Dios en nuestra vida, es tratar de recuperar el plan original, para que un día podamos nosotros en Jesús ser transfigurados en él. Que El sea todo en nosotros.

Muchos de los santos padres ven en la imagen de Moisés y Elías que platican con Jesús, los elementos necesarios para entender la cruz y

atrás de ella llegar a la victoria. Moisés representa la ley, la Palabra de Dios, no podemos pretender una configuración con Jesús si ignoramos la Palabra de Dios y sus mandamientos, estos son de suma importancia para nuestra vida y crecimiento. Elías representa la acción profética y carismática, tampoco podemos pretender una configuración con Jesús ignorando la oración y la apertura a la vida espiritual en nosotros, sin esta apertura la Palabra de Dios sería una ley ruda y pesada, que no se entendería y solo serviría para condenar. De igual manera si sólo nos enfocamos en una vida espiritual ignorando la Palabra de Dios y su ley, sería sólo un sentimentalismo que no nos conduciría a nada. Ambos elementos son necesarios para crecer espiritualmente y como personas. La Palabra de Dios y la oración. Son como dos alas que nos ayudan a elevar el vuelo.



# Deacon's Corner

YOUR FAITH  
HAS SAVED YOU;  
*go in peace.*

What was the point of God asking Abraham to sacrifice his son Issac? Was God putting Abraham through this excruciating test just to find out if he was faithful?

Is the message that murder is ok if it's God doing it, or if it's being done on his orders? No, the God of the Old Testament is always shown to be a God of Justice. We worship Him not because He is powerful, but because He is good. God didn't need to learn anything about Abraham, he already knew how strong his faith was. It was something that Abraham needed to understand about himself that God was teaching.

This story also made it clear that God didn't desire human sacrifice. Many people in the world would sacrifice their children to pagan gods. God was teaching through this test that animal sacrifice was acceptable, but human sacrifice was not. Humans were different and important to God and were not to be sacrificed. In the Jewish tradition the Ram that was provided by God was the precursor for the lambs that would be used for the Passover Feast. In the Christian tradition, the Ram provided by God was the foreshadowing of God's sacrifice of his only son for our salvation. But the main point of the reading is about the importance of faith; this cardinal virtue that has the power to save us.

God doesn't need to test us to know our faith. It's we who need to understand if our faith is strong or if it is lacking. How strong is your faith? How well have you held to your Lenten promises? How far are you prepared to go in serving God? In the Gospels, we hear many times Jesus saying to someone: "Go in peace, your faith has saved you." Would He say that to you right now? Why don't you spend some time in prayer and ask Him.

## Dios y Abraham


¿Cuál fue el punto de que Dios le pidiera a Abraham que sacrificara a su hijo Isaac?


¿Estaba Dios poniendo a Abraham esta prueba insoportable sólo para descubrir si era fiel? ¿Está bien el mensaje de que el asesinato está bien si es Dios quien lo hace o si se hace por orden suya? No, el Dios del Antiguo Testamento siempre se muestra como un Dios de Justicia. Lo adoramos no porque sea poderoso, sino porque es bueno. Dios no necesitaba aprender nada acerca de Abraham, él ya sabía cuán fuerte era su fe. Era algo que Abraham necesitaba entender acerca de sí mismo, que Dios le estaba enseñando.

Esta historia también dejó claro que Dios no deseaba sacrificios humanos. Mucha gente en el mundo sacrificaba sus hijos a dioses paganos. Dios estaba enseñando a través de esta prueba que el sacrificio de animales era aceptable, pero el sacrificio humano no lo era. Los humanos eran diferentes e importantes para Dios y no debían ser sacrificados. En la tradición judía, el carnero provisto por Dios era el precursor de los corderos que se utilizarían para la Fiesta de la Pascua. En la tradición cristiana, el carnero proporcionado por Dios era el presagio del sacrificio de Dios de su único hijo para nuestra salvación. Pero el punto principal de la lectura es la importancia de la fe; esta virtud cardenal que tiene el poder de salvarnos.

Dios no necesita ponernos a prueba para conocer nuestra fe. 
