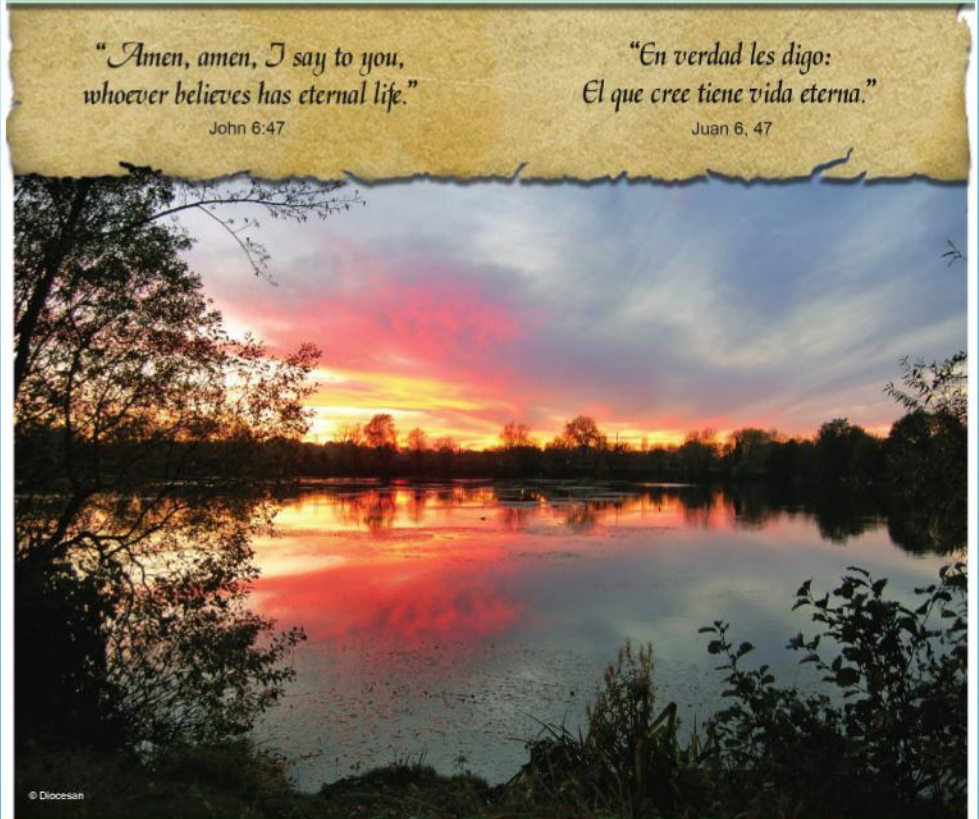

The Gospel Message for This Weekend

This weekend's Gospel continues the narrative of the miracle of the loaves and fishes, where Jesus challenges those following Him only for the physical sustenance they received. He urges them to seek the true "bread of life," emphasizing the necessity of desiring what is eternal and divine rather than material and temporary. This message underscores that material goods provide only temporary satisfaction, whereas spiritual nourishment offers lasting fulfillment and eternal life.

Jesus' Teaching on the Bread of Life

Jesus employs the image of manna in the desert, which, despite being miraculous, did not grant eternal life to those who consumed it. The discussion centers around the Jews' doubts about Jesus' claim to be the bread of life and His divine origin. Jesus urges His followers to accept His divinity and understand that faith transcends human logic.

Approach to the Eucharist

Believers are invited to approach the Eucharist with humility and a genuine need, recognizing it as the true spiritual sustenance. We should come to faith with a sincere desire to meet our spiritual needs before fully comprehending divine mysteries. Once we experience faith, we can more profoundly understand its significance.

Transformation through Communion

Communion with God through the Eucharist

transforms believers, enabling them to become "bread" for others. This theme highlights the importance of living in unity with Christ and reflecting His love in the world. It challenges the faithful not to live solely for themselves but to be sources of spiritual nourishment for those around them.

Communal and Personal Union

The importance of communion is addressed not only as a personal act but also as a communal union with God and others. Jesus, the bread of life, unites and transforms us, and the Eucharist serves as a continuous reminder of this truth. Communion is a sacred bond that should strengthen our relationships with God and our brothers and sisters in faith.

Demonstrating Faith through Actions

If we truly believe in Jesus' presence in the Eucharist, we must demonstrate it through our actions and dedication to prayer and worship. Recognizing the importance of being in Christ's presence and allowing His love to transform our lives is crucial. This belief should be reflected in our devotion and how we live our daily lives, showing others the profound impact of our faith.

El evangelio de este fin de semana continúa la narrativa del milagro de los panes y los peces, donde Jesús desafía a aquellos que lo siguen solo por haber recibido alimento físico, instándolos a **buscar el verdadero "pan de vida"**. Enfatiza la necesidad de desear lo eterno y divino en lugar de lo material y temporal. Este mensaje subraya que los bienes materiales solo satisfacen temporalmente, mientras que el alimento espiritual ofrece una satisfacción duradera y vida eterna.

Jesús utiliza la imagen del maná en el desierto, que aunque fue un milagro, no otorgó vida eterna a quienes lo consumieron. La discusión se centra en la duda de los judíos sobre la afirmación de Jesús de ser el pan de vida y su origen divino. **Jesús insta a sus seguidores a aceptar su divinidad** y entender que la fe va más allá de la lógica humana.

A través de un enfoque humilde y de necesidad, se invita a los creyentes a acercarse a **la Eucaristía como el verdadero alimento espiritual**. Debemos acercarnos a la fe: con un deseo genuino de satisfacer nuestras necesidades espirituales antes de intentar entender plenamente los misterios divinos. Una vez que experimentamos la fe, podemos comprender más profundamente su significado.

La comunión con Dios a través de la Eucaristía transforma a los creyentes, permitiéndoles

convertirse en "pan" para los demás, un tema que destaca la importancia de vivir en unión con Cristo y ser un reflejo de su amor en el mundo. Esto desafía a los fieles a no vivir únicamente para ellos mismos, sino a ser fuentes de alimento espiritual para aquellos a su alrededor.

Se aborda la importancia de la comunión, no solo como un acto personal, sino como una unión comunitaria con Dios y los demás. Jesús es el pan de vida que nos une y transforma, y la Eucaristía es un recordatorio continuo de esta verdad. La comunión es un vínculo sagrado que debe fortalecer nuestras relaciones con Dios y con nuestros hermanos en la fe.

Si realmente creemos en la presencia de Jesús en la Eucaristía, debemos demostrarlo a través de nuestras acciones y dedicación a la oración y adoración, reconociendo la importancia de estar en presencia de Cristo y dejar que su amor transforme nuestras vidas.

Faithful Catholics from all over the country came together at the Convention Center and Lucas Oil Stadium for the 5-day event in downtown Indy. The first day culminated with 60,000 people in adoration of the presence of Jesus in the Eucharist after the four routes of the National Eucharistic pilgrimage converged at the stadium. You could hear a pin drop. The days continued with speakers, adoration, confessions, Holy Masses and other events. People waited in long lines at times for hours, however, no one ever seemed cranky or upset. Instead, people

talked to one another and shared their stories. The friendliness and kindness in everyone was inspiring. People were so kind, so generous and so full of love. There was so much pure joy in everyone we met that we both felt like we were experiencing a little taste of what heaven must be like. We were amazed by the number of young families and young adults that attended. We were also struck by the large number of young seminarians and priests as well as the countless number of young religious sisters. Everywhere we looked, we saw people on fire for Jesus and it was contagious. Hundreds of priests heard confessions every day and the lines were never short. Perpetual adoration was held in the Church across from the convention center. We were lucky to get in on the first day because after that the church was constantly full and had long lines of people waiting to get in. We were also fortunate to witness a Eucharistic procession through the streets of Indianapolis with tens of thousands lining the streets adoring Jesus. It was really inspiring to be around so many people with a thirst for Jesus. We can't wait for the next Congress! If you did not get a chance to attend, you can still watch and listen to most of the speakers on EWTN or Relevant Radio.

DEACON'S CORNER

The Tenth National Eucharistic Congress

The US Catholic Bishops held the first National Eucharistic Congress in over eighty years in Indianapolis last month. By all accounts it was a moving, exciting and inspiring experience for the more than 60,000 Catholics that were able to attend. Many said the most powerful moments were the moments of adoration in Lucas Oil Stadium, when everybody was on their knees and adoring the Lord in praise and in silence. Try to imagine a football stadium, filled to capacity, the lights are out, it's dark, and there's just the light shining on the monstrance. And the place is so quiet...50,000 people there are adoring Our Lord in silence.



But then, there were the processions which carried Christ out into the streets of the city. People in offices and stores seeing tens of thousands of people in procession, bring Christ out into the world. It wasn't just an internal experience. "It was going out of ourselves and out into the streets to proclaim Christ is risen, He's alive, He loves you and to present Him to everyone who will listen" said one attendee.

People in the convention center were also caught up in spontaneous devotion as the liturgical team needed to move the Blessed Sacrament throughout the convention center for different periods of adoration. But there weren't enough backways, and the halls were crowded with people moving between break-out sessions; so Jesus would be taken right through the crowd. People would shout "Jesus is coming!" and drop to their knees and pray while the Blessed Sacrament passed by.

I'm sure the fruit of this Congress will be wonderful indeed.

RINCON DEL DIACONO

El Décimo Congreso Eucarístico Nacional

Los obispos católicos de Estados Unidos celebraron el mes pasado en Indianápolis el primer Congreso Eucarístico Nacional en más de ochenta años. Según todos los indicios, fue una experiencia conmovedora, emocionante e inspiradora para los más de 60.000 católicos que pudieron asistir. Muchos dijeron que los momentos más poderosos fueron los momentos de adoración en el estadio Lucas Oil, cuando todos estaban de rodillas y adoraban al Señor en alabanza y en silencio. Trate de imaginar un estadio de fútbol lleno al máximo, las luces apagadas, está oscuro y solo hay una luz brillando en la custodia. Y el lugar es tan tranquilo... 50.000 personas allí están adorando a Nuestro Señor en silencio.

Pero luego estaban las procesiones que llevaban a Cristo por las calles de la ciudad. La gente en oficinas y tiendas al ver a decenas de miles de personas en procesión, trae a Cristo al mundo. No fue sólo una experiencia interna. "Fue salir de nosotros mismos y salir a las calles para proclamar que Cristo ha resucitado, está vivo, te ama y presentarlo a todos los que escuchen", dijo un asistente.



La gente en el centro de convenciones también quedó atrapada en una devoción espontánea ya que el equipo litúrgico necesitaba mover el Santísimo Sacramento por todo el centro de convenciones para diferentes períodos de adoración. Pero no había suficientes pasillos y los pasillos estaban llenos de gente que se movía entre las sesiones de trabajo; entonces Jesús sería llevado entre la multitud. La gente gritaba "¡Jesús viene!" y caer de rodillas y orar mientras pasaba el Santísimo Sacramento.

Estoy seguro de que el fruto de este Congreso será realmente maravilloso.
