# To remain in the love of God.



The founder of our religious community, Fr. Pablo Cárdenas, a priest of the Franciscan order, was very fond of the Gospel according to St. John; he told us that it was the simplest Gospel and that because of its simplicity, it was difficult for us to understand it.

In the first 10 verses of chapter 15 of the Gospel according to John, the word “remain” appears 10 times, and of the approximately 118 times that this word appears in the whole Bible, 40 are in the Gospel according to John.

Fr. Pablo spoke to us a lot about the importance of always remaining in the Holy of Holies. In the Old Testament, this is described in chapters 25–30 of the book of Exodus, which I invite you to read to understand clearly how the so-called Tent of Meeting was built (Ex. 33:7). In the Holy of Holies was the Ark of the Covenant, the place of God's presence.

Now, the word “remain”, in its Greek interpretation, means to remain, to persevere, to endure, to wait, to wait, to stay, a place to be, to wait, and to be patient. Yes, it has many meanings, but this gives us an idea of what the Gospel wants to tell us.

To remain in the Holy of Holies is to be with Jesus; it is to have communion with him always; it is to know that he is with us, loving us and leading our lives as what he is, the Lord of our existence, and that he will never abandon us.

However, this society of ours, which has taught us that things have to be quick, easy, and pleasant with the law of the least effort, has made us forget that authentic communion with God is built with patience, with discipline, with hope, and above all, with a process of conversion.

To remain in the Lord, to remain in the Holy of Holies, is to be united to Jesus; to make his convictions, his ideas, and his love our own; to make the Kingdom of God our own; to live as what we really are: children of God.

Do you want to accept Jesus' challenge to remain in him?

# Permanecer en el amor de Dios.

Al fundador de nuestra comunidad religiosa, el padre Pablo Cárdenas, un sacerdote de la orden franciscana, le gustaba mucho el Evangelio según san Juan, nos decía que era el Evangelio más simple y que por su simplicidad se nos complicaba comprenderlo.

En los primeros 10 versículos del capítulo 15 del Evangelio según san Juan aparece 10 veces la palabra "permanecer", y de las aproximadamente 118 veces que aparece esta misma palabra en toda la Biblia, 40 están en el Evangelio según san Juan.

El padre Pablo nos hablaba mucho sobre la importancia de permanecer siempre en el lugar Santísimo. En el Antiguo Testamento, esto está descrito en los capítulos 25 al 30 del libro del Éxodo, el cual los invito a leer para comprender claramente cómo estaba construida la llamada Tienda del encuentro (Ex. 33,7). En el lugar Santísimo estaba el Arca de la Alianza, lugar de la presencia de Dios.

Ahora bien, la palabra "permanecer", en su interpretación griega, significa permanecer, perseverar, soportar, esperar, quedarse, un lugar donde estar, esperar y paciencia. Sí, tiene muchos significados, pero esto nos da una idea de lo que el Evangelio quiere decirnos.

Permanecer en el Lugar Santísimo es estar con Jesús, es tener comunión con él siempre, es saber que él está con nosotros amándonos y conduciendo nuestra vida como lo que él es, el Señor de nuestra existencia y que nunca nos abandonará.

Sin embargo, esta sociedad nuestra que nos ha enseñado que las cosas tienen que ser rápidas, fáciles, placenteras, con la ley del menor esfuerzo, nos ha hecho olvidar que la auténtica comunión con Dios se construye con paciencia, con disciplina, con esperanza y sobre todo con un proceso de conversión.

Permanecer en el Señor, permanecer en el lugar santísimo, es estar unidos a Jesús, es hacer nuestras sus convicciones, sus ideas, su amor, es hacer nuestro el Reino de Dios, es vivir como lo que realmente somos: hijos de Dios.

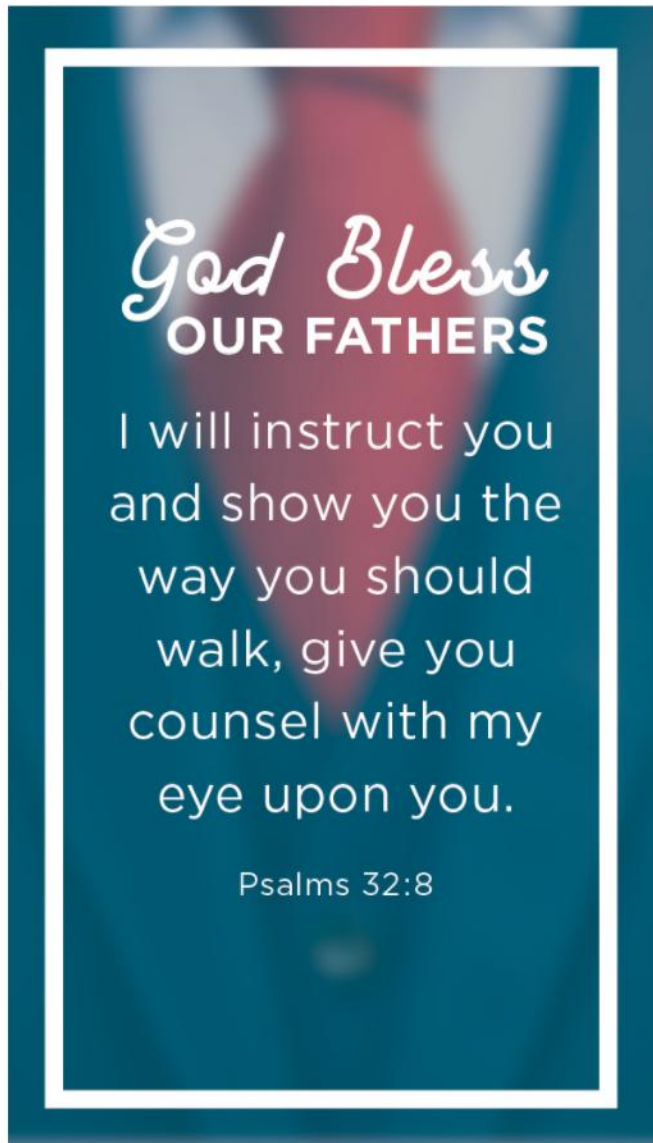

## DEACON'S CORNER

In our first reading the prophet Ezekiel writes about God planting a tree. In the Old Testament trees often refer to great Kings or Kingdoms such as Egypt, Babylon and Israel. So Ezekiel is prophesying that God will establish a new King and a new Kingdom. Writing to the Jewish exiles in captivity in Babylon Ezekiel has already told them that their deportation from Israel to Babylon and the destruction of their temple in Jerusalem occurred because of their sins, their disloyalty to God but he promises God will restore them to the land of Israel one day.



The image of God planting a tree, in part, refers to God restoring the Jews to the land of Israel with a new king. And so it happened. The people eventually returned to Israel and rebuilt the temple. But that's not the end of the story, because Israel was never restored to its' original glory. Look at the first reading again. Ezekiel prophesies that God will take a small branch, a tender shoot from the very top of a tree, the tree represents Israel, and plant it in Jerusalem and that small branch will grow into a majestic tree.

The tender shoot also occurs in the writings of the prophet Isaiah and refers to the messiah of Israel. Therefore the total and complete fulfillment of Ezekiel's prophecy had to await the coming of that tender shoot, the messiah Jesus Christ who will establish the new Kingdom, the New Israel, the Kingdom of God, the Church. This new Kingdom, this church will start small but grow into a majestic tree.

Finally, the reading says birds will nest in the tree. Biblical scholar Professor Scott Hahn points out that the birds often represent the gentiles in the Old Testament. Thus the church will be a refuge and place of shelter for gentiles, that is you and me, as well as for Jews. And so it is.

## RINCON DEL DIACONO

En nuestra primera lectura, el profeta Ezequiel escribe acerca de Dios plantando un árbol. En el Antiguo Testamento los árboles suelen referirse a grandes Reyes o Reinos como Egipto, Babilonia e Israel. Entonces Ezequiel está profetizando que Dios establecerá un nuevo Rey y un nuevo Reino. Ezequiel, escribiendo a los judíos exiliados en cautiverio en Babilonia, ya les ha dicho que su deportación de Israel a Babilonia y la destrucción de su templo en Jerusalén se produjo a causa de sus pecados, su deslealtad a Dios, pero les promete que Dios los restaurará a la tierra de Israel algún día.

La imagen de Dios plantando un árbol, en parte, se refiere a que Dios restaura a los judíos en la tierra de Israel con un nuevo rey. Y así sucedió. El pueblo finalmente regresó a Israel y reconstruyó el templo. Pero ese no es el final de la historia, porque Israel nunca recuperó su gloria original. Mire la primera lectura nuevamente. Ezequiel profetiza que Dios tomará una pequeña rama, un brote tierno de la copa de un árbol, el árbol representa a Israel, y lo plantará en Jerusalén y esa pequeña rama crecerá hasta convertirse en un árbol majestuoso.

El brote tierno también aparece en los escritos del profeta Isaías y se refiere al mesías de Israel. Por lo tanto el cumplimiento total y completo de la profecía de Ezequiel tuvo que esperar a la venida de ese tierno retoño, el mesías Jesucristo que establecerá el nuevo Reino, el Nuevo Israel, el Reino de Dios, la Iglesia. Este nuevo Reino, esta iglesia comenzará siendo pequeña pero crecerá hasta convertirse en un árbol majestuoso.

Finalmente, la lectura dice que los pájaros anidarán en el árbol. El profesor Scott Hahn, erudito en Biblia, señala que los pájaros a menudo representan a los gentiles en el Antiguo Testamento. Así la iglesia será refugio y lugar de amparo para los gentiles, es decir vosotros y para mí, así como para los judíos. Y así es.
