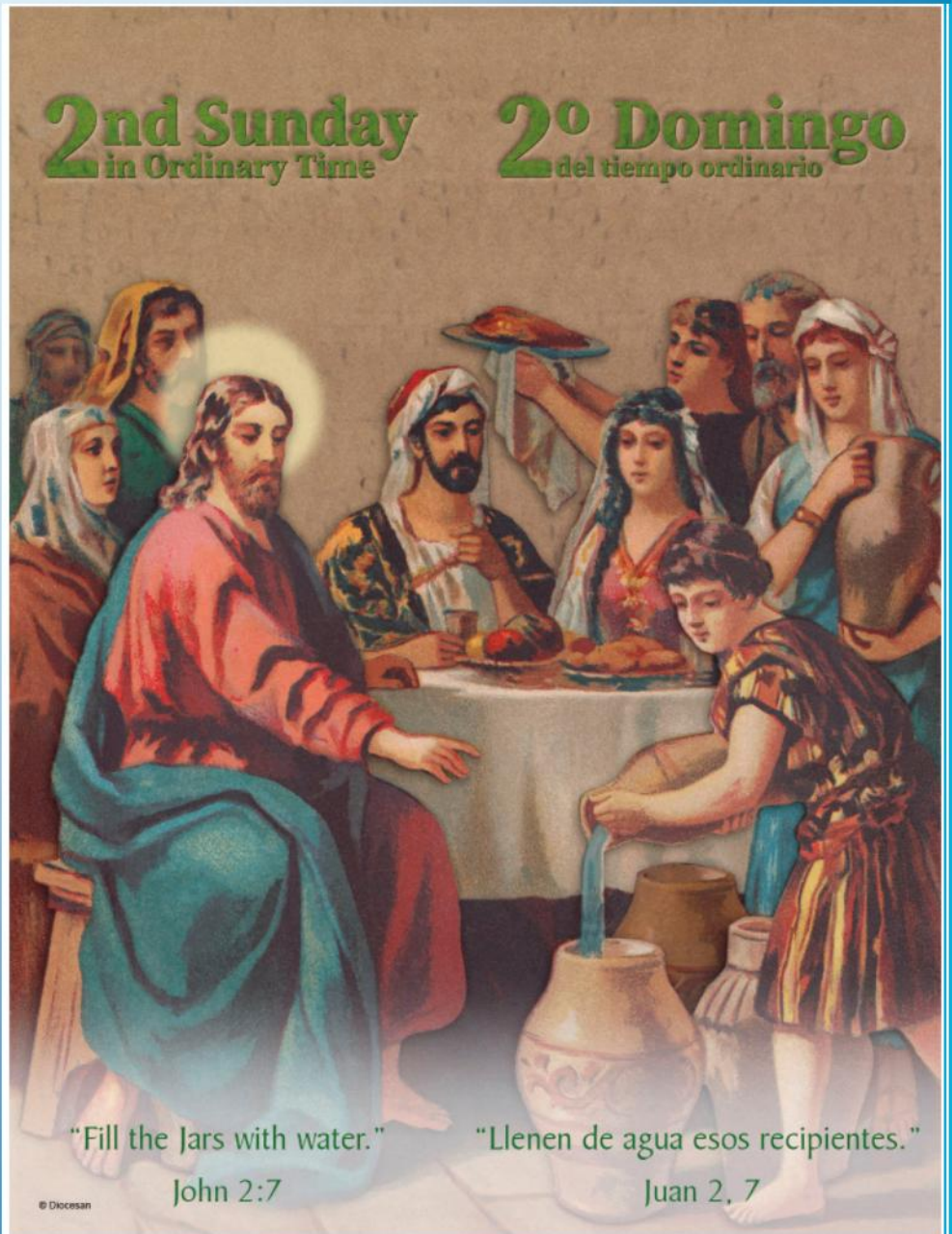

Reflection on Our Invitations

The text begins by questioning whom we invite to our celebrations and, more deeply, into our lives. It reflects on how receiving an invitation can be an honor while emphasizing the importance of wisely choosing our guests. It uses the example of the Gospel narrative of the Wedding at Cana, where Jesus, Mary, and the disciples were among the invitees. This choice was not coincidental but crucial, as Jesus' presence was key to resolving a crisis—the lack of wine.

The Symbolism of Wine

In Jewish culture, wine symbolizes joy, prosperity, and well-being, and its absence at a wedding would have been considered an ill omen. Jesus performed His first miracle by turning water into wine, restoring not only the drink but also hope, happiness, and fullness to the attendees. This act signifies that, even in times of difficulty, if Jesus is present, joy and life can be renewed.

The Importance of Inviting Jesus

The text highlights the necessity of inviting Jesus into our lives. His presence ensures that there will always be "wine," representing joy, strength, and hope.

Having Jesus does not mean the absence of challenges but the ability to face them with serenity and confidence. Additionally, it encourages us to reflect on who holds the central place in our hearts and to consider how we can include God in all our activities and decisions.

The Challenge of Living with Faith

Living as committed Christians is not always easy, but the text reminds us that living without God is even more difficult. Problems are inevitable, but with Jesus in our lives, they become opportunities to strengthen our faith and hope. The text reassures us that walking with Jesus gives us the strength to face any adversity instead of yielding to challenges.

The Call to Deepen in the Word

Finally, the text calls us to read and meditate on the Bible as a means of strengthening our relationship with God. Listening to and reading the Word of God is essential to nourish our faith and find direction in times of uncertainty.

Reflexión sobre nuestras invitaciones

El texto inicia cuestionándonos sobre a quiénes invitamos a nuestras fiestas y, más profundamente, a nuestra vida. Reflexiona sobre cómo recibir una invitación puede ser un honor, pero también destaca la importancia de elegir sabiamente a los invitados. Utiliza como ejemplo el Evangelio que narra las bodas de Caná, donde Jesús, María y los discípulos fueron parte de los invitados. Esta selección no fue casual, sino fundamental, ya que la presencia de Jesús fue clave para resolver una crisis: la falta de vino.

El simbolismo del vino

En la cultura judía, el vino representa alegría, prosperidad y bienestar, y su ausencia en una boda habría significado un mal augurio. Jesús realiza su primer milagro al convertir el agua en vino, devolviendo no solo la bebida, sino también la esperanza, la felicidad y la plenitud a los asistentes. Este acto simboliza que, incluso en los momentos de dificultad, si Jesús está presente, la alegría y la vida pueden renovarse.

La importancia de invitar a Jesús

El texto enfatiza la necesidad de invitar a Jesús a nuestra vida. Su presencia garantiza que siempre habrá "vino", es decir, alegría, fortaleza y esperanza.

Tener a Jesús no significa ausencia de problemas, sino la capacidad de enfrentarlos con serenidad y confianza. Además, se nos invita a reflexionar sobre quién ocupa el lugar principal en nuestro corazón y a considerar cómo podemos incluir a Dios en todas nuestras actividades y decisiones.

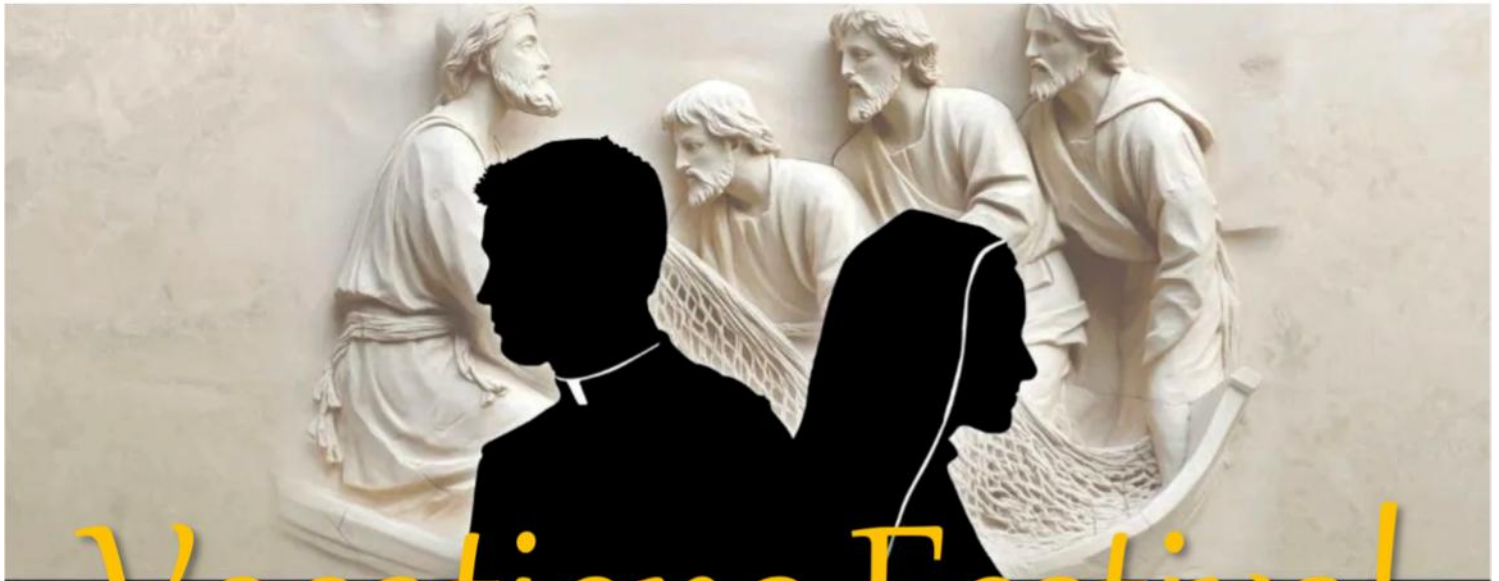
El desafío de vivir con fe

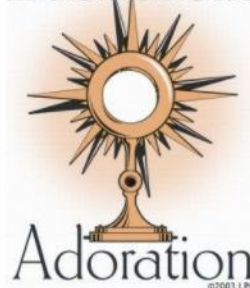

DEACON'S CORNER

They have no wine

This week we celebrate the 2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time. This year our gospel reading comes from the gospel of John and tells of the wedding in Cana. Mary comes to Jesus and tells him they are out of wine. In his answer He seems to imply that this isn't his problem. But Mary wants him to do something about it, and with complete confidence that he will not refuse her, she doesn't say another word to him, but simply instructs the servants to "do whatever he tells you".

We can take from this scene three things. First, that going to Mary and asking for her gentle intercession with her Son is very likely to succeed. Jesus never wants to refuse her anything. It's been said that Jesus is the head of the church, but Mary is the neck that can turn the head.

Second, her final words to the servants are the last words she speaks in scripture, and she gives us the best possible advice for anyone to follow. Simply by doing whatever her Son tells us is the way to become a saint and assure our place in heaven.

Lastly, Jesus's response seems a bit harsh, even rude, but Jesus and Mary know each other so well that He is probably saying something else. He is now in his thirties. He must have shared with his mother, by now, how his life will lead to the cross, if only to prepare her for what she would experience. With his response "My time has not yet come" he really seems to be asking her, "You know where this is going to lead. Are you ready for my public ministry to start?" Her answer seems to say, "You have a lot to accomplish; you need to get started."

RINCON DEL DIACONO

No tienen vino

Esta semana celebramos el 2º Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario. Este año nuestra lectura del evangelio proviene del evangelio de Juan y habla de la boda en Caná. María se acerca a Jesús y le dice que se han quedado sin vino. En su respuesta, Él parece dar a entender que ese no es su problema. Pero María quiere que Él haga algo al respecto, y con plena confianza de que Él no se negará, no le dice ni una palabra más, sino que simplemente ordena a los sirvientes que "hagan lo que Él les diga".

Podemos sacar de esta escena tres cosas. Primero, que ir a María y pedirle su tierna intercesión ante su Hijo es muy probable que tenga éxito. Jesús nunca quiere negarle nada. Se ha dicho que Jesús es la cabeza de la iglesia, pero María es el cuello que puede hacer girar la cabeza.

Segundo, sus últimas palabras a los sirvientes son las últimas palabras que pronuncia en las Escrituras, y nos da el mejor consejo posible para que cualquiera lo siga. Simplemente haciendo lo que su Hijo nos dice es la manera de llegar a ser santos y asegurar nuestro lugar en el cielo.

Por último, la respuesta de Jesús parece un poco dura, incluso grosera, pero Jesús y María se conocen tan bien que probablemente Él está diciendo algo más. Él ya tiene treinta y tantos años. A esta altura, ya debe haber compartido con su madre cómo su vida lo conducirá a la cruz, aunque sólo sea para prepararla para lo que ella experimentaría. Con su respuesta "Mi hora aún no ha llegado", en realidad parece estar preguntándole: "¿Sabes a dónde te llevará esto? ¿Estás lista para que comience mi ministerio público?". Su respuesta parece decir: "Tienes mucho que lograr; necesitas comenzar".
