Peace be with you....

What beautiful words, and know that they come from Jesus, and that they are not a wish, but a reality. Jesus is the only one who can give us peace.

Although it seems to me that since it is something that everyone seeks, few truly understand what peace is. Well, peace is not the absence of problems or difficulties, because we know that that was precisely what the disciples of Jesus never had... rather they were always surrounded by difficulties, challenges and even persecutions. And so we could ask ourselves, what then is the Peace that Jesus comes to announce once resurrected?

Peace is more like a certainty that comes from knowing Jesus or encountering Jesus. Try to imagine this scene: Jesus appears to the disciples after all the events of his crucifixion. Yes, it is a moment of immense joy, but he offers them peace while showing them the wounds on his hands and side.

We might think that the fact of showing them the wounds on his feet and side is so that they would not doubt that he was the same one who had been crucified. But that is a little implausible to me, because if I had a friend die in a traffic accident, would he appear to me with the injuries from his death . . . so that I could recognize him? Well, it doesn't sound logical to me . . . rather he would appear to me the way that I knew him before the accident. I think that the purpose of Jesus showing them the wounds, at the same time that he offers them peace, is so that they have the security that suffering is not the last word, death is not the last word... and so that they truly believe in the message of hope and love.

Today that is precisely what is needed, to believe and have the security of the gospel.



And for this, would we have to see Jesus' wounds? No, the answer is given to us by the gospel itself with the appearance that Jesus makes to Thomas. "You believe because you have seen me; blessed are those who believe without having seen".

Those who put their trust in what they see are as unstable as the leaves on the trees, one day they are there another day they are not... but those who believe with the inner conviction that is not given by the senses, those are the happy ones, those who are able to experience peace even in the midst of the storm.

And we will be able to give a response of faith, like the one that Jesus expects from his disciples. So today, are we experiencing the peace that Jesus offers us?

La paz este con ustedes...

Que hermosas palabras y sabiendo que vienen de Jesús y que no son un deseo, sino una realidad. Jesús es el único que nos puede dar la paz.

Aunque me parece que al ser algo que todo mundo busca, pocos logran realmente entender que es la paz. Pues la paz no es la ausencia de problemas o dificultades, pues sabemos que eso fue precisamente lo que los discípulos de Jesús nunca tuvieron... ellos más bien siempre estuvieron rodeados de dificultades, de retos e incluso de persecuciones. Y entonces podríamos preguntarnos ¿qué es entonces la Paz que Jesús viene a anunciar ya resucitado?

La paz es mas como una certeza que proviene del conocimiento de Jesús o del encuentro con Jesús. Trata de imaginar esta escena, Jesús se les aparece a los discípulos después de todos los acontecimientos de su crucifixión. Si, es un momento de inmensa alegría, pero él les ofrece la paz al mismo tiempo que les enseña las heridas de las manos y el costado.

Pudiéramos pensar que el hecho de mostrarles las heridas de las manos y su costado, es para que no dudaran que él era él mismo que había sido crucificado. Pero eso me es un poco increíble, pues si a mí se me apareciera un amigo que falleció en un accidente de tráfico con las heridas de su muerte para que yo lo reconozca, pues no me suena lógico más bien se me aparecería con la forma en la que yo lo conocí antes del accidente... más bien pienso que el propósito de enseñarles las heridas al mismo tiempo que les ofrece la paz, es para que tengan la seguridad de que el sufrimiento, no es la última palabra, la muerte no es la última palabra... y para que en verdad crean en el mensaje de esperanza y amor.



Hoy eso es precisamente lo que hace falta, creer y tener la seguridad del evangelio.

¿Y para ello, tendríamos que ver las heridas de Jesús? No, la respuesta nos la da el mismo evangelio con la aparición que Jesús hace a Tomas. "Tú crees porque me has visto; dichosos los que creen sin haber visto"

Los que ponen su confianza en lo que ven, son tan inestables como las hojas de los árboles, un día están otro día no están... pero los que creen con la convicción interior que no la da los sentidos, esos son los dichosos, los que son capaces de experimentar la paz aun en medio de la tormenta.

Y nosotros, seremos capaces de dar una respuesta de fe, como la que Jesús espera de sus discípulos. Y hoy, ¿estamos experimentado la paz que Jesús nos ofrece?

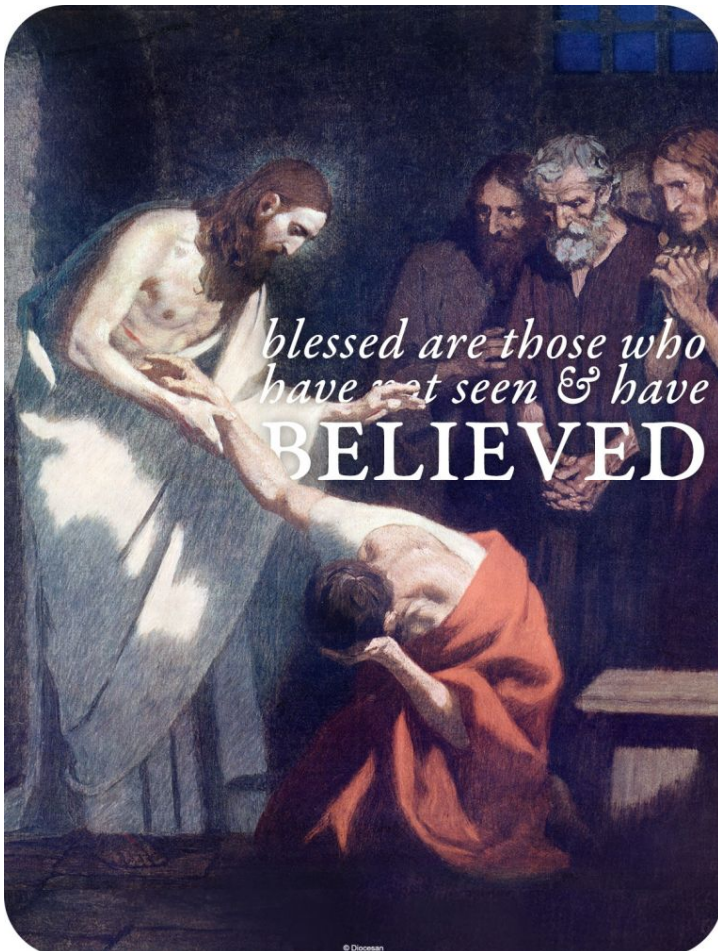

DEACON'S CORNER

This Sunday's readings are full of joy, hope, and promise. We read in Acts of the new community of believers coming together to break bread and pray and remember. In the Letter of St. Peter, we hear of the joy of the promise of life after death through the Resurrection. Peter tells us to rejoice in the faith we have of the Resurrection of Christ and the promise of salvation God has given us. Are all of these feelings that we might be experiencing today sound familiar?

Didn't this all happen about 2000 years ago? As we read the account, in John's Gospel, about the appearance of Jesus, I can only imagine what the Apostles had been going through and what they must have been feeling after the death and Resurrection of Jesus. Someone they knew and loved for all of those months was gone. They were alone, afraid, probably angry, and certainly wondering what to do next. How would they survive? And Jesus comes into their midst, becomes present to them and said "Peace be with you." And the Apostles believed. A second time Jesus became present to them and again said "Peace be with you", this time for Thomas. What a joy they must have felt having Jesus in their presence so they could believe.

Just as Jesus made himself known to the Apostles at different times after his Resurrection, by his presence, he makes himself present to us in the Eucharist. And his presence helps us through our times of grief, anger, uncertainty, and loss. Jesus, present in the Eucharist, is his gift to us, and our faith in that presence brings him to us as surely as he came to the Apostles in the room with the locked door.

RINCON DEL DIACONO

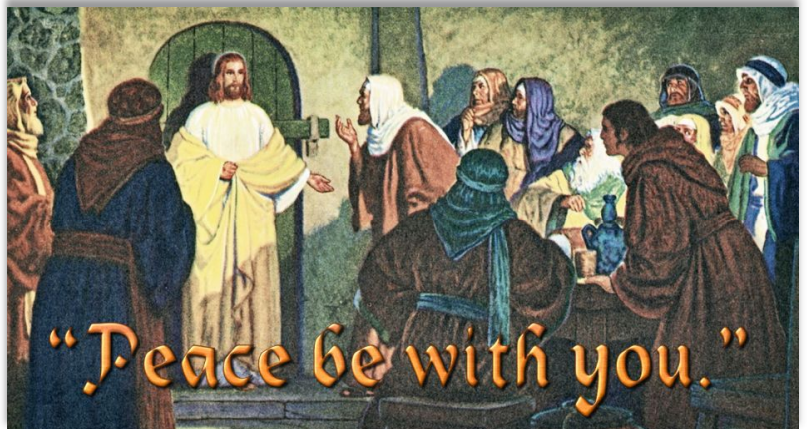

Pedro nos dice que nos regocijemos por la fe que tenemos en la Resurrección de Cristo y la promesa de salvación que Dios nos ha dado. ¿Te suenan familiares todos estos sentimientos que podríamos estar experimentando hoy?

¿No sucedió todo esto hace unos 2000 años? Al leer el relato, en el Evangelio de Juan, sobre la aparición de Jesús, sólo puedo imaginar lo que habían estado pasando los Apóstoles y lo que debieron haber sentido después de la muerte y resurrección de Jesús. Alguien a quien conocieron y amaron durante todos esos meses se había ido. Estaban solos, asustados, probablemente enojados y ciertamente preguntándose qué hacer a continuación. ¿Cómo sobrevivirían? Y Jesús llega en medio de ellos, se hace presente ante ellos y les dice: "La paz esté con ustedes". Y los Apóstoles creyeron. Por segunda vez Jesús se hizo presente ante ellos y nuevamente dijo "La paz esté con ustedes", esta vez para Tomás. Qué alegría debieron sentir al tener a Jesús en su presencia para poder creer.

Así como Jesús se dio a conocer a los Apóstoles en diferentes momentos después de su Resurrección, por su presencia, se hace presente a nosotros en la Eucaristía. Y su presencia nos ayuda en nuestros momentos de dolor, ira, incertidumbre y pérdida. Jesús, presente en la Eucaristía, es su regalo para nosotros, y nuestra fe en esa presencia lo trae a nosotros con tanta seguridad como vino a los Apóstoles en la habitación con la puerta cerrada.
