Depending on the mission, the tools we need to carry are different...

Some one say that depending on the mission, the tools we need to carry are different, and that is very important. By knowing clearly what our mission is, we can choose the best tools that will be useful for us to accomplish what has been entrusted to us. We can imagine that the mission Jesus gives to his disciples is perhaps one of the most important and difficult, not only because they would face opposition in thought, but also because they would be exposed to a spiritual struggle against demons and evil spirits.

However, when we see the description of the tools or recommendations that Jesus gives to his disciples, we realize that it is very short, very basic, and we could even say very light on luggage, because the tools they will use are precisely those they already carry within themselves. Hence the importance of taking care of the attitude and confidence they have in Him and in themselves. Similarly, I always like to apply the sacred scripture to our daily lives. That is why I think that each aspect that Jesus tells his disciples could well be applied today to you and me.


When we have a mission, it is very clear that we should not get distracted, that we should always have it in front of us as our objective. If Jesus had recommended to his disciples that they carry many things, that they carry a lot of bread, that they carry a backpack, that they carry even money in the belt, and other things, surely the worry of wanting to take care of these things would already represent a distraction from the most important thing. Instead, when it is

clear what is most important, then we could make use of the other things, because they would be reduced to just tools and not goals.

That is what I think fails a lot among us today, because many of us believe that the most important thing is the family, but we worry more about the tool. We worry more about having a house, having a car, we spend more time at work than with our children, and it seems that those tools are taking the place that belongs to the mission. The mission is to take care of your family, and the tool you could have is to provide them with a house, but it seems that in many cases, it is decided to sacrifice the family to have a house.

It would be good to discover what the mission is that you and I have in our lives, to then set priorities and never fall into the deception or trap of wanting to give more importance to the tools than to the mission that Jesus has given us. Once you are very clear about what the mission is, it is very possible that even without one or another tool, you will carry it out. But even if you have many tools, if you are not clear about what the mission is, you will surely fail in the attempt. Hence, it is important that we stop and reflect on what our mission is.

Dicen que dependiendo de la misión son las herramientas que debemos llevar, y eso es muy importante. Conociendo con claridad cuál es la misión que tenemos, podremos elegir las mejores

herramientas que nos serán útiles para desempeñar aquello que se nos ha encomendado. Podemos imaginar que la misión que Jesús le da a sus discípulos es quizás una de las más importantes y difíciles, no solo porque enfrentarían oposiciones de pensamiento, sino porque incluso se estarían exponiendo a una lucha espiritual contra demonios y espíritus malignos.

Sin embargo, cuando vemos la descripción de las herramientas o recomendaciones que Jesús les da a sus discípulos, nos damos cuenta de que es muy corta, muy básica e incluso podríamos decir que muy ligera de equipaje, porque son precisamente las herramientas que ellos ya llevan en su interior. De ahí la importancia de que cuiden la actitud y la confianza que tienen en Él y en ellos mismos. De manera análoga, siempre me gusta aplicar la sagrada escritura a nuestro diario vivir. Por eso pienso que cada aspecto que Jesús les dice a sus discípulos bien se podría aplicar hoy a ti y a mí.

Cuando tenemos una misión, es muy claro que no debemos distraernos, que la tengamos siempre frente a nosotros como nuestro objetivo. Si Jesús les hubiera recomendado a sus discípulos que llevaran muchas cosas, que llevaran mucho pan, que llevaran mochila, que llevaran incluso dinero en el cinto y otras cosas más, seguramente la preocupación de querer cuidar estas cosas ya representaría una distracción a lo más

importante. En cambio, cuando se tiene claro qué es lo más importante, entonces bien podríamos hacer uso de las demás cosas, porque se reducirían solamente a herramientas y no a metas.

Eso es lo que creo que en el día de hoy falla mucho entre nosotros, porque somos muchos los que creemos que lo más importante es la familia, pero nos preocupamos más por la herramienta. Nos preocupamos más por tener una casa, por tener un carro, pasamos más tiempo incluso en el trabajo que con los hijos, y parece que aquellas herramientas van tomando el lugar que le corresponde a la misión. La misión es cuidar tu familia y la herramienta que pudieras tener es proporcionarles una casa, pero parece que en muchos casos se decide sacrificar a la familia para tener una casa.

Sería bueno descubrir cuál es la misión que tú y yo tenemos en nuestra vida para entonces poner prioridades y nunca caer en el engaño o en la trampa de querer darle más importancia a las herramientas que a la misión que Jesús nos ha dado. Una vez que tienes muy clara cuál es la misión, es muy posible que hasta sin una u otra herramienta la lleves a cabo. Pero aunque tengas muchas herramientas, si no tienes clara cuál es la misión, seguramente fracasarás en el intento. De ahí que es importante que nos detengamos y reflexionemos en cuál es nuestra misión.

New Organ for St. Mary's

For decades, the sanctuary of St. Mary's has been blessed with the heavenly music of our Kilgen pipe organ. Over the years, time has taken its toll on the organ. Keys are sticking and have begun to lose their covers, two foot pedals have become disconnected and no longer function, and the organ itself is a half step flat resulting in music not becoming of our great worship space.



Many years ago, we researched the possibility of buying a refurbished organ or building a new one. With an aging AV unit on our church building and several major roofing projects needed on our campus, the project was put on hold. With the Kilgen organ becoming not able to function, we have researched organ manufacturers for an organ to accommodate our space. We have located a new organ in Virginia. We have some funds in our Organ savings account to purchase the unit and we want to do it. This will enable us to maintain the Catholic tradition of organ music. Although we have the funds for the instrument they are not enough, we are asking for donations to complete the cost, for shipping, installation and modifications needed in the choir loft. Several of you have asked me about the organ, well this is an opportunity that we have to obtain an organ according to the beauty of our church. Help us make it possible.

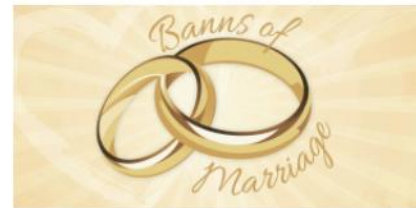

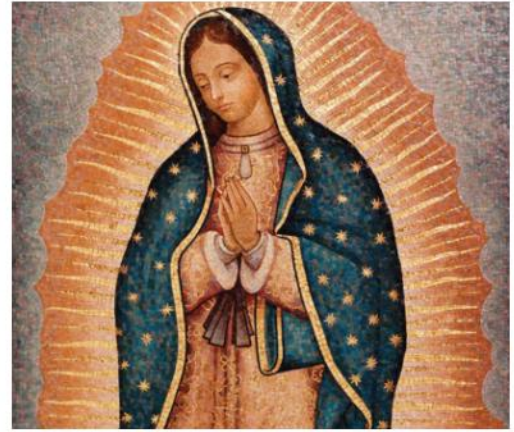
