Beware of the scribes, who like to go around in long robes and accept greetings in the marketplaces, seats of honor in synagogues, and places of honor at banquets.



Jesus' Warning about Hypocrisy

Jesus begins the gospel with a clear and strong warning, saying “Beware” of the scribes. This warning goes beyond a simple precaution; it is an urgent reminder not to follow their vain behaviors. The scribes sought public recognition, dressed ostentatiously, and took the best seats in synagogues and banquets. Jesus points out that these attitudes are not only frivolous but also dangerous because they can influence and distort our inner character.

The Widow and Her Sincere Generosity

In contrast, the gospel presents a poor widow who offers two small coins of little value, a gesture that Jesus highlights as more valuable than the abundant contributions of the wealthy. This is because she gave all she had to live on, demonstrating pure and selfless generosity. The widow’s action is an example of authenticity and total commitment, opposite to the hypocrisy of the scribes who only seek to appear pious without true dedication.

Appearances in Modern Society

Jesus' warning remains relevant today, in a society where social media fosters the pursuit of recognition and the construction of perfect images. People often use filters and show only what they want others to see, creating a gap between how they appear and who they truly are. This preoccupation with appearances distances us from true happiness, which Jesus describes as a life built sincerely from within.

The Value of Giving Everything

Jesus' message also invites us to reflect on our own capacity for giving. It is not just about material possessions but about how we give our best in our relationships and commitments. In marriage, family, and community, giving 100% is essential. Holding back can lead to an empty and superficial life, like that of the scribes. True fulfillment comes when we give everything, as the widow did, who, despite her poverty, gave all she had.

Living with Authenticity and Fulfillment

The gospel concludes with a call to live without masks and to give our best at all times. True peace and happiness are not based on what we have or how others see us but in total and genuine giving. Jesus encourages us to be whole and complete people, capable of giving that extra when we think we have already given everything. Only then will we achieve an extraordinary life, where our actions not only shine before others but also nourish our own hearts.

Cuidado con la hipocresía

Advertencia de Jesús sobre la Hipocresía

Jesús comienza el evangelio con una advertencia clara y contundente, diciendo “cuidado” con los escribas. Este llamado de atención va más allá de una simple precaución; es un recordatorio urgente de no seguir sus comportamientos vanidosos. Los escribas buscaban reconocimiento público, vestían con ostentación y ocupaban los primeros lugares en las sinagogas y banquetes. Jesús señala que estas actitudes no solo son frívolas, sino también peligrosas, porque pueden influir y deformar nuestro carácter interior.

La Viuda y su Generosidad Sincera

En contraste, el evangelio presenta a una viuda pobre que ofrece dos moneditas de escaso valor, un gesto que Jesús destaca como más valioso que las contribuciones abundantes de los ricos. Esto es porque ella entregó todo lo que tenía para vivir, demostrando una generosidad pura y desinteresada. La acción de la viuda es un ejemplo de autenticidad y entrega total, lo opuesto a la hipocresía de los escribas, que solo buscan lucir piadosos sin un verdadero compromiso.

Las Apariencias en la Sociedad Actual

La advertencia de Jesús se mantiene relevante hoy en día, en una sociedad donde las redes sociales fomentan la búsqueda de reconocimiento y la construcción de imágenes perfectas. Las personas a menudo recurren a filtros y muestran solo lo que quieren que los demás vean, creando una distancia entre lo que aparentan y lo que realmente son. Esta preocupación por las apariencias nos aleja de la

felicidad verdadera, que Jesús describe como una vida sincera y construida desde adentro.

El Valor de Darlo Todo

El mensaje de Jesús también nos invita a reflexionar sobre nuestra propia capacidad de entrega. No se trata solo de bienes materiales, sino de cómo damos lo mejor de nosotros en nuestras relaciones y compromisos. En el matrimonio, la familia y la comunidad, dar el 100% es esencial. Retener algo de nosotros mismos puede llevarnos a una vida vacía y superficial, como la de los escribas. La verdadera plenitud se encuentra cuando entregamos todo, como lo hizo la viuda que, aun en su pobreza, dio todo lo que tenía.

Vivir con Autenticidad y Plenitud

El evangelio concluye con un llamado a vivir sin máscaras y a dar lo mejor de nosotros en todo momento. La verdadera paz y felicidad no se basan en lo que tenemos ni en cómo nos ven los demás, sino en una entrega total y genuina. Jesús nos anima a ser personas íntegras y completas, capaces de dar un extra cuando ya creemos haberlo dado todo. Solo así alcanzaremos una vida extraordinaria, donde nuestras acciones no solo brillan ante los demás, sino que también enriquecen nuestro corazón.

We want to live all the evangelical (Gospel) values and the fruits of the Spirit. We will intentionally reflect in this time of renewal on the following values.

UNITY. We know that without it, all evangelization efforts would be useless. The more open we are to diversity, the more docile we will be to unity.

As Jesus said, "So that they may all be one. Like you, Father, in me and I in you, may they also be one in us, so that the world may believe that you have sent me" (John, 17, 20).

THANKFULNESS. We are able to recognize and be grateful in all circumstances for the blessings that God gives us.

"In all circumstances give thanks, for this is the will of God for you in Christ Jesus." 1 Thessalonians 5:18

HUMILITY. This virtue enables us to acknowledge the gifts we have received from God and to use them for Him with prudential judgment.

"Do nothing out of rivalry, or out of vainglory, but with humility, each considering the others as superior to himself, each seeking not his own interest but that of others" (Philippians 2:3-4).

FAITH. The gift we have received from God through the Church to be exercised in our lives through good works.

"For you have been saved by grace through faith; and this does not come from you, but is a gift of God; it does not come from works, so that no one can boast. Indeed, we are his workmanship: created in Christ Jesus, in order for the good works that God ordained beforehand that we are to practice" (Ephesians 2:8-10).

SUSTAINABILITY. Protect and grow the legacy handed down to us and pass that legacy on to our children.

"So that neither the one who plants is something, nor the one who waters, but God who makes it grow. And the one who plants and the one who waters are the same thing; although each one will receive the salary according to his own work, since we are God's co-workers and you, God's field, God's edification. According to the grace of God that was given me, I, as a good architect, laid the foundation, and someone else builds on it. Look how each one builds!" (1 Corinthians 3:7-10).

SPIRITUALITY. We recognize that without Him we are nothing, and that with Him we can witness even miracles in our lives and in our community.

"Abide in me, as I in you. Just as the branch cannot bear fruit by itself, if it does not remain in the vine; so neither can you if you do not remain in me" (John, 15:4).

This week we continue contemplating the Word of God but transition to the Gospel of John. John's gospel is considered to be the most contemplative. He is frequently depicted as an eagle. In ancient times the eagle was considered the king of the birds as it soared high in the heavens. It was believed to be able to look straight into the sun. Thus, the most beloved Apostle John, who rested upon the chest of Christ and deeply contemplated the very heart of God, passes on for Christians the most contemplative account of Christ's life.

It is not possible to come close to exhausting the deep meaning of this Gospel in just two short sessions, but nonetheless we will enter in.
