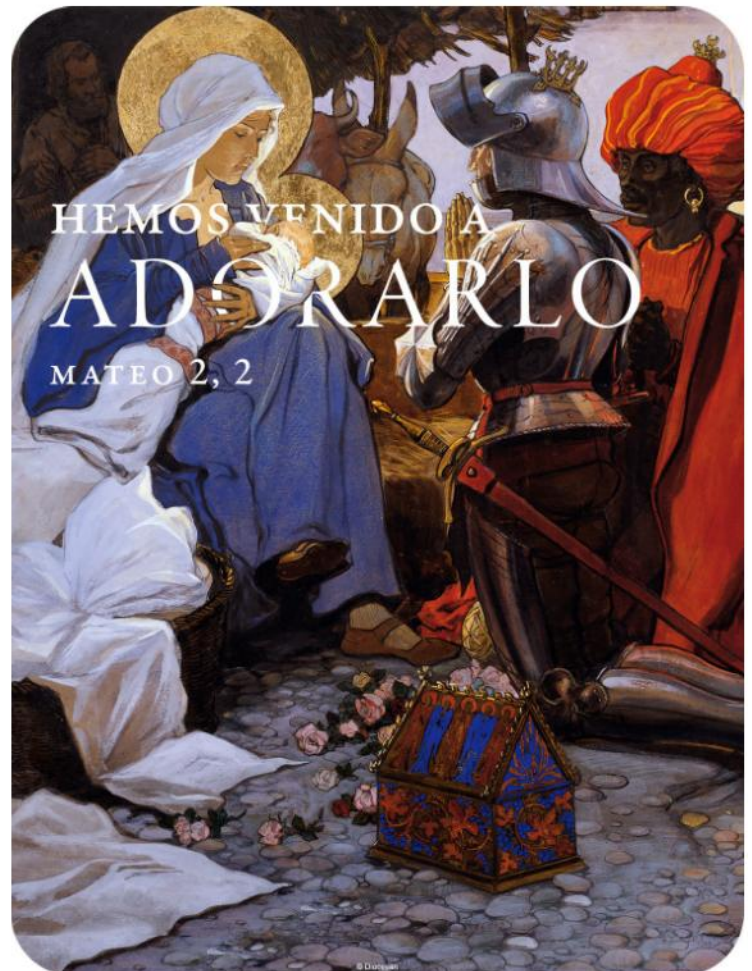

Where is the newborn king?

We Are All Seeking Jesus: Contrasting Intentions

The text begins by presenting a fundamental truth: we are all seeking Jesus, albeit with different intentions. Some seek Him to worship, while others, like King Herod, harbor destructive motives. This contrast can be applied to our pursuits in life—happiness, love, and peace. Often, we seek these virtues, but depending on our motivations and actions, we may either fully embrace them or inadvertently extinguish them.

The Story of the Magi from the East

The Gospel recounts how the Magi, guided by a star, search for the newborn King of the Jews. Their aim is to worship Him, whereas Herod, driven by envy and fear, perceives the child as a threat and schemes to eliminate Him. This narrative highlights the distinction between those who seek truth to surrender to it and those who, blinded by self-interest, attempt to manipulate or destroy it.

True Light Versus Artificial Lights

Initially guided by the star, the Magi lose their way upon reaching Jerusalem, misled by the city's artificial lights and their human assumptions of finding a king in a palace. Their detour prompts them to consult Scripture, which redirects them to Bethlehem. This episode reminds us that our expectations and biases can often lead us astray, but the Word of God is a reliable compass that brings us back to the right path.

Encountering Peace and Joy

When the Magi regain their direction, they experience immense joy upon seeing the star again

and arriving at the child's location. This encounter symbolizes the peace and happiness that come from sincerely seeking God. Jesus becomes the source of a profound joy that transcends challenges and leads to a transformative encounter.

The Danger of Missteps and the Need for Reconciliation

In life, we may be tempted by pleasures, power, or vanity, diverting us from genuine love, peace, and happiness. Like the Magi, we must acknowledge our mistakes and return to the right path. Reconciliation is crucial—not only with God but also in our human relationships—strengthening love and friendship after moments of failure.

The Light of Faith as a Constant Guide

The final message invites us to follow the unwavering and true light of faith, represented by the star of Bethlehem. In a world filled with enticing yet hollow promises, faith in Jesus serves as our guide, offering lasting peace. Worshiping Jesus and living according to His Word is the key to finding the love and happiness we seek. Ultimately, our mission is to set aside personal whims, place our trust in God, and deepen our faith to remain steadfast on the right path.

Todos Buscamos a Jesús: El Contraste de las Intenciones

El texto comienza planteando una verdad fundamental: todos buscamos a Jesús, aunque con intenciones diferentes. Algunos lo buscan para adorarlo y otros, como el Rey Herodes, con deseos destructivos. Este contraste puede aplicarse a nuestras búsquedas en la vida: felicidad, amor y paz. A menudo, buscamos estas virtudes, pero según nuestras motivaciones y acciones, podemos vivirlas plenamente o acabar extinguiéndolas.

El Relato de los Magos de Oriente

El Evangelio narra cómo los magos de Oriente, guiados por una estrella, buscan al recién nacido Rey de los Judíos. Su objetivo era adorarlo, pero Herodes, movido por la envidia y el miedo, ve en el niño una amenaza y trama eliminarlo. Esta historia resalta el contraste entre quienes buscan la verdad para rendirse a ella y quienes, cegados por sus intereses, intentan manipularla o destruirla.

La Luz Verdadera Frente a las Luces Artificiales

Los magos, aunque inicialmente siguen la estrella, se desvían al llegar a Jerusalén, confundidos por las luces artificiales de la ciudad y las expectativas humanas de encontrar a un rey en un palacio. Este error les lleva a consultar las Escrituras, que los reorientan hacia Belén. Este episodio nos recuerda que muchas veces nuestras expectativas y prejuicios pueden alejarnos de la verdad, pero la Palabra de Dios siempre puede devolvernos al camino correcto.

El Encuentro con la Paz y la Alegría

Al recuperar su camino, los magos experimentan una inmensa alegría al ver nuevamente la estrella y llegar al

lugar donde estaba el niño. Este encuentro simboliza la paz y la felicidad que hallamos cuando retomamos nuestra búsqueda sincera de Dios. Jesús se convierte en la fuente de una alegría que trasciende las dificultades y nos lleva a un encuentro transformador.

El Peligro de los Desvíos y la Necesidad de Reconciliación

En la vida, podemos ser seducidos por placeres, poder o vanidad, desviándonos del amor, la paz y la felicidad auténticos. Como los magos, necesitamos reconocer nuestros errores y volver al camino correcto. La reconciliación es clave, no solo con Dios, sino también en nuestras relaciones humanas, ya que fortalece el amor y la amistad después de las caídas.

La Luz de la Fe Como Guía Permanente

El mensaje final es una invitación a seguir la luz constante y verdadera de la fe, simbolizada en la estrella de Belén. En un mundo lleno de reflectores que prometen soluciones fáciles pero terminan vacíos, la fe en Jesús nos orienta y nos ofrece una paz duradera. Adorar a Jesús y vivir según su Palabra es la clave para encontrar el amor y la felicidad que buscamos. Al final, nuestra misión es abandonar los caprichos personales, confiar plenamente en Dios y profundizar en nuestra fe para no desviarnos del camino.

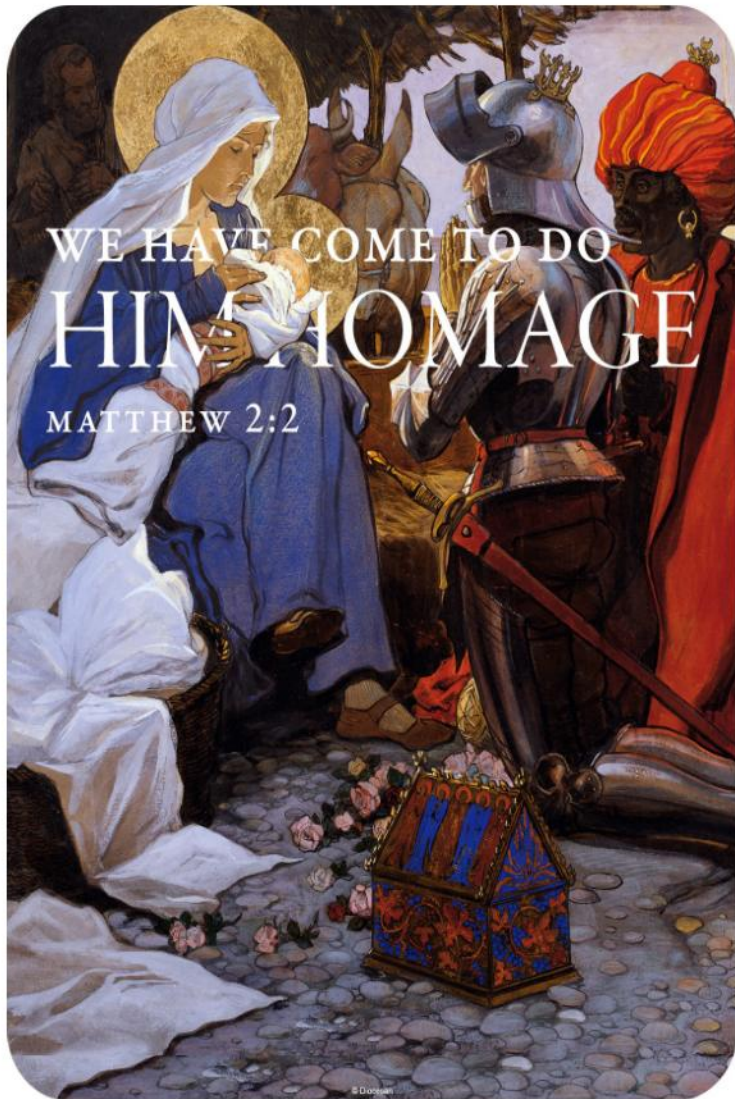

DEACON'S CORNER

The Elephant

There is a story about a group of blind men who try to examine an elephant and then describe the animal. One examines the animal's foot and says the elephant is like the trunk of a tree. One examines the elephant's trunk and says it's like a snake. As others examine the ear, skin, tusk, and tail they each come up with very different understandings of an elephant.

We are in the middle of the Christmas season, and we joyfully reflect on how the second person of the Holy Trinity took upon himself our humanity. The Church gives us different seasons to reflect on different aspects of our faith. Soon we will start Lent, where instead of rejoicing we will be somberly reflecting on our failings and how the things of this world can lead us astray.

It is important to study and seek better understanding of each aspect of our faith; just as if you really want to understand about elephants, you should study the foot, tusk, trunk, etc. of the beast. But just as with the elephant, this needs to be in the context of understanding at its core, the elephant is a really big animal, so also as we study and practice each aspect of our faith, we need to do so in the context of the totality of our faith.

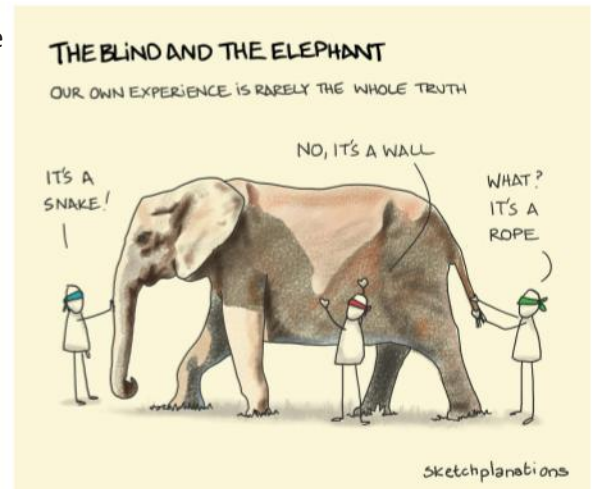
So yes, it's important to pray and to study scripture and to serve others in need. It's important to come to mass and to receive absolution for our sins. It's important to do all these things, and more. But never losing sight of the core truth of our faith, lest we become like the blind men and the elephant. We must never lose sight of the elephant in the room; that God loves you, that he cares for you, and he wants you back.

RINCON DEL DIACONO

El elefante

Hay una historia sobre un grupo de hombres ciegos que tratan de examinar un elefante y luego describen al animal. Uno examina la pata del animal y dice que el elefante es como el tronco de un árbol. Otro examina la trompa del elefante y dice que es como una serpiente. Mientras otros examinan la oreja, la piel, el colmillo y la cola, cada uno llega a una interpretación muy diferente de lo que es un elefante.



Estamos en medio de la temporada navideña y reflexionamos con alegría sobre cómo la segunda persona de la Santísima Trinidad asumió nuestra humanidad. La Iglesia nos da diferentes temporadas para reflexionar sobre diferentes aspectos de nuestra fe. Pronto comenzaremos la Cuaresma, donde en lugar de regocijarnos, reflexionaremos sombríamente sobre nuestras fallas y cómo las cosas de este mundo pueden llevarnos por mal camino.

Es importante estudiar y buscar una mejor comprensión de cada aspecto de nuestra fe; así como si realmente quieres entender sobre los elefantes, debes estudiar la pata, el colmillo, la trompa, etc. de la bestia. Pero, al igual que con el elefante, esto debe hacerse en el contexto de una comprensión básica: el elefante es un animal muy grande, por lo que también cuando estudiamos y practicamos cada aspecto de nuestra fe, debemos hacerlo en el contexto de la totalidad de nuestra fe.

Así que sí, es importante orar y estudiar las Escrituras y servir a los necesitados. Es importante asistir a misa y recibir la absolución de nuestros pecados. Es importante hacer todas estas cosas y más. Pero nunca debemos perder de vista la verdad fundamental de nuestra fe, para no convertirnos en los ciegos y el elefante. Nunca debemos perder de vista al elefante en la habitación: que Dios te ama, que se preocupa por ti y quiere que regreses.
