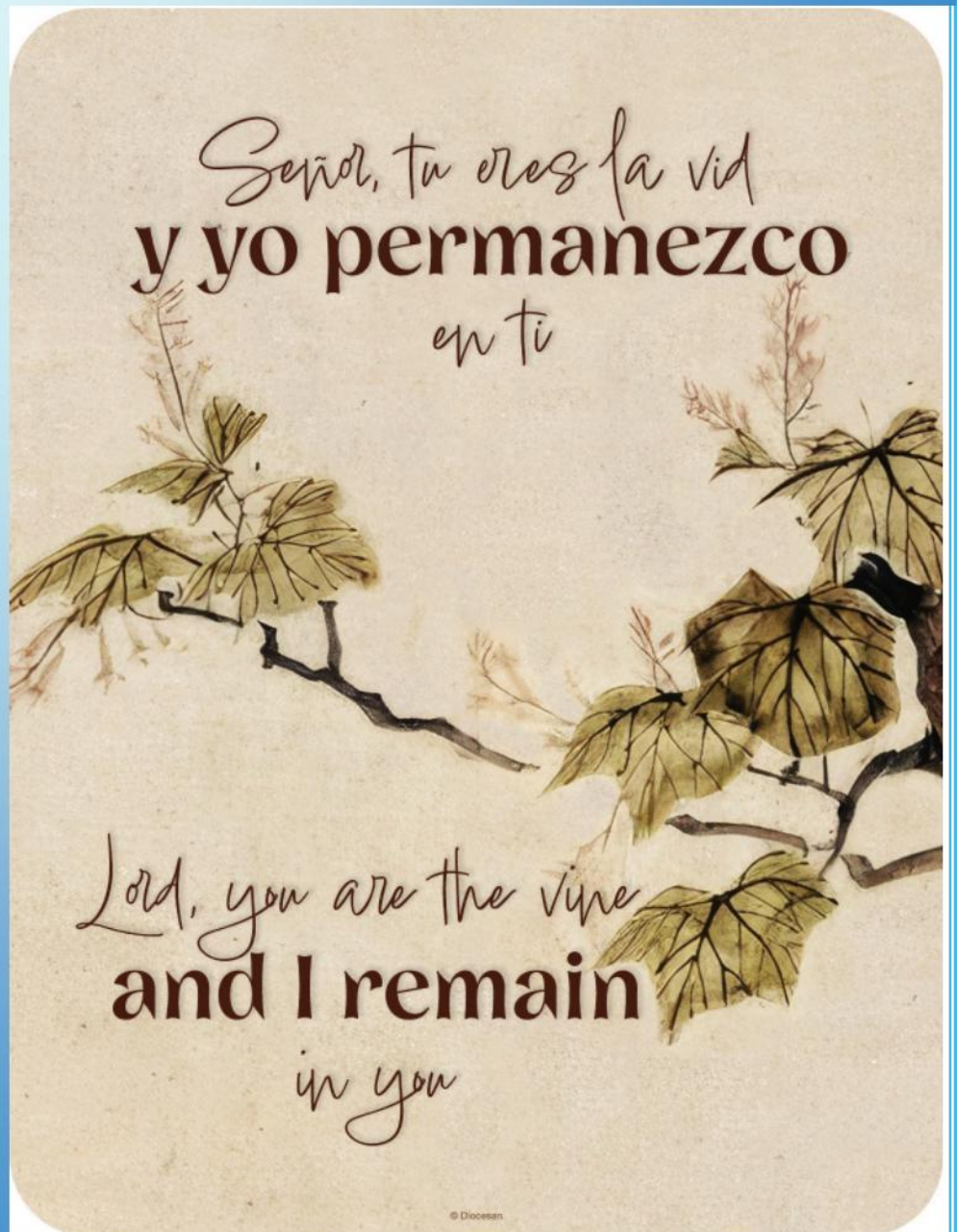

Shepherd-sheep Vine-branch

If last week the topic was very easy to understand Jesus, the good shepherd, and we who will be part of his flock if we listen to his voice and if we follow him then these two aspects are essential to say that we are from the Lord's flock; it is listening to him and to follow him. There could be someone who would listen to him, but if he does not follow him, it is a clear sign that he is not one of his flock.

Today the gospel gives us another very good image to meditate on and also very simple at the same time as profound as we would like to apply it in our lives. Jesus presents himself as the true vine, the Father is the vinedresser, and it would be up to us to be the branch, which is the one that bears fruit.

Thinking about the image of the Shepherd-sheep and the Vine-branch gives us a very complete idea not only of the relationship we must have with the Lord but also of our deepest identity in being. Let's think, the Shepherd-sheep relationship is something external, it has to be listened to and followed, to which we could add many pretexts, such as the noise that would make it difficult for us to distinguish the voice of the Lord... but on this occasion with this parable of the Vine-branch, it is not about doing, but rather about being. It is not something external, but rather it is something internal, to be able to receive the sap that is naturally provided to us by the vine, and in this

way, fruits would naturally be produced. The challenge today is that sometimes we allow ourselves to be seduced by what is foreign to us, sin, and that causes us to become contaminated and not produce fruit.

In the parable of the Shepherd-sheep, the enemy was someone from outside, the wolf. But on this occasion, the enemy could be our bad decisions, closing ourselves to the vine, closing ourselves to grace, and as a result, we will not bear fruit. The result is that we will be cut off, but we could even dry up the stronger we are by the internal damage.

Here it is not enough to be in the flock or to be united to the vine, here it is important to bear fruit. Well, like any tree, no matter how much foliage and leaves it has, it will never satisfy hunger unless it bears fruit, the fruit is very distant from the foliage. The leaves can be the intentions or the words, but the fruit is the action, the concrete fact that nourishes and gives life.

It is important to review our attitudes, and our disposition and, above all, to recognize in time if we are bearing fruit as the Lord expects of us.

Pastor-oveja

Vid-sarmiento

Si la semana pasada el tema era muy fácil de entender, Jesús el Buen Pastor y nosotros que seremos de su rebaño si escuchamos su voz y si lo seguimos. Estos dos aspectos son indispensables para decir que somos del rebaño del Señor, el escucharlo y el seguirlo. Pudiera existir alguien que lo escuchara, pero si no lo sigue, es clara señal que no es de su rebaño.

Hoy el evangelio nos regala otra imagen muy buena para meditar y también muy sencilla al mismo tiempo tan profunda como nosotros quisiéramos aplicarla en nuestra vida. Jesús se presenta como la Vid Verdadera, el Padre es el viñador, y a nosotros nos correspondería ser el sarmiento, que es el que da fruto.

Pensar en la imagen del Pastor-oveja y de la Vid-sarmiento, nos da una idea muy completa no solo de la relación que debemos de tener con el Señor, sino además de nuestra más profunda identidad en el ser. Pensemos, la relación Pastor-oveja es algo externo, se tiene que escuchar y seguir, a lo que pudiéramos añadir muchos pretextos, como el ruido que nos dificultaría distinguir la voz del Señor... pero en esta ocasión con esta parábola de la Vid-sarmiento, no se trata de hacer, sino más bien es algo interior, ser capaces de recibir la savia que nos es proporcionada naturalmente por la vid, y de esta manera naturalmente se producirían frutos. El reto el día de hoy, es que a veces nos dejamos seducir por lo que nos es ajeno a nosotros, el pecado, y eso

hace que nos contaminemos y no produzcamos frutos.

En la parábola de Pastor-oveja, el enemigo era alguien de fuera, el lobo. Pero en esta ocasión para que el enemigo puede ser nuestras malas decisiones, el cerrarnos a la vid, el cerrarnos a la gracia, y por consecuencia no daremos fruto, el resultado, es que seremos cortados, incluso nos pudiéramos secar mientras más fuerte sea el daño interior.

Aquí no es suficiente estar en el rebaño, o estar unido a la vid, aquí es importante dar fruto. Pues como todo árbol, por mucho follaje y hojas que tenga nunca saciará el hambre al menos que estos den frutos, el fruto es muy distante del follaje. Las hojas pueden ser las intenciones o las palabras, pero el fruto es la acción, el hecho concreto que alimenta y que da vida.

Es importante revisar nuestras actitudes, nuestra disposición y sobre todo el reconocer a tiempo si estamos dando fruto como el Señor espera de nosotros.

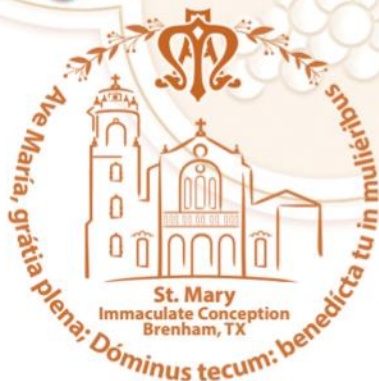

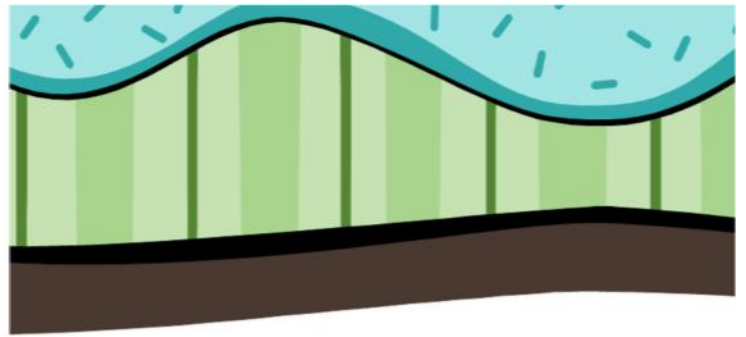

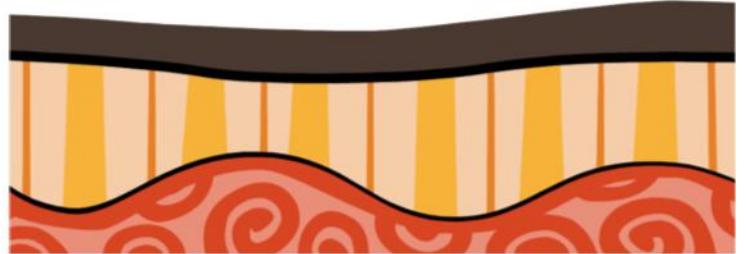
