The Holy Trinity

The feast of the Holy Trinity gives me the impression that, despite being a very beautiful feast, many still see it as something abstract and distant. It even gives me the impression that it is only left for intellectuals who can try to delve into this feast. But it is not so. I believe it is quite the opposite: it is a feast that the simplest person can grasp in their hearts.

Certainly, trying to intellectualize and thoroughly understand the mystery of the Holy Trinity will be impossible: one God, three different persons. The Father is God, the Son is God, the Holy Spirit is God, but there is only one God, and yet each of them is different from the other. Trying to approach it in an intellectual way, intelligence and mathematics fail us, because the sum of God the Father, plus God the Son, plus God the Holy Spirit is still one God. And yet, each of them is completely God.

So, what can we say about the Holy Trinity? First, let us approach with a simple heart and discover that God is not a solitary God, that God is not a being far away, lost and alone in space.

God is family, the perfect communion of three distinct persons who share the same divine essence. It is precisely this fact: that God is family, that God is love, that God is happiness – all by being a perfect communion of persons. It is this fact that makes us trust in the love He has for us. Because this perfection of community, this perfection of happiness, and this perfection of love always seeks to be shared. That is why God has created us, that is why God has sought us, that is why God has saved us, and that is why God calls us to participate in Him, to live with Him. Because love is shared, happiness radiates, and family grows.

Celebrating the feast of the Holy Trinity is celebrating a God who is family and who invites us to be with Him. We have a God who is love, and love demands communion. That is why this God never tires of calling us to participate and to be with Him.

La Solemnidad de la Santísima Trinidad.

Me da la impresión de que, a pesar de ser una Solemnidad muy bella, muchos la siguen viendo como algo abstracto y lejano. Incluso me da la impresión de que solamente se deja para los intelectuales que puedan tratar de profundizar en esta Solemnidad . No es así. Creo que sería todo lo contrario: es una Solemnidad que la gente más sencilla puede captar en su interior.

Ciertamente, tratar de intelectualizar y comprender exhaustivamente el misterio de la Santísima Trinidad será imposible: un solo Dios, tres diferentes personas. El Padre es Dios, el Hijo es Dios, el Espíritu Santo es Dios, pero solamente hay un Dios, y sin embargo, cada uno de ellos es diferente del otro.

Tratar de acercarnos de una manera intelectual nos faltaría inteligencia, y aquí las matemáticas nos fallan, porque la suma de Dios Padre más Dios Hijo más Dios Espíritu Santo sigue siendo un Dios. Y aún así, cada uno de ellos es completamente Dios.

Entonces, ¿qué poder decir de la Santísima Trinidad? Primero, acerquémonos con un corazón sencillo y descubramos que Dios no es un Dios solitario, que Dios no es un ser lejano, perdido y solitario en el espacio. Dios es familia, es la perfecta comunión de tres personas distintas que comparten la misma esencia divina. Y es precisamente este hecho, el hecho de que Dios es una familia, el hecho de que Dios es amor, el hecho de que Dios es felicidad al ser una perfecta comunión de personas, es este hecho el que hace que nosotros confiemos en el amor que Él nos tiene.

Porque esta perfección de comunidad, esta perfección de felicidad y esta perfección de amor busca siempre compartirse. Por eso es que Dios nos ha creado, por eso es que Dios nos ha buscado, por eso es que Dios nos ha salvado y por eso es que Dios nos llama a que participemos de Él, a que vivamos con Él. Porque el amor se comparte, la felicidad se irradia y la familia crece.

Celebrar la Solemnidad de la Santísima Trinidad es celebrar a un Dios que es familia y que nos invita a estar con Él.

Tenemos un Dios que es amor y el amor exige comunión. Es por eso que este Dios no se cansa de llamarnos a participar y a estar con Él.

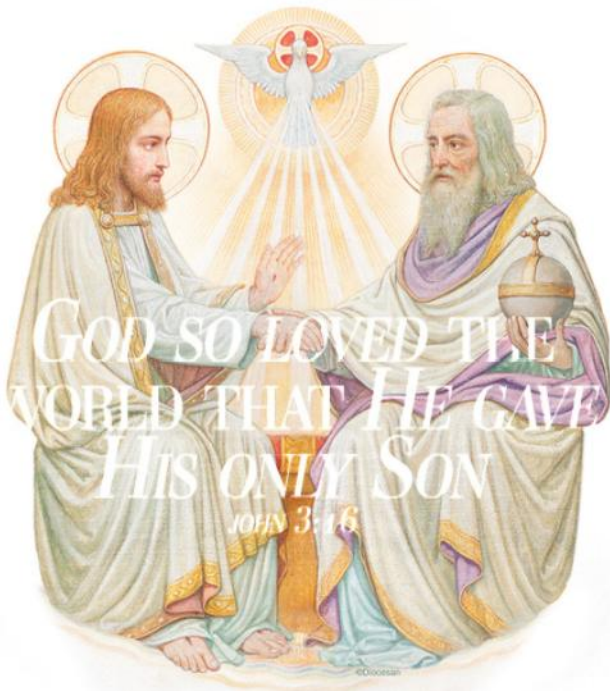

DEACON'S CORNER

The Greatest Vocation

A few days ago the place kicker for the Kansas City Chiefs gave the commencement address for Benedictine College and created a great deal of controversy by saying to the women of the graduating class: "Some of you may go on to lead successful careers in the world, but I would venture to guess that the majority of you are most excited about your marriage and the children you will bring into this world."



I found it strange that anyone would find this controversial. The root of the word "vocation" is a Latin word meaning "to be called". There's no question but that being a wife and mother is a vocation, a calling, and for a woman called to this vocation it's the most important work she does. I know many women who balance families and careers, and I don't know of one, who if asked which was more important in her life, would not say it was without question her family.

We often speak of vocations in terms of religious vocations but there's no religious vocation that is more important than that of being a good wife and mother. If you were to ask any theologian "Who was the most important human person in the history of the Church, the answer would of course be Mary, and she is venerated and honored for her responding to God's call to be a mother.

We often ask the young: "What do you want to be when you grow up?" The question should be "What does God want you to be when you grow up?" For a woman who is called to be a wife and mother and to build a home, it's not a waste of her talent, it's not to abandon her dreams and it's not to forgo the chance of success in a career. It's to answer God's call to bring new life into the world. What could be more important than that?

La Mayor Vocación

Hace unos días el pateador de los Kansas City Chiefs pronunció el discurso de graduación de Benedictine College y creó una gran controversia al decirles a las mujeres de la graduación: "Algunas de ustedes podrán llegar a tener carreras exitosas en el mundo, pero me atrevería a suponer que la mayoría de ustedes están muy entusiasmadas con su matrimonio y los hijos que traerán a este mundo".

Me pareció extraño que alguien encontrara esto controversial. La raíz de la palabra "vocación" es una palabra latina que significa "ser llamado". No hay duda de que ser esposa y madre es una vocación, un llamado y para una Mujer llamada a esta vocación es el trabajo más importante que realiza. Conozco muchas mujeres que equilibran familias y carreras, y no conozco a nadie que, si se le preguntara qué era más importante en su vida, no diría que fue sin lugar a dudas su familia.

A menudo hablamos de vocaciones en términos de vocaciones religiosas pero no hay vocación religiosa que sea más importante que el de ser una buena esposa y madre. Si le preguntaras a cualquier teólogo "¿Quién fue la persona humana mas importante en la historia de la Iglesia, la respuesta sería, por supuesto, María, y ella es venerada y honrada por haber respondido al llamado de Dios a ser madre.

A menudo preguntamos a los jóvenes: "¿Qué quieres ser cuando seas grande?" La pregunta debería ser "¿Qué es lo que Dios quiere que seas cuando seas grande? Para una mujer que está llamada a ser esposa y madre y a construir una casa, no es desperdiciar su talento, no es abandonar sus sueños y no es renunciar a la posibilidad de éxito en una carrera. Es responder al llamado de Dios de traer nueva vida al mundo.

¿Qué podría ser más importante que eso?
