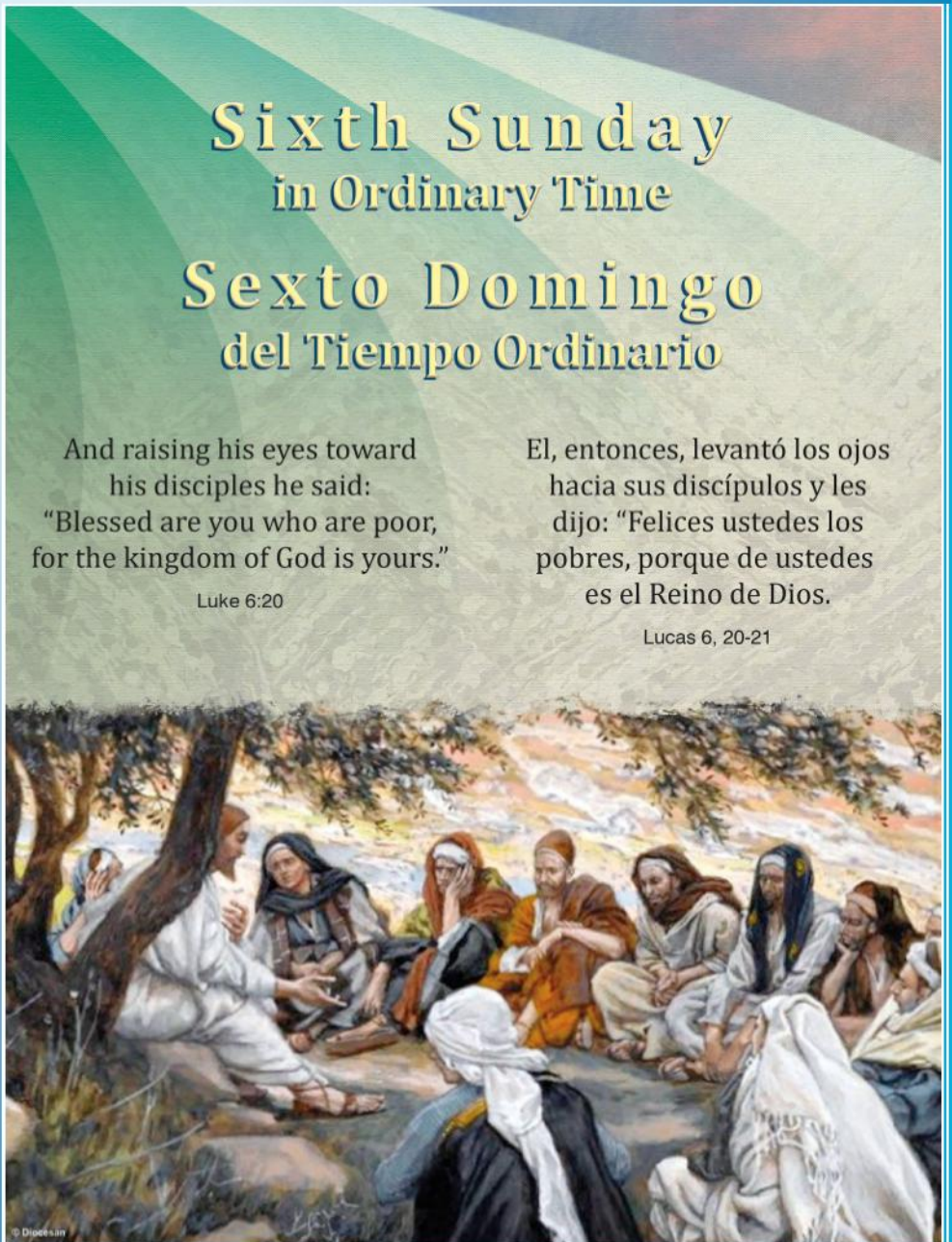

The Beatitudes and Our Attitude Towards God

The Depth of the Gospel

This passage of the Gospel is extremely dense and profound, to the point that we could pause at each phrase and find an inexhaustible wealth of meaning. It is not a text to be read lightly but one that requires deliberate meditation. Saint Luke presents the Beatitudes differently than Saint Matthew, also adding the lamentations, which invites us to an even broader reflection.

Beyond the Material

When Jesus speaks of the poor, the hungry, or those who weep, He is not merely referring to material conditions. It is not just about lacking resources or feeling sorrow but rather about an attitude of need that drives us to seek God. One can be wealthy in possessions and still have the heart of a poor person in spirit—someone who recognizes their dependence on God and their desire for something deeper.

True Wealth and the Danger of Complacency

Jesus' lamentations warn us about the false security we might find in wealth, pleasure, or public approval. If we believe we have everything and stop seeking God, we risk being left empty in the end. The problem is not money itself but where we place our comfort and trust. Those who feel self-sufficient run the risk of never seeking what they truly need.

Spiritual Hunger

Jesus speaks of those who hunger—not just in a

physical sense but in their desire for justice, truth, and God. When someone is hungry for something, they move, they seek to be satisfied. This should be our attitude toward God—not settling for what is immediate but maintaining a constant inner longing that pushes us to seek Him with even greater determination.

The Weeping That Purifies and True Joy

Blessed are those who weep, for they will laugh. This weeping is not mere sadness but a longing for God—a yearning that makes us realize that only in Him do we find true fulfillment. It does not mean that we should seek suffering, but rather that we should understand the value of our trials and turn them into opportunities to draw closer to God.

The Measure of Our Need

God is willing to give us all His love and blessings, but how much we receive depends on how much we are willing to accept. Like in the story of the man giving away oranges, some arrive empty-handed and receive little, while others bring large containers and leave with abundance. Such is our relationship with God—the greater our need, the more we can receive from Him.

Las Bienaventuranzas y Nuestra Actitud ante Dios

La Profundidad del Evangelio

Este pasaje del Evangelio es sumamente denso y profundo, tanto que podríamos detenernos en cada frase y encontrar una riqueza inagotable de significado. No es un texto para ser leído a la ligera, sino que requiere meditación pausada. San Lucas nos presenta las bienaventuranzas de una manera distinta a San Mateo, agregando además las lamentaciones, lo que nos invita a una reflexión aún más amplia.

Más Allá de lo Material

Jesús no se refiere únicamente a situaciones materiales cuando menciona a los pobres, los hambrientos o los que lloran. No es simplemente la falta de recursos o la tristeza, sino la actitud de necesidad que nos mueve a buscar a Dios. Es posible ser rico en bienes y, aun así, tener el corazón de un pobre en espíritu, alguien que reconoce su dependencia de Dios y su deseo de algo más profundo.

La Verdadera Riqueza y el Peligro del Conformismo

Las lamentaciones de Jesús nos advierten sobre la falsa seguridad que podemos encontrar en las riquezas, el placer o el reconocimiento. Si creemos que ya lo tenemos todo y dejamos de buscar a Dios, nos arriesgamos a quedar vacíos al final. No es el dinero el problema, sino dónde ponemos nuestro consuelo y nuestra confianza. Quienes se sienten autosuficientes corren el riesgo de nunca buscar lo que realmente necesitan.

El Hambre Espiritual

Jesús habla de aquellos que tienen hambre, pero no solo en un sentido físico, sino en el deseo de justicia, de verdad y de Dios. Cuando una persona tiene hambre de algo, se mueve, busca saciarse. Así debe ser nuestra actitud hacia Dios: no conformarnos con lo inmediato, sino tener siempre una inquietud interior que nos impulse a buscarlo con más fuerza.

El Llanto que Purifica y el Gozo Verdadero

Bienaventurados los que lloran, porque reirán. Este llanto no es solo tristeza, sino un anhelo por Dios, una añoranza que nos hace reconocer que solo en Él encontramos la verdadera plenitud. No significa que debamos buscar sufrimiento, sino que debemos entender el valor de nuestras penas y convertirlas en una oportunidad para acercarnos más a Dios.

La Medida de Nuestra Necesidad

Dios está dispuesto a darnos todo su amor y bendición, pero depende de nosotros cuánto estemos dispuestos a recibir. Como en la historia del hombre que regalaba naranjas, algunos van con las manos vacías y reciben poco, mientras que otros llevan grandes recipientes y se marchan con abundancia. Así es nuestra relación con Dios: cuanto más grande sea nuestra necesidad, más podremos recibir de Él.

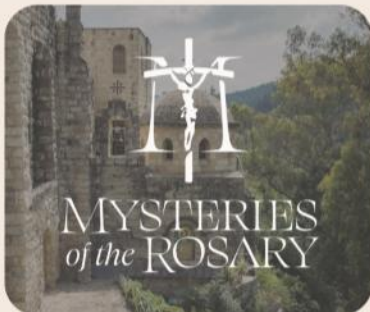

DEACON'S CORNER

Who do we trust? Today's readings contrast the fate of those who trust and hope in God as opposed to those who trust exclusively in the ways of the world.

Jeremiah and the psalm say those who trust in God are like a plant near a running stream that is always green and bears fruit. Similarly In John's Gospel (Jn. 7:37-38) Jesus says: If anyone thirsts let him come to me and drink ...out of his heart shall flow rivers of living water. By way of contrast, those who trust exclusively in the ways of the world are dry and lifeless. Jeremiah says like a barren desert bush. Which of these images best describe us?

St. Luke continues these ideas in today's Gospel. In contrast to Mathew's list of 8 beatitudes which all say blessed are they, Luke instead has 4 blessings and 4 woes. The woes are warnings to those who take too much trust and comfort in the things of this world and pay little attention to the world to come. Luke's beatitudes describe a reversal of fortune. Those who appear blessed in this world and give top priority and full reliance and trust in things of this world risk misfortune in the next; while those who put their trust in God in spite of their suffering in this world will be blessed in the next. Those whose find their ultimate joy and trust exclusively in things of this world will grieve and weep after their death when they are separated from those things and from God.

Who do we trust? May our trust always be in God. That we may bear the fruit of holiness and be full of the living water of God's grace. Then at our death we will rejoice and leap for joy as we hear God say "Behold your reward is great in heaven!"

¿En quién confiamos? Las lecturas de hoy contrastan el destino de quienes confían y esperan en Dios en comparación con aquellos que confían exclusivamente en los caminos del mundo.

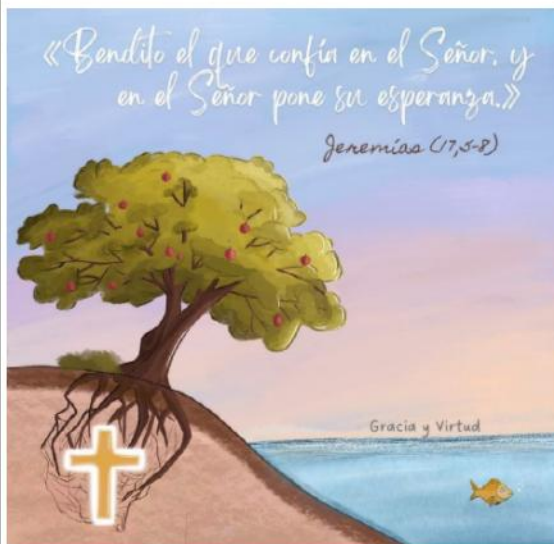
Jeremías y el salmo dicen que quienes confían en Dios son como una planta cerca de un arroyo que siempre está verde y da fruto. De manera similar, en el Evangelio de Juan (Jn. 7:37-38), Jesús dice: Si alguno tiene sed, venga a mí y beba... de su interior correrán ríos de agua viva. En contraste, quienes confían exclusivamente en los caminos del mundo están secos y sin vida. Jeremías dice como un arbusto estéril del desierto. ¿Cuál de estas imágenes nos describe mejor?

San Lucas continúa con estas ideas en el Evangelio de hoy. En contraste con la lista de 8 bienaventuranzas de Mateo que todas dicen bienaventurados, Lucas en cambio tiene 4 bendiciones y 4 ayes. Los ayes son advertencias para aquellos que confían demasiado y se sienten cómodos en las cosas de este mundo y prestan poca atención al mundo venidero.

Las bienaventuranzas de Lucas describen un cambio de suerte. Aquellos que parecen bienaventurados en este mundo y dan máxima prioridad y plena confianza a las cosas de este mundo corren el riesgo de sufrir desgracias en el próximo; mientras que aquellos que ponen su confianza en Dios a pesar de su sufrimiento en este mundo serán bienaventurados en el próximo. Aquellos que encuentran su máxima alegría y confianza exclusivamente en las cosas de este mundo se lamentarán y llorarán después de su muerte cuando se separen de esas cosas y de Dios.

¿En quién confiamos? Que nuestra confianza esté siempre en Dios. Para que podamos dar el fruto de la santidad y estar llenos del agua viva de la gracia de Dios. Entonces, en nuestra muerte, nos regocijaremos y saltaremos de alegría al escuchar a Dios decir: "¡He aquí que vuestra recompensa es grande en los cielos!"
