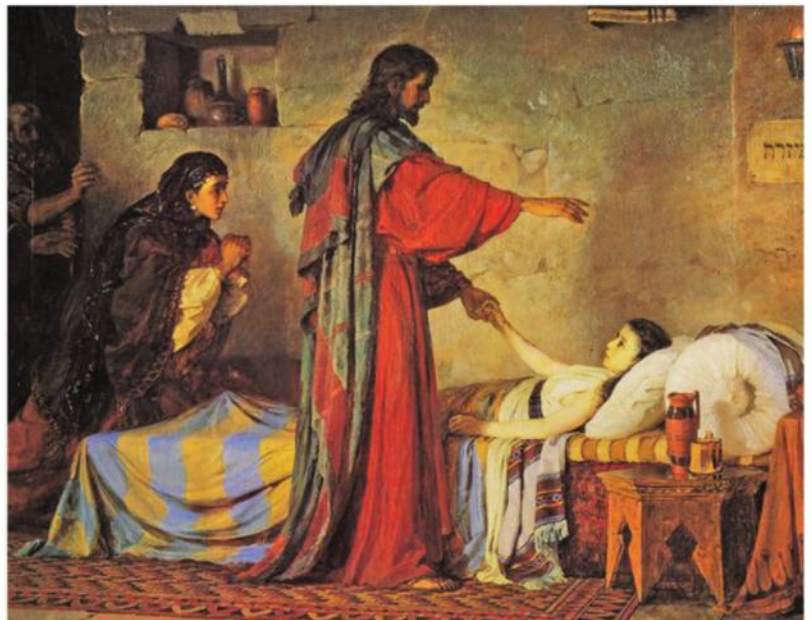

This phrase, which we hear in liturgical celebrations, is the way in which the Apostle Paul concluded several of his letters. We can find them, with some variations in Rom. 16:20; 1 Cor. 16:23; 2 Cor. 13:13; Gal. 6:18; Eph. 6:24; Phil. 4:23, etc. You may review the above quotations and the Apostle's other letters.

This peculiar way for St. Paul to end his letters signifies the Apostle's constant desire to wish the greatest possible good to the community, and the greatest possible good is the Lord Himself. But he also reminds the Christian community that when they are gathered in the name of the Lord, Christ himself is in their midst, just as he himself promised (Mt. 18:20).

The Catholic faith, being universal, does not think of itself; it is not closed in on itself; it is not a faith to be lived privately; the true faith, the faith that we profess in the Church, which is One, Holy, Catholic, and Apostolic, recognizes the constant presence of the Lord at all times, but especially when united as one body, having in mind the purpose of adoring, glorifying, announcing, and serving God, we not only wish each other well, but we do well. We are true disciples of Jesus when we love one another, and only then will we be recognized (Jn. 13:35).

That is why my wish at this moment of farewell is to wish for all of you the greatest possible good, and that is the Lord himself. I wish and pray that he will always remain with you, that he will accompany you in your hard and joyful moments, that he will give you a generous and quick heart to forgive, and that he will give you, his peace.

I want to thank each one of you for your good wishes and the opportunity you gave me to serve you with my priesthood. I thank Father Everardo, Pastor of this parish, for all his attention to me and Brother Alejandro.

God bless you all! May the Lord be with you.

Somos verdaderos discípulos de Jesús cuando nos amamos los unos a los otros y solamente así seremos reconocidos (Jn. 13:35).

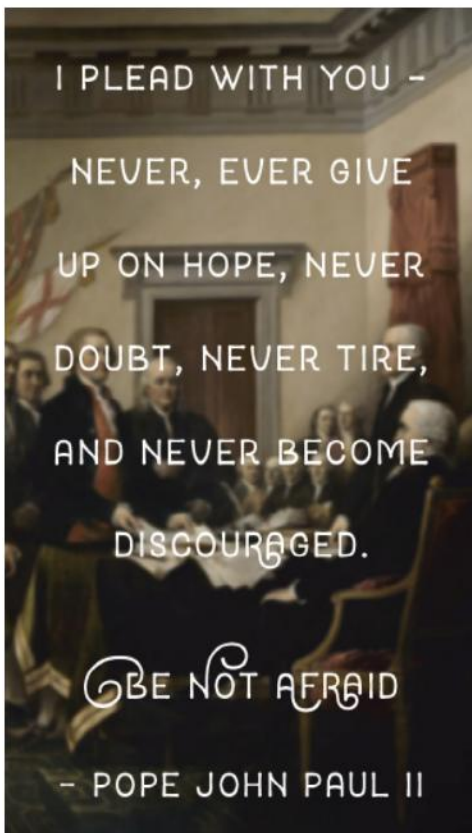


Did You Know?

DEACON'S CORNER

“Little girl, I say to you, arise!” Last week Jesus showed his power over wind and waves. Today He shows His power by healing a woman’s physical infirmity that renders her ritually unclean and unable to participate in the covenant and by raising to life a deceased twelve-year-old girl.

Peter, James and John, the synagogue official and father of the girl and his wife who witness Jesus raising girl may have remembered that the prophets Elijah and Elisha also raised children from the dead in 1st and 2nd Kings. This should have proven to them that Jesus was at least a prophet. Later Jesus will raise his friend Lazarus from the dead after Lazarus had been dead for four days. Finally Jesus Himself rose from the dead on Easter Sunday.

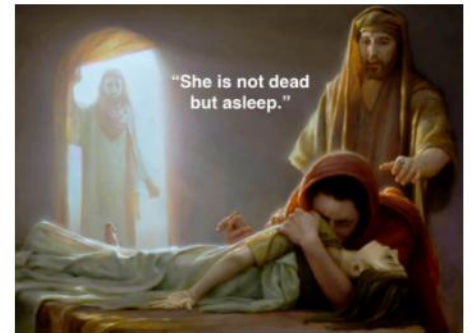
Jesus has the power over **both spiritual and physical death**. We know what physical death is. What is spiritual death? Mortal sins, are deadly sins and if not repented of prior to physical death result in eternal separation from God the source of all life. Several weeks ago we heard Jesus speak about an **unforgivable** sin, i.e., a stubborn refusal to ask for forgiveness of sin. The catechism says this can result in eternal loss and eternal separation from God (CCC 1864). Jesus loves us and knows that we are weak so provided us the sacrament of confession where His **power over spiritual death** forgives even the worst sins and restores us to spiritual life. Everyone who walks of confessional is different from when they walked in! They have been restored to spiritual life by God’s powerful grace!

Jesus **power over physical death** will be fully manifested when he raises all humanity at the final judgment at the end of world. Those spiritually dead sadly will have final confirmation that they will not experience eternal life with Jesus. While those spiritually alive will share the life of Jesus with God, the angels and saints in heaven forever! Regarding the latter remember the words of St. Paul: **console one another with these words** (Thess. 4:18).

RINCON DEL DIACONO

“¡Niña, te digo, levántate!” La semana pasada Jesús mostró su poder sobre el viento y las olas. Hoy Él muestra Su poder al sanar la enfermedad física de una mujer que la deja ritualmente impura e incapaz de participar en el pacto y al resucitar a una niña fallecida de doce años.



Pedro, Santiago y Juan, el funcionario de la sinagoga y padre de la niña y su esposa que fueron testigos de cómo Jesús resucitó a la niña, pueden haber recordado que los profetas Elías y Eliseo también resucitaron a niños de entre los muertos en 1.º y 2.º Reyes. Esto debería haberles demostrado que Jesús era al menos un profeta. Más tarde, Jesús resucitará a su amigo Lázaro de entre los muertos después de que Lázaro llevaba cuatro días muerto. Finalmente Jesús mismo resucitó de entre los muertos el Domingo de Pascua.

Jesús tiene poder sobre la **muerte tanto espiritual como física**. Sabemos qué es la muerte física. ¿Qué es la muerte espiritual? Los pecados mortales y, si no se arrepienten antes de la muerte física, resultan en la separación eterna de Dios, la fuente de toda vida. Hace varias semanas escuchamos a Jesús hablar sobre el pecado **imperdonable**, es decir, una negativa obstinada a pedir perdón del pecado. El catecismo dice que esto puede resultar en pérdida eterna y separación eterna de Dios (CCC 1864). Jesús nos ama y sabe que somos débiles, por eso nos proporcionó el sacramento de la confesión donde su **poder sobre la muerte espiritual** perdona incluso los peores pecados y nos restaura a la vida espiritual. ¡Todos los que caminan por el confesionario son diferentes de cuando entraron! ¡Han sido restaurados a la vida espiritual por la poderosa gracia de Dios!

El poder de Jesús **sobre la muerte física** se manifestará plenamente cuando resucite a toda la humanidad en el juicio final en el fin del mundo. Aquellos espiritualmente muertos lamentablemente tendrán la confirmación final de que no experimentarán la vida eterna con Jesús. Mientras que aquellos espiritualmente vivos compartirán la vida de Jesús con Dios, los ángeles y los santos en el cielo para siempre. Respecto a estos últimos recordad las palabras de San Pablo: **consolaos unos a otros con estas** palabras (Tes 4,18).
