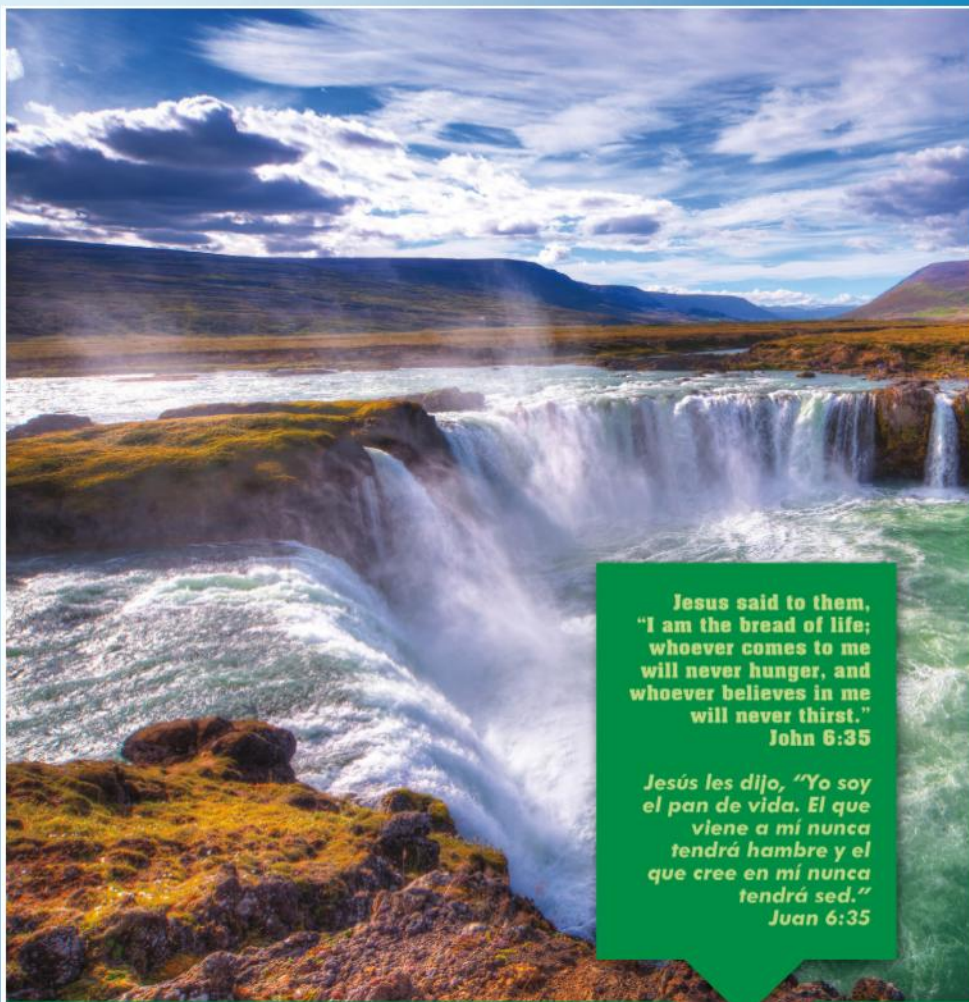

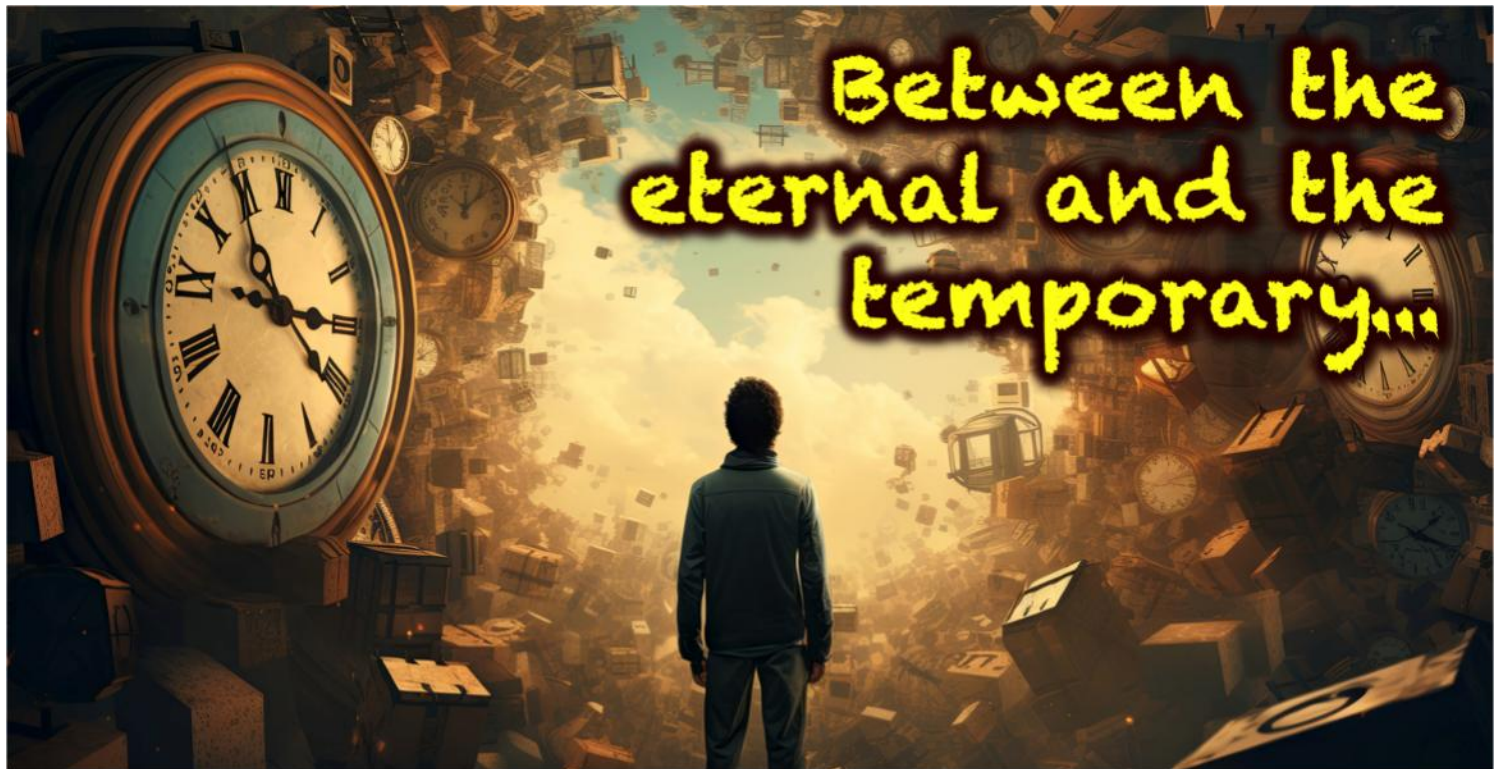

Father Everardo will be celebrating a wedding on Saturday, August 10th, at Santa Cruz in Buda, Texas.

Let us continue praying for an increase in vocations to the priesthood.



In the Gospel for this weekend, we hear about the continuation of the miracle of the loaves and fishes, where Jesus confronts the people who seek Him only for the food they received and not for believing in Him. Jesus highlights that people often focus on material and perishable desires, such as food, a car, or a house, but these things only provide temporary satisfaction. He calls for seeking the bread of eternal life rather than the transient things of the world.

Jesus criticizes the mentality of seeking only material things, using the example of how people strive to obtain things that, while valuable for a time, eventually wear out or lose their value. This constant pursuit of material wealth never completely satisfies the human heart and always leaves us with a sense of emptiness.

The text also reflects how our priorities have changed over time. Previously, needs were more basic and centered on daily survival, whereas today we seek comfort and security in material things. However, these cannot fill the spiritual void that only God can fill. Jesus calls us to reorient our priorities towards the eternal.

Moreover, it is mentioned that while the people of Israel received manna in the desert as food, Jesus offers something far more significant: the bread of eternal life. This spiritual nourishment is what truly satisfies and gives meaning to human life. Jesus invites people to work not for the perishable food but for that which endures to eternal life.

Finally, the text concludes with a reflection on the importance of believing in Jesus and seeking eternal life. Earthly things will always have an end, but communion with God is what brings true fullness and satisfaction. We are urged to trust in Jesus' promise and stop seeking satisfaction in the material, to focus instead on pursuing a deep and meaningful relationship with God, who is the source of all joy and fullness.

In theory, it is easy to answer the question of what we would choose if offered something eternal or something temporary, between something that would satisfy us and something that would temporarily alleviate our hunger. Surely we would all choose the diamond over the glass, the love of a true marriage over just a summer fling, eternal life over just a temporary pleasure... but that is theoretically... now let us ask ourselves what we are really choosing in our daily lives... when we go on vacation, do we continue to give God the first place? Do we continue choosing to honor God or do we seek it for ourselves, do we choose first to grow as children of God before growing professionally... we could continue with a long series of questions like these, but it would all boil down to whether we are choosing eternal life or just the temporary.

# Entre lo eterno y lo temporal...



En el evangelio de este fin de semana, nos habla sobre la continuación del milagro de los panes y los peces, donde Jesús confronta a las personas que lo buscan solo por el alimento que recibieron y no por creer en Él. Jesús resalta que muchas veces las personas se enfocan en deseos materiales y perecederos, como la comida, un automóvil, o una casa, pero estas cosas solo brindan satisfacción temporal. Él llama a buscar el pan de vida eterna y no las cosas pasajeras del mundo.

Jesús critica la mentalidad de buscar solo lo material, utilizando el ejemplo de cómo las personas se esfuerzan para obtener cosas que, aunque valiosas en un momento, eventualmente se desgastan o pierden su valor. Esta búsqueda constante de lo material nunca satisface completamente el corazón humano y nos deja siempre con una sensación de vacío.

El texto también refleja cómo, a lo largo del tiempo, nuestras prioridades han cambiado. Antes, las necesidades eran más básicas y centradas en la supervivencia diaria, mientras que hoy en día buscamos comodidad y seguridad en cosas materiales. Sin embargo, estas cosas no pueden llenar el vacío espiritual que solo Dios puede llenar. Jesús nos llama a reorientar nuestras prioridades hacia lo eterno.

Además, se menciona que aunque el pueblo de Israel recibió el maná en el desierto como alimento, Jesús ofrece algo mucho más significativo: el pan de vida eterna. Este alimento espiritual es lo que verdaderamente sacia y da sentido a la vida humana. Jesús invita a las personas a trabajar no por el alimento perecedero, sino por el que dura para la vida eterna.

Finalmente, el texto concluye con una reflexión sobre la importancia de creer en Jesús y buscar la vida eterna. Las cosas terrenales siempre tendrán fin, pero la comunión con Dios es lo que da verdadera plenitud y satisfacción. Se nos insta a confiar en la promesa de Jesús y a dejar de buscar satisfacción en lo material, para centrarnos en la búsqueda de una relación profunda y significativa con Dios, que es la fuente de toda alegría y plenitud.

En teoría, es fácil responder a la pregunta, sobre que es lo que escogeríamos si se nos ofreciera algo eterno o algo temporal, entre algo que nos saciara y algo que nos calmara temporalmente el hambre. Seguro que todos elegiríamos el diamante en vez del cristal, el amor de un matrimonio verdadero que de solo un verano, la vida eterna que solo un gusto temporal... pero eso es teóricamente... ahora preguntémosnos que es lo que realmente estamos eligiendo en nuestro diario vivir... cuando salimos de vacaciones, ¿seguimos dándole a Dios el primer lugar? Seguimos eligiendo darle honor a Dios o lo buscamos para nosotros mismos, elegimos primero el buscar crecer como hijos de Dios antes de crecer profesionalmente... pudiéramos seguir con una serie larga de preguntas como estas, pero todo se resumiría en que si estamos eligiendo la vida eterna o solo la temporal.

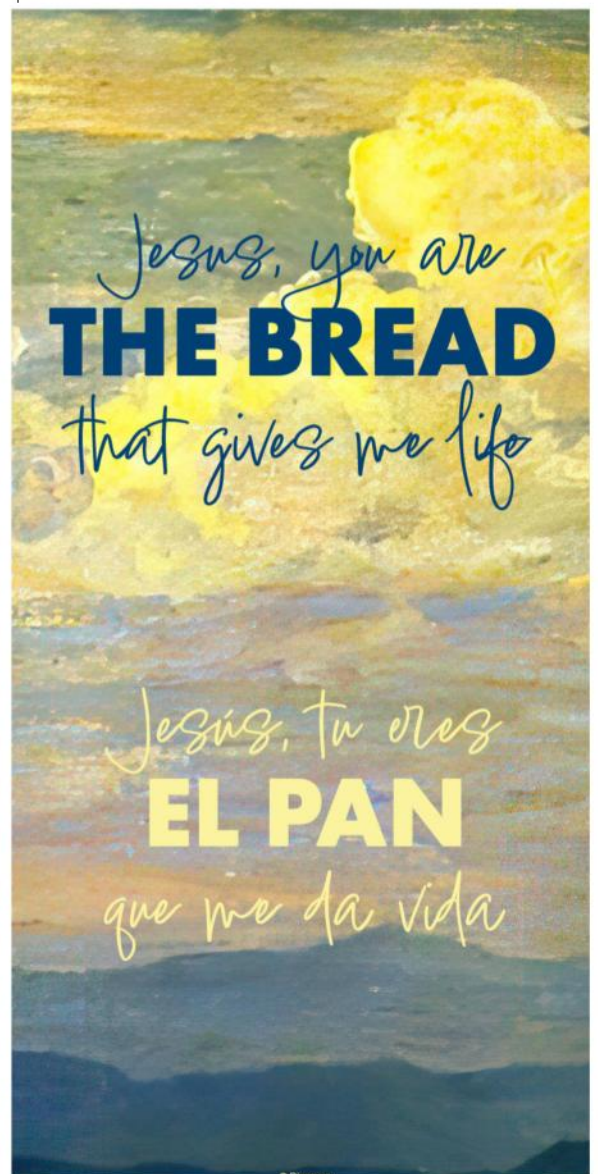
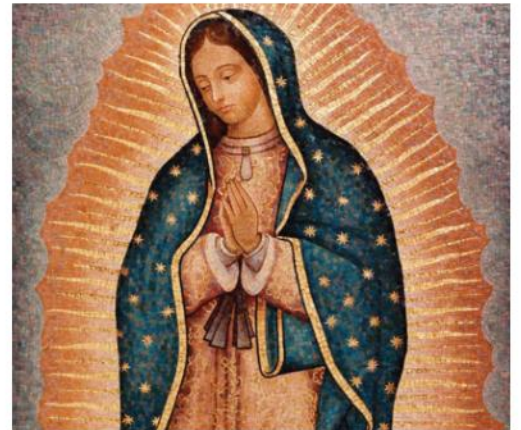

## DEACON'S CORNER



### Who's in charge?

A small boy was told to write his Christmas letter to Jesus, but when he started, he realized that he hadn't been very good that year. So, he took the figure of Mary out of the nativity scene and hid it under his bed in a shoebox, and then started his letter: "Dear Jesus, if you ever want to see your mother again, I want..."

Yes, it's amusing to think of a child trying to get a ransom from Jesus for Mary. But is it any different when someone says: "God, I will believe in you if only..." In a real way we are holding ourselves as ransom and demand that payment be made before we will believe. We expect to be able to bend God's will to our own by using His love for us as leverage, just as the small boy was trying to do with Jesus.

But God doesn't have to prove His love for us; He has done so already by Jesus's sacrifice on the cross. The full ransom has already been paid. The question is never if God loves us, but if we love Him. Do we love Him enough to give up our false gods of pride, pleasure, possessions and power? Do we love Him enough to bend our neck and bow down to His legitimate authority? The challenge in life is not for us to get God to bend His will to ours, but for us to conform our will to His.

Often in life things happen that we don't want, that we don't like and that we wish were otherwise, and we demand that God do something about it. But God is not a Genie in a bottle that is required to grant our wishes or our prayers. Yes, God loves us; but that doesn't mean we get to control Him. To accept God's love, we must accept it on His terms because He is God, and we are not.

### ¿Quién esta a cargo?

A un niño pequeño le dijeron que escribiera su carta de Navidad a Jesús, pero cuando empezó, se dio cuenta de que ese año no había sido muy bueno. Entonces, sacó la figura de María del belén y la escondió debajo de su cama en una caja de zapatos, y luego comenzó su carta: "Querido Jesús, si alguna vez quieres volver a ver a tu madre, quiero..."

Sí, es divertido pensar en un niño tratando de obtener un rescate de Jesús por María. Pero, ¿es diferente cuando alguien dice: "Dios, creeré en ti si tan solo..."? En realidad, nos consideramos como un rescate y exigimos que se haga el pago antes de creer. Pero Dios no tiene que demostrarnos su amor; Ya lo ha hecho mediante el sacrificio de Jesús en la cruz. Ya se ha pagado el rescate completo. La pregunta nunca es si Dios nos ama, sino si nosotros lo amamos. ¿Lo amamos lo suficiente como para renunciar a nuestros falsos dioses de orgullo, placer, posesiones y poder? ¿Lo amamos lo suficiente como para doblar nuestro cuello e inclinarnos ante su autoridad legítima? El desafío en la vida no es lograr que Dios doblegue su voluntad a la nuestra, sino que conformemos nuestra voluntad a la suya.

Muchas veces en la vida suceden cosas que no queremos, que no nos gustan y que desearíamos que fueran de otra manera, y exigimos que Dios haga algo al respecto. Pero Dios no es un genio en una botella que se requiere para conceder nuestros deseos o nuestras oraciones. Sí, Dios nos ama; pero eso no significa que podamos controlarlo. Para aceptar el amor de Dios, debemos aceptarlo en Sus términos porque Él es Dios y nosotros no.
