At what level of love are we at?



We return to a very important topic, and perhaps that's why it's repeated so much, and by repeating it, we lose interest in it. When it should be the opposite, if we hear it so much it's because it's important.

The topic is love... yes, remaining in the love of God and loving one another. I think that remaining in the love of God is not so difficult to understand. If I use the analogy of love in marriages, well, for them to stay in love, dialogue and details are important keys to keep the flame of love alive. So, in the matter of remaining in the love of God, the gospel tells us very clearly what we have to do... obey the commandments. And perhaps someone would ask, which ones? All of them? Well, that's why Jesus gives us a summary of the commandments when he talks to us about loving one another. And I believe that's the difficult part.

Perhaps that's why we see how this topic is progressively explained in the gospels, until it reaches its culmination, which is what we read today.

At first, the idea of loving one another appears. But that idea is perhaps a bit ambiguous, it's more on a very childish level. Like if a father told his son, "You have to love your brother"... the child might understand it, but he'll have many doubts... what is love? How can I love him? And given that perhaps the context in which the father told his son, "You have to love your brother" is very likely to be after some quarrel between them where the father had to intervene. In that situation, love would be like: "I must not hit my brother", "I must not harm my brother" and that's true. Love implies not harming others, but undoubtedly, it's much more than that.

That's why another idea appears in the gospel, "do unto others as you would have them do unto you". Here it's not just about avoiding harm, but treating others as I would like to be treated. But another question arises: what happens when what your neighbor likes is not what you like? Or even worse, when the concept of love and the experience of love are different... we understand that at this moment love is about seeking for others the good that pleases us, but not necessarily what is good for them. Here it's as if we were at a teenage level. Where it seems that the measure of good is ourselves and that can cause misunderstandings and wounds to others.

The third and final level of revelation regarding loving one another is what we find in the gospel today. The measure will not be the absence of harm, nor our understanding of good... it will be Christ himself. To love as he loved us. And that means putting ourselves in the place of others, going out of ourselves to help and understand others even when they are wrong. It will mean being able to give our life for others, and let's not necessarily think of shedding blood, but perhaps in the most everyday things, giving time, offering our help. So, the measure of love has been set by Jesus himself on the cross.

This leads me to wonder, at what level of love are we at?

¿En qué nivel de amor nos encontramos?



Volvemos a un tema muy importante y quizá por eso se repite tanto, y al repetirse hace que perdamos interés en ello. Cuando debería ser lo contrario, si lo escuchamos mucho es porque es importante.

El tema es el amor... sí, el permanecer en el amor de Dios y el amarnos unos a otros. Pienso que el tema de permanecer en el amor de Dios no es tan difícil de entender. Si utilizo la analogía del amor en los matrimonios, pues para que ellos permanezcan en el amor, el diálogo y los detalles son clave importante para mantener la llama del amor. Pues en el tema de permanecer en el amor a Dios, el evangelio nos dice muy claro lo que tenemos que hacer... cumplir los mandamientos. Y quizá alguien diría, ¿cuáles? ¿Todos? Bueno, es por eso que Jesús nos da un resumen de los mandamientos cuando nos habla de amarnos los unos a los otros. Y creo que ese es el tema difícil.

Es quizá por eso que vemos cómo se va explicando de manera progresiva este tema en los evangelios, hasta llegar a su culminación que es la que leemos el día de hoy.

Al principio aparece la idea de amarnos los unos a los otros. Pero esa idea es quizá un poco ambigua, es más en un nivel muy infantil. Como si un padre le dijera a su hijo, "tienes que amar a tu hermano"... el niño quizá lo entiende, pero tendrá muchas dudas... ¿Qué es el amor? ¿Cómo puedo amarlo? Y dado que quizá el contexto en que el padre le dijo a su hijo, "tienes que amar a tu hermano" es muy posible que sea después de alguna riña entre ambos donde el padre tuvo que intervenir. En esa situación, el amor sería como: "no debo de golpear a mi hermano", "no debo de hacerle daño a mi hermano" y eso es verdad, el amor implica no dañar al prójimo, pero indudablemente es mucho más que eso.

Es por eso que después aparece otra idea en el evangelio, "haz a tu prójimo lo que a ti te gustaría que te hicieran". Aquí ya no es solo evitarle el mal, sino tratarlo como a mí me gustaría que me trataran. Pero surge otra pregunta: ¿qué sucede cuando a tu prójimo no le gusta lo que a ti te gusta? O peor aún, cuando el concepto de amor y la experiencia de amor son diferentes... entendemos que en este momento el amor es procurar al otro el bien que a nosotros nos agrada, pero no necesariamente es el bien del otro. Aquí es como si estuviéramos en un nivel de adolescentes. Donde parece que la medida del bien somos nosotros mismos y eso puede causar malos entendidos y heridas en el prójimo.

El tercer y último nivel de revelación en lo que corresponde a amarnos los unos a los otros es el que encontramos en el evangelio el día de hoy. La medida no será la ausencia de daño, ni nuestro entendimiento del bien... será Cristo mismo. Amar como él nos amó. Y eso significa ponernos en el lugar del prójimo, salir de nosotros mismos para ayudar y entender al prójimo aun cuando él esté en el error. Significará ser capaces de dar la vida por el prójimo, y no pensemos necesariamente en derramar la sangre, sino en quizá lo más cotidiano, dar el tiempo, brindar nuestra ayuda. Así que la medida del amor nos la ha puesto Jesús mismo en la cruz.

Esto me lleva a preguntarme ¿en qué nivel de amor nos encontramos?

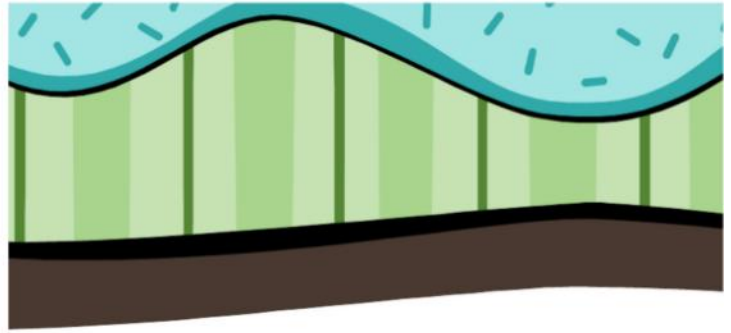


Men of St. Mary's, Friends of Joseph

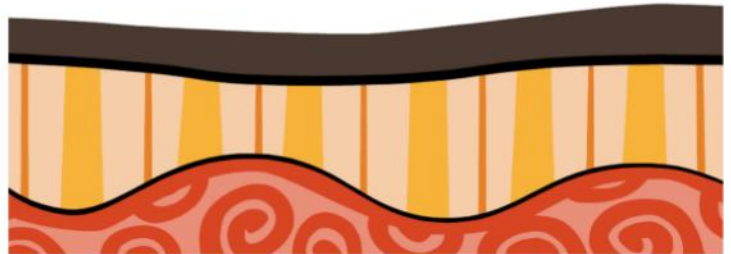
