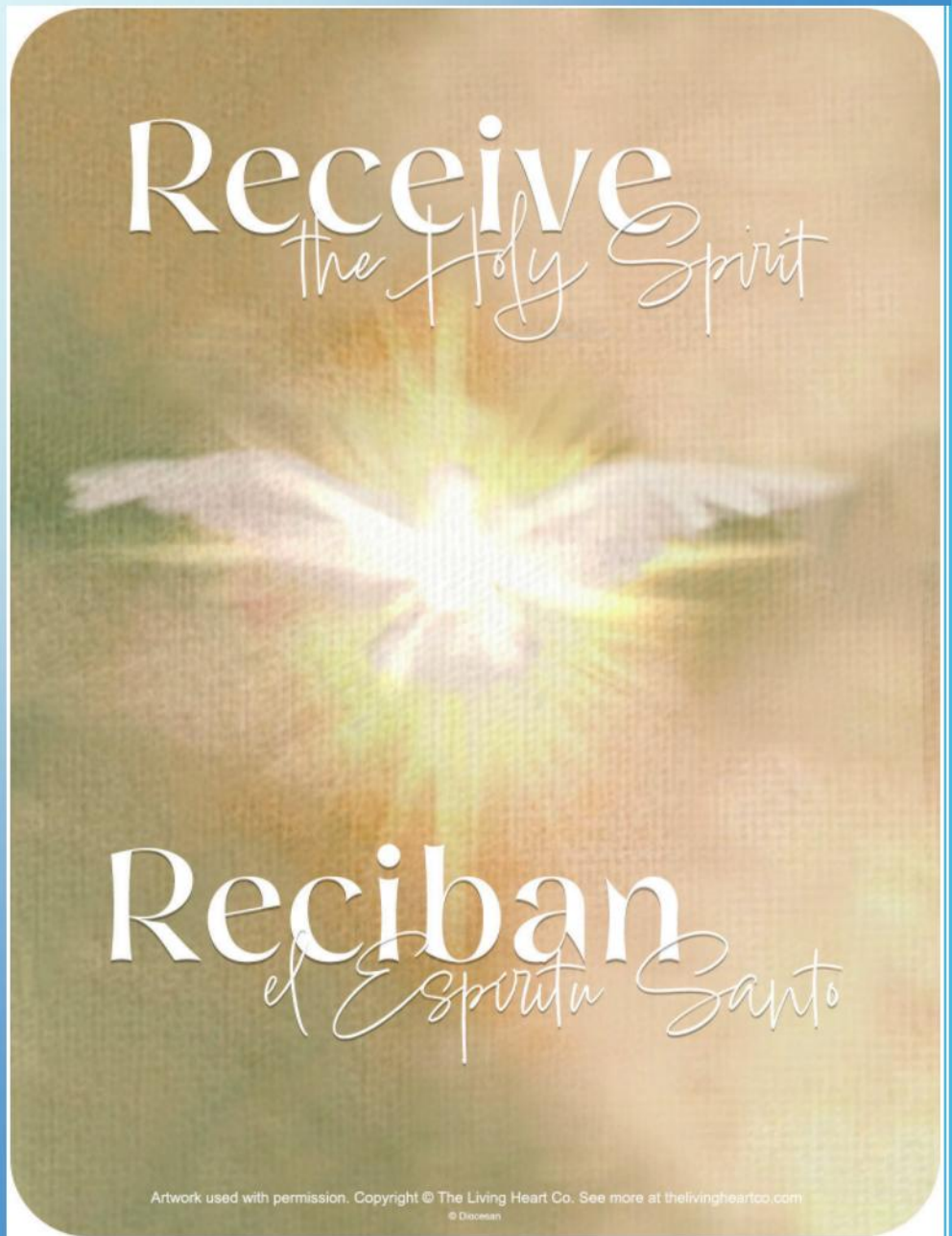

Come Holy Spirit

Without a doubt, the feast of Pentecost is one of my favorites because of its great symbolism from the Old Testament and especially in the New Testament when the fullness of the Holy Spirit is received.

In the Old Testament, during the feast of Pentecost, the people **receive the law of God** and become part of the chosen people. In the New Testament, when the promise of Jesus is fulfilled, the Holy Spirit becomes the new law, not written on tablets of stone, as God gave them to Moses, but **inscribed in our hearts**.

In the Old Testament, **God was seen as distant**, a God who spoke in the clouds. In the Gospels, we see God close to us, Emmanuel, **God with us**. In the Acts of the Apostles, the promise that Jesus gave us is fulfilled, and now it is **God in us**; we are now temples of the Holy Spirit.

One of the wonders the Holy Spirit produces in us is unity. It is clear that sin causes separation, as in the Tower of Babel, where pride divides us. But the fruit of receiving the Holy Spirit is unity, where nationality and language no longer matter. The new language that will characterize Christians is

the language of love, respect, and unity. Let the Holy Spirit act in us, renewing the wonders of the beginning, so that we may witness the miracles that Jesus continues to perform today. We are His people; all together, we are the people of God.



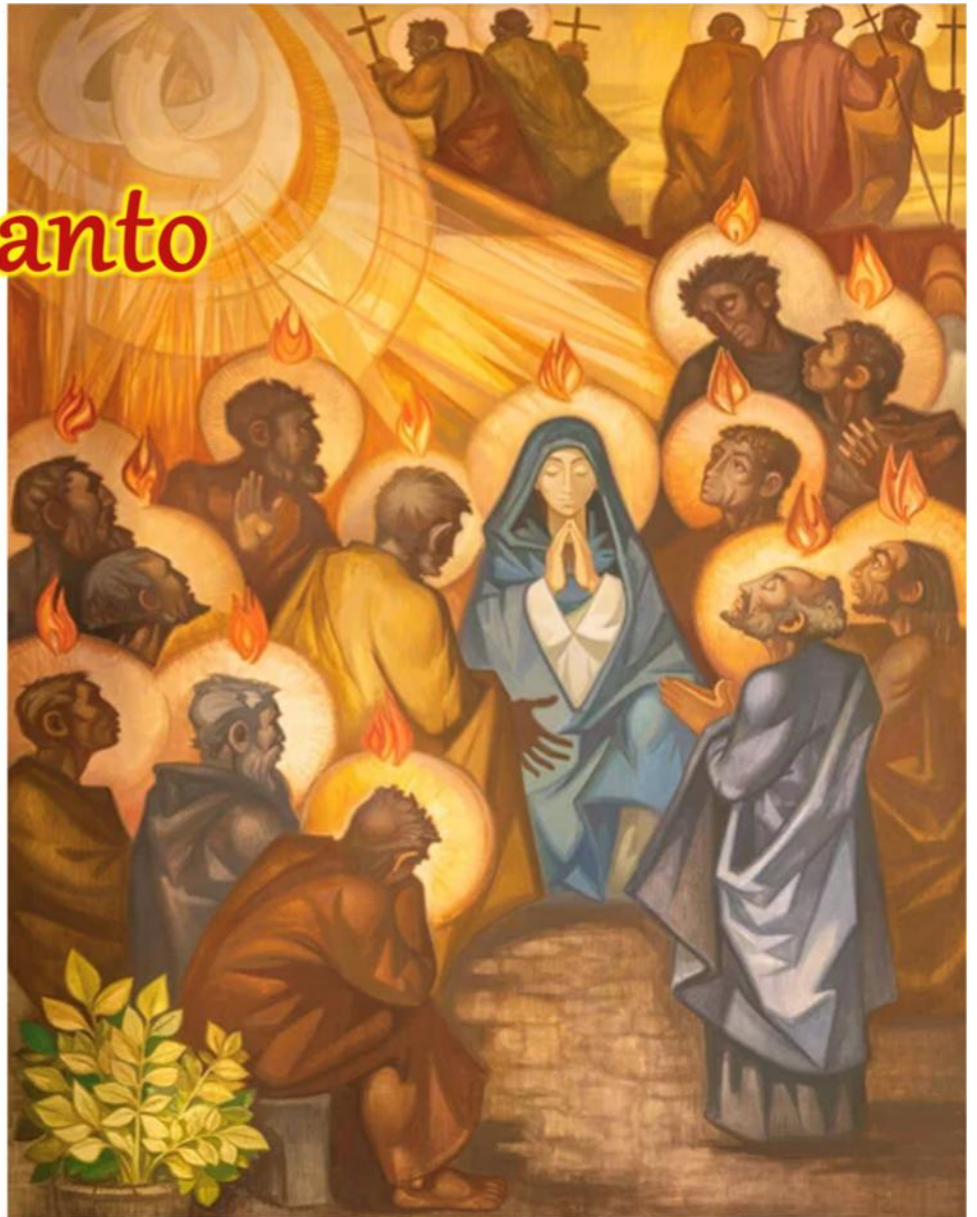

Sin duda, la fiesta de Pentecostés es una de mis favoritas por todo el gran simbolismo que tiene desde el Antiguo Testamento y especialmente en el Nuevo Testamento, cuando se recibe la plenitud del Espíritu Santo.

En el Antiguo Testamento, en la fiesta de Pentecostés, es cuando el **pueblo recibe la ley de Dios** y pasa a ser parte del pueblo elegido. En el Nuevo Testamento, al cumplirse la promesa de Jesús, el Espíritu Santo viene a ser la nueva ley, no escrita en tablas de piedra, como Dios se las dio a Moisés, sino **inscrita en nuestros corazones**.

En el Antiguo Testamento, se veía a **Dios lejano**, un Dios que hablaba en las nubes. En los Evangelios, vemos a Dios cercano a nosotros, el Emmanuel, **Dios con nosotros**. Ya en Hechos de los Apóstoles, cumplida la promesa que Jesús nos dio, **ahora es Dios**



en nosotros; ahora somos templos del Espíritu Santo.

Una de las maravillas que produce el Espíritu Santo en nosotros es la unidad.

Se ve claramente que el pecado provoca división, como en la torre de Babel, donde el orgullo nos divide. Pero el fruto de recibir al Espíritu Santo es la unidad, donde ya no importa ni la nacionalidad ni el idioma. El nuevo lenguaje que

caracterizará a los cristianos será el lenguaje del amor, del respeto y de la unidad. Dejemos al Espíritu Santo actuar en nosotros, que renueve las maravillas del principio para que seamos testigos de los milagros que Jesús sigue haciendo hoy en día. Nosotros somos su pueblo; todos juntos somos el pueblo de Dios.

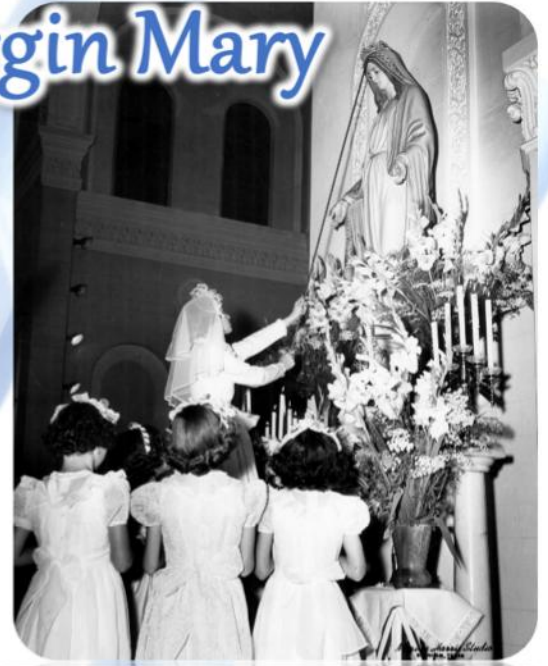

Let's offer roses to the Virgin Mary

An ancient tradition of the Catholic Church is to dedicate the month of May to the Virgin Mary. Throughout this month, flowers are offered to her in chapels and parishes during the praying of the Holy Rosary.

This custom originated in Europe during the Middle Ages. At that time, May was known as the "month of flowers" because spring reached its peak, filling the fields with green and a variety of colorful and fragrant flowers. To encourage good weather, this month was consecrated to honor the virtues and beauty of the Mother of God.

In the 13th century, Alfonso X "the Wise", King of Spain, invoked the Virgin Mary during the month of flowers through the "Cantigas de Santa María". These are a series of monodic songs that proclaim the virtues of Mary and the miracles achieved through her intercession.

It was in the 16th century when the practice of honoring the Blessed Virgin for 30 consecutive days with a series of spiritual exercises began to gain momentum. During these exercises, various mysteries, titles, and excellences of the Mother of God were considered. One of the main promoters was St. Philip Neri, who invited young people to sing and offer flowers to the Virgin.

In the 17th century, the idea of setting a specific month to honor the Virgin emerged, enriched with different devotions. However, it wasn't until the 19th century that this practice was favored with indulgences by Popes Pius VII and Pius VIII. The appearance of Our Lady of Fatima on May 13, 1917, gave the month of flowers a special significance.

Today, the month of Mary is celebrated by praying the Holy Rosary, and it is customary for children to offer flowers to the Virgin between each mystery. This mainly occurs in chapels and parishes dedicated to our mother under one of her titles, but it can also be done privately by praying the rosary as a family.

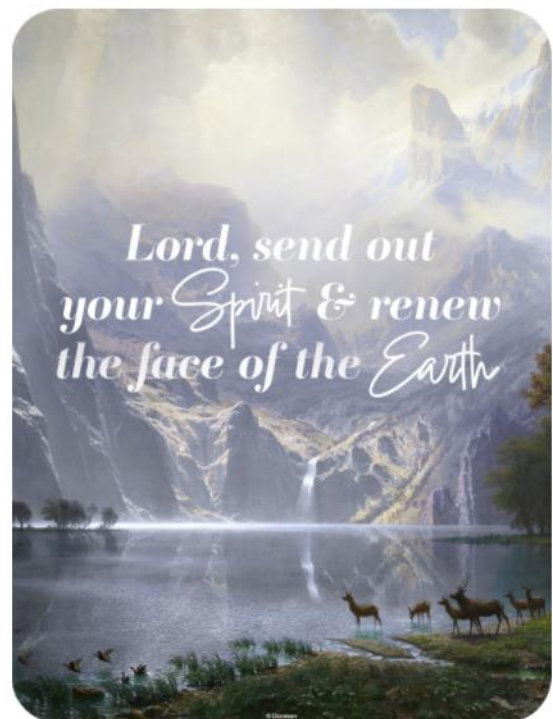
COMMUNION SERVICE

DEACON'S CORNER

Saint Isadore the Farmer

On May 15th we celebrate the feast of St. Isadore, who lived about a thousand years ago in Spain. At a young age he entered the service of a wealthy landowner from Madrid and worked faithfully on his estate outside the city for the rest of his life. He married a young woman who also became a saint, Maria de la Cabeza. They had one son, who died young.

He lived a simple life that involved prayer and work. He rose early to go to church and would visit the churches of Madrid and the surrounding areas on his holidays. He was known for his love of the poor and sometimes would miraculously supply them with food. He was also concerned about the treatment of animals. He died in 1130 and was declared a saint in 1622.

As we look at the saints in our stained-glass windows we see many religious figures. We see popes and bishops, priests, monks, and nuns, all of them in religious garb. Isadore reminds us that holiness can be found even in the mundane tasks of everyday life. You don't have to go to Nigeria and martyred for the faith to be a Saint. Sanctity can be found by serving God in any walk of life.

If through prayer and good works you are ordering your life to God's call, it doesn't matter if you are a bricklayer, an auto repairman, a construction worker, a grocery store clerk, an upholsterer or even a farmer. You may still wind up a Saint in the Catholic Church, with many miracles attributed to people asking for your intercession. St. Isadore shows us that no matter what it is we do, our work is an offering to God, and therefore we should always be doing our best. And that God responds to our best, sometimes with miracles. Who knows, perhaps one day you will become the patron saint for your occupation.

RINCON DEL DIACONO

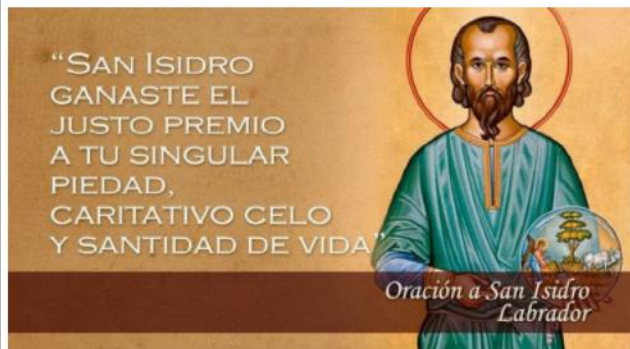
San Isidro Labrador

El 15 de mayo celebramos la fiesta de San Isidro que vivió hace unos mil años en España. Desde muy joven entró al servicio de un rico terrateniente madrileño y trabajó fielmente en su finca fuera de la ciudad por el resto de su vida. Se casó con una joven que también se convirtió en santa, María de la Cabeza. Tuvieron un hijo, que murió joven.

Vivió una vida sencilla que implicaba oración y trabajo. Se levantaba temprano para ir a la iglesia y visitaba las iglesias de Madrid y alrededores en sus vacaciones. Era conocido por su amor a los pobres y a veces milagrosamente les proporcionaría comida. También le preocupaba el trato a los animales. El murió en 1130 y fue declarado santo en 1622.

Cuando miramos a los santos en nuestras vidrieras, vemos muchas figuras religiosas. Vemos papas y obispos, sacerdotes, monjes y monjas, todos ellos con atuendos religiosos. Isidro nos recuerda que la santidad se puede encontrar incluso en las tareas mundanas de la vida cotidiana. No es necesario ir a Nigeria y ser martirizado por la fe para ser un Santo. La santidad se puede encontrar sirviendo a Dios en cualquier ámbito de la vida.

Si a través de la oración y las buenas obras estás ordenando tu vida al llamado de Dios, no importa si eres un un albañil, un reparador de automóviles, un trabajador de la construcción, un dependiente de una tienda de comestibles, un tapicero o incluso un granjero. Es posible que aún termines siendo un Santo en la Iglesia Católica, y muchos milagros se atribuyen a personas que piden por tu intercesión. San Isidro nos muestra que no importa lo que hagamos, nuestro trabajo es una ofrenda a Dios, y por lo tanto, siempre debemos hacer nuestro mejor esfuerzo. Y que Dios responde a lo mejor de nosotros, a veces con milagros. Quién sabe, tal vez algún día te conviertas en el santo patrón de tu profesión.
