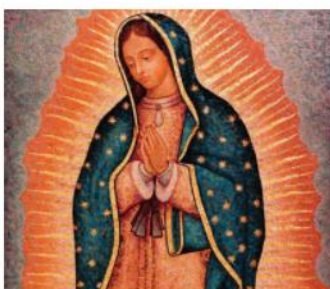

"The Power of Listening: A Reflection on Influence, Faith, and Transformation"

Today, I would like to share a personal experience that has prompted deep reflection. I have been fortunate to live in various cities, both in Mexico and the United States, and this diversity of locations has exposed me to a range of accents and speech patterns. I recall a particular day in Mexico City when a lady asked me why I spoke with a "sing-song" tone. Her question amused me because, until that moment, I hadn't realized how different accents can subtly influence our manner of speaking based on where we've been and whom we've interacted with.

This observation led me to ponder the incredible human capacity for imitation. Indeed, we learn to speak by imitating what we hear. For instance, a child learns to speak the language spoken in their environment. This realization highlights the importance of being mindful of the company we keep and the things we listen to because, often unconsciously, we begin to emulate those behaviors and attitudes.

This idea is closely tied to today's Gospel, where Jesus heals a deaf and mute man. As I reflected on this passage, I understood that the man's problem was not merely physical; he had stopped hearing properly and, as a result, could not speak clearly. Jesus took him aside from the crowd to communicate with him more personally and effectively. This suggests to me that, at times, we need to distance ourselves from noise and distractions to hear God's voice more clearly.

In our daily lives, negative actions often stem from what we are hearing. If we surround ourselves with negative influences, we will eventually start speaking and acting in that manner. It is crucial to carefully choose what we allow into our hearts and minds because it directly affects how we live and interact with others.

Jesus speaks to each of us personally. Although His word is proclaimed worldwide, the message He has for you and me is unique. We must be willing to listen and allow His message to transform our lives. If our actions are not correct, perhaps it is because we are not truly listening to what He is telling us.

Lastly, I reflect on how the news and the media we consume daily can influence our mood and outlook on life. Instead of focusing on negative news, we should pay more attention to the Good News of the Gospel, which fills us with peace and joy, even amid difficulties. Let us allow Jesus to take us aside and speak to us because nothing is more comforting than receiving a word from God that transforms our lives.

Hoy quiero compartirles una experiencia personal que me hizo reflexionar profundamente. He tenido la fortuna de vivir en muchas ciudades, tanto en México como en Estados Unidos, y esta diversidad de lugares me ha expuesto a una variedad de acentos y formas de hablar. Recuerdo en particular un día en la Ciudad de México, cuando una señora me preguntó por qué hablaba "cantadito". Me hizo reír porque, hasta ese momento, yo no me había dado cuenta de cómo los diferentes acentos se van pegando a nosotros, dependiendo de dónde hemos estado y con quién hemos hablado.

Esto me llevó a pensar en la increíble capacidad que tenemos los seres humanos para imitar lo que vemos y escuchamos. De hecho, aprendemos a hablar por imitación. Un niño, por ejemplo, aprende a hablar el idioma que escucha en su entorno. Esto me hizo reflexionar sobre la importancia de cuidar con quién nos relacionamos y qué escuchamos, porque, sin darnos cuenta, comenzamos a imitar esos comportamientos y actitudes.


Esta idea se conecta con el Evangelio del día de hoy, donde Jesús sana a un hombre sordo y tartamudo. Al leer este pasaje, me di cuenta de que el problema de este hombre no era simplemente físico; había dejado de escuchar bien y, por lo tanto, no podía hablar correctamente. Jesús lo aparta de la multitud para poder comunicarse con él de una manera más personal y efectiva. Esto me hace pensar en cómo, a veces, necesitamos alejarnos del ruido y las distracciones para poder escuchar la voz de Dios con claridad.

En nuestra vida diaria, muchas veces nuestras acciones negativas son el resultado de lo que estamos escuchando. Si escuchamos cosas malas, eventualmente empezaremos a hablar y actuar de esa manera. Es crucial que seleccionemos cuidadosamente lo que dejamos entrar en nuestro corazón y mente, porque esto afecta cómo vivimos y nos relacionamos con los demás.

Jesús nos habla a cada uno de nosotros de manera personal. Aunque su palabra se proclama en todo el mundo, el mensaje que tiene para ti y para mí es único. Debemos estar dispuestos a escucharle y permitir que su mensaje transforme nuestras vidas. Si nuestras acciones no son las correctas, tal vez sea porque no estamos escuchando bien lo que Él nos dice.

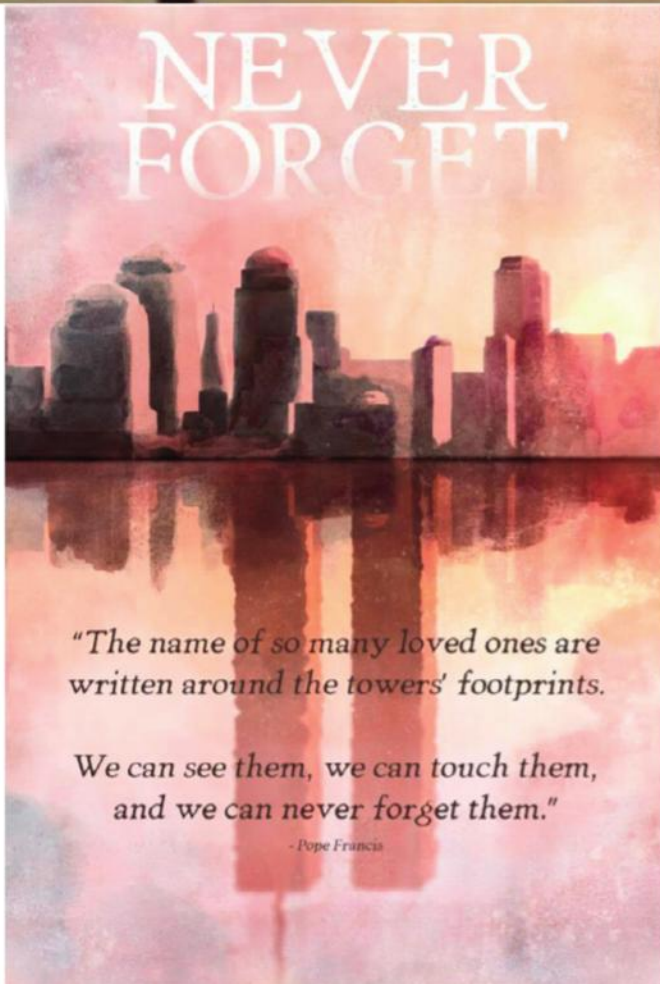
Finalmente, reflexiono sobre cómo las noticias y lo que consumimos diariamente pueden influir en nuestro estado de ánimo y en nuestra perspectiva de vida. En lugar de enfocarnos en las malas noticias, deberíamos prestar más atención a las buenas noticias del Evangelio, que nos llenan de paz y alegría, incluso en medio de las dificultades. Dejemos que Jesús nos tome aparte y nos hable, porque no hay nada más reconfortante que recibir una palabra de Dios que transforme nuestra vida.

DEACON'S CORNER

In today's Gospel Jesus restores hearing and speech to a deaf man with a speech impediment. Jesus looks up to heaven, groans and says to the man *ephphatha* (an Aramaic word) which means **be opened**.

Jesus tells the man not to tell anyone about this healing. It is not yet the time for Jesus' identity and mission to be revealed. In spite of what Jesus tells him the man tells everyone he can find. People are astonished at what Jesus has done. The touching of the man's ears and lips harkens back to God putting a burning coal on the lips of the prophet Isaiah to purify Isaiah for his ministry

(Is. 6:7-8). It also looks forward to the ephphatha rite, performed at the discretion of the priest or deacon, in our current baptism ritual. After the baptism of a child, the deacon or priest touches the ears and mouth of the child with his thumb and says: ***May the Lord who made the deaf to hear and the mute to speak, grant that you may soon receive His word with your ears and profess the faith with your lips, to the glory and praise of God the Father. If there are many children to be baptized the prayer is said once, omitting the touching of the ears and mouth.***

Jesus gave us ears to hear and lips to proclaim the truth of our faith. May we always hear His words and boldly profess the faith with our lips to the glory of God!

RINCON DEL DIACONO

En el evangelio de hoy, Jesús devuelve la audición y el habla a un hombre sordo con impedimento del habla. Jesús mira al cielo, gime y le dice al hombre ***Effetá*** (palabra aramea) que significa **abrirse**.

Jesús le dice al hombre que no le cuente a nadie sobre esta curación. Aún no es el momento que sea revelada la identidad y la misión de Jesús. A pesar de lo que Jesús le dice, el hombre se lo cuenta a todos los que encuentra. La gente está asombrada de lo que Jesús ha hecho. El toque de los oídos y los labios del hombre nos recuerda a Dios poniendo un carbón encendido en los labios del profeta Isaías para purificarlo para su ministerio (Isaías 6:7-8). También espera con interés el rito del ephphatha, realizado a discreción del sacerdote o diácono, en nuestro ritual de bautismo actual. Después del bautismo de un niño, el diácono o sacerdote toca los oídos y la

boca del niño con el pulgar y dice: ***El Señor Jesús, que hizo oír a los sordos y hablar a los mudos, te concede, a su tiempo, escuchar su palabra y profesar la fe, para alabanza y gloria de Dios Padre.*** Si hay muchos niños a bautizar la oración se dice una vez, omitiendo tocar los oídos y la boca.

Jesús nos dio oídos para oír y labios para proclamar la verdad de nuestra fe. Siempre escuchamos sus palabras y profesamos con valentía la fe con nuestros labios para gloria de Dios.
