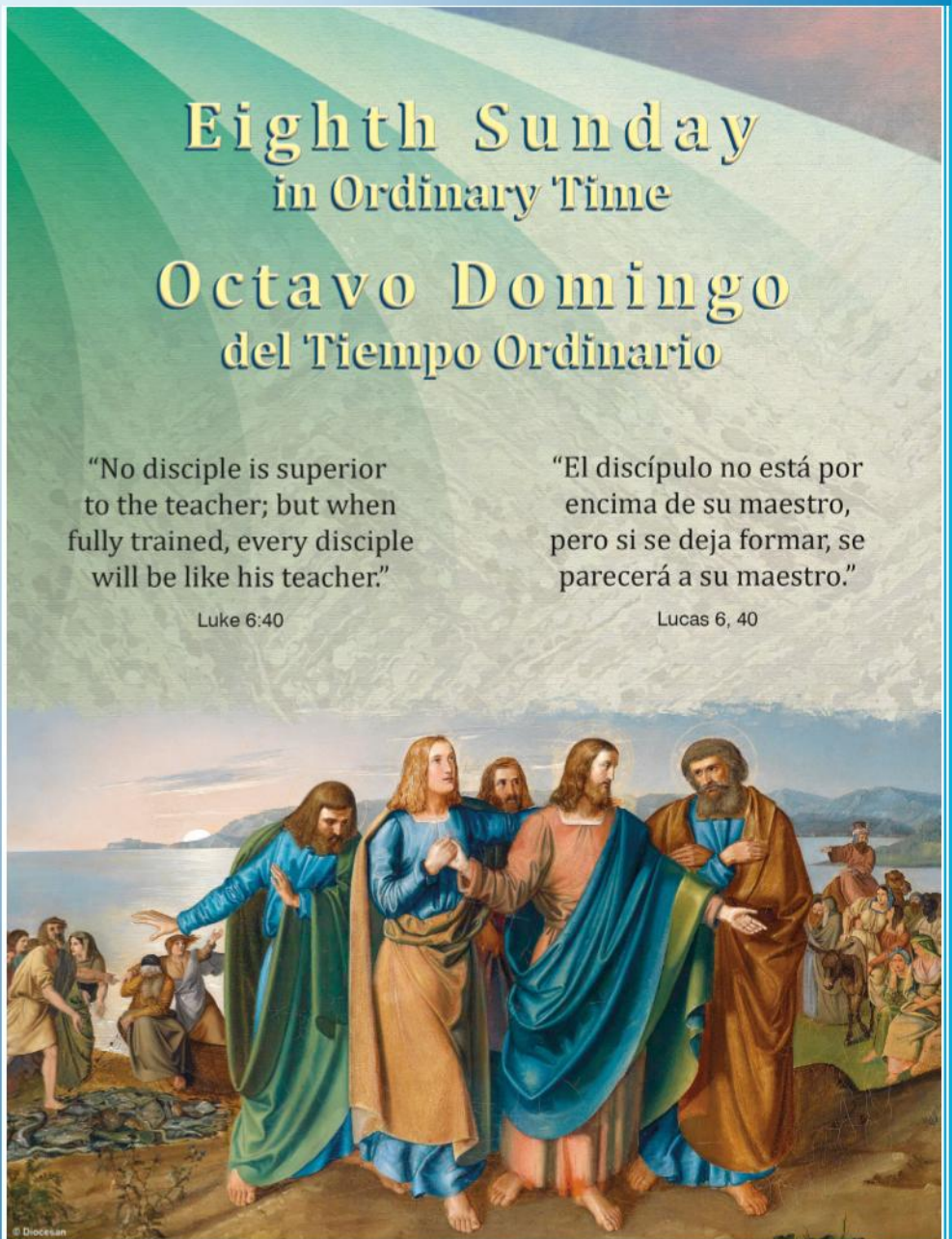

The Importance of Testimony



The Gospel Is Always Relevant

The Gospel should not be regarded as an ancient story but as a living and ever-present truth. Its teachings are just as relevant today as when they were first spoken by Jesus. Each time we hear the message, we must receive it with an attitude of openness and reflection, as it continues to resonate powerfully in our daily lives.

The Lack of Role Models in Modern Society

Today, many public figures, especially in the realms of entertainment and sports, fail to present themselves as examples of integrity. This lack of positive role models affects the younger generations, who often receive the wrong message—that behavior does not matter as long as professional expectations or fame are met. This contrasts sharply with the Christian call to be exemplary in every aspect of life.

The Teaching of Jesus: The True Model for Life

Jesus teaches us that we cannot correct others without first recognizing and addressing our own faults. The example of the speck and the plank in the eye (Luke 6:41-42) reminds us to be aware of our own weaknesses before pointing out those of others. A true teacher does not merely instruct with words but leads by example through their way of life.

The Consistency Between Words and Actions

True impact lies not in what is said but in how one

lives. The teachings of a leader or role model must be supported by a consistent and authentic life. As Jesus said, *"A good tree cannot bear bad fruit"*, meaning our actions should reflect a heart filled with goodness and integrity.

The Responsibility of Personal Example

Being aware of our own actions is crucial, especially for those in positions of influence, such as parents, teachers, or spiritual leaders. Children, for example, do not just listen to what they are told; they imitate the behavior of their parents. Therefore, personal testimony carries more weight than any verbal instruction.

The Power of a Lasting Example

A final story illustrates the power of example: A father and his son walk along a slippery path, with the child following in his father's footsteps. This metaphor reflects how our actions directly impact those around us. We cannot demand change in others if we are not willing to embody the principles we preach. Words may be forgotten, but a good testimony leaves an indelible mark.

La Importancia del Testimonio



El Evangelio es Siempre Actual

El evangelio no debe ser visto como una historia antigua, sino como una verdad siempre presente y viva. Sus enseñanzas son tan relevantes hoy como cuando fueron pronunciadas por Jesús. Cada vez que escuchamos el mensaje, debemos recibirlo con una actitud de apertura y reflexión, ya que sigue teniendo un eco poderoso en nuestra vida cotidiana.

La Falta de Modelos a Seguir en la Sociedad Actual

Hoy en día, muchas figuras públicas, especialmente en el mundo del entretenimiento y el deporte, no se presentan como ejemplos de vida íntegra. La falta de modelos positivos afecta a las nuevas generaciones, que muchas veces reciben el mensaje erróneo de que la conducta no importa mientras se cumpla con las expectativas laborales o de fama. Esto contrasta con el llamado cristiano a ser ejemplo en todas las áreas de la vida.

La Enseñanza de Jesús: El Verdadero Modelo de Vida

Jesús nos enseña que no podemos corregir a los demás sin antes reconocer y trabajar en nuestras propias fallas. El ejemplo de la viga y la paja en el ojo (Lucas 6:41-42) nos recuerda que primero debemos ser conscientes de nuestras debilidades antes de señalar las de los demás. Un verdadero maestro no solo enseña con palabras, sino con su ejemplo de vida.

La Coherencia entre Palabras y Acciones

El verdadero impacto no está en lo que se dice, sino

en cómo se vive. Las enseñanzas de un líder o modelo a seguir deben estar respaldadas por una vida coherente. Como dice Jesús, *"El árbol bueno no da frutos malos"*, por lo que nuestras acciones deben reflejar un corazón lleno de bondad y autenticidad.

La Responsabilidad del Ejemplo Personal

Ser conscientes de nuestras propias acciones es clave, especialmente si ocupamos roles de influencia, como padres, maestros o líderes espirituales. Los hijos, por ejemplo, no solo escuchan lo que se les dice, sino que siguen el ejemplo de conducta de sus padres. Por eso, el testimonio personal tiene más poder que cualquier enseñanza verbal.

El Testimonio que Arrastra

Una historia final ilustra el poder del ejemplo: un padre y su hijo caminan por un sendero resbaladizo, y el niño sigue las huellas de su papá. Esta metáfora refleja cómo nuestras acciones impactan directamente en quienes nos rodean. No podemos exigir cambios en los demás si no estamos dispuestos a ser ejemplo de lo que predicamos. Las palabras pueden ser olvidadas, pero un buen testimonio deja una huella imborrable.

RECOGNIZING ANXIETY AND DEPRESSION IN CHILDREN

Anxiety is a natural response to stress. However, it becomes a disorder when excessive, persistent worry disrupts a child's daily activities.

Key Symptoms:

- Excessive worry about everyday events
- Restlessness or feeling on edge
- Fatigue and difficulty concentrating
- Irritability and muscle tension
- Sleep disturbances
- Avoidance of social situations

Behavioral Indicators:

- Clinginess to caregivers
- Reluctance to attend school or participate in activities
- Tantrums or meltdowns in stressful situations

Depression is more than just occasional sadness. It is a significant mood disorder that affects a child's emotional state, thinking, and behavior.

Key Symptoms:

- Persistent low mood or sadness
- Loss of interest in favorite activities
- Changes in appetite or weight
- Insomnia or excessive sleeping
- Fatigue or lack of energy
- Feelings of worthlessness or guilt
- Difficulty focusing
- Thoughts of death or self-harm

Behavioral Indicators:

- Withdrawal from family and friends
- Decline in school performance
- Frequent outbursts or increased irritability
- Complaints of unexplained physical aches

When to seek help

If your child shows any of these signs, talk to your pediatrician. Early support can make a significant difference.

If your child is having thoughts of self-harm or suicide, this is a medical emergency. Contact your doctor, call 911 or go to the nearest emergency room immediately.

RECONOCIENDO LA ANSIEDAD Y DEPRESIÓN EN NIÑOS

La **ansiedad** es una respuesta natural al estrés. Sin embargo, se convierte en un trastorno cuando la preocupación excesiva y persistente interrumpe las actividades diarias del niño.

Síntomas Claves de la Ansiedad

- Preocupación excesiva por situaciones cotidianas
- Inquietud o sentirse nervioso
- Fatiga y dificultad para concentrarse
- Irritabilidad y tensión muscular
- Trastornos del sueño
- Evitación de situaciones sociales

Cambios en el Comportamiento:

- Aferrarse a los cuidadores o padres
- Resistirse a ir a la escuela o participar en actividades
- Berrinches o colapsos en situaciones estresantes

La **depresión** es más que solo tristeza ocasional. Es un trastorno del estado de ánimo que afecta las emociones, el pensamiento y el comportamiento de un niño.

Síntomas Claves de la Depresión

- Tristeza o estado de ánimo bajo persistente
- Pérdida de interés en actividades favoritas
- Cambios en el apetito o peso
- Insomnio o dormir en exceso
- Fatiga o falta de energía
- Sentimientos de inutilidad o culpa
- Dificultad para concentrarse
- Pensamientos de muerte o autolesiones

Cambios en el Comportamiento:

- Aislamiento de la familia y amigos
- Disminución en el rendimiento escolar
- Estallidos de ira o irritabilidad aumentada
- Quejas de dolores físicos inexplicables

¿Cuándo Buscar Ayuda?

Si tu hijo muestra alguno de estos signos, es importante hablar con su pediatra. El apoyo temprano puede marcar una gran diferencia. Si tu hijo tiene pensamientos de autolesionarse o suicidarse, esto es una emergencia médica. Contacte a su médico, llama al 911 o acude a la sala de emergencias más cercana inmediatamente.

DEACON'S CORNER



Apart from Christmas and Easter, Ash Wednesday is one of the most attended Masses of the year for the Catholic Church. Ash Wednesday consists of abstaining from meat, going to Mass, and adorning your forehead with ashes. But why do some sects of Christianity celebrate Ash Wednesday? Furthermore, how did Ash Wednesday come about?

Christian churches celebrate Ash Wednesday, also known as the “Day of Ashes,” on the first day of Lent. Lent falls between the dates of Feb. 4 and March 11, depending on the date of Easter Sunday. “Day of Ashes” derives from the Roman Missal, “Dies Cinerum,” and appears in copies of the Gregorian Sacramentary from early centuries. It’s commonly believed that the concept originated with the Roman Catholics in the sixth century. The origin of this day isn’t entirely clear, but it’s thought that the practice of marking the head with ashes in the shape of a cross originated during Gregory the Great’s papacy. A solemn reminder of human mortality, the religious day also marks the beginning of Lent and the expression of penance. In placing ashes on your head, traditional words that echo the sentiment of mortality are usually spoken: “Remember that your dust, and to dust, you shall return.” This marks the beginning of Lent, which lasts for a 40-day period of devout fasting. Using ashes as a sign of penance was traditionally a private devotion. In time, a Catholic member of the clergy performed it for public penitents as part of a formal rite. In this context, the ashes on the penitent served as a motive for fellow Christians to pray for and be sympathetic towards the person returning to repent. In later centuries, using ashes evolved into Ash Wednesday’s present rite of starting the season of Lent. Even in today’s celebrations of Ash Wednesday, the ashes are meant to represent dust. This is a reference to what God said to Adam when he was expelled from the Garden of Eden. The Christian Bible says that Adam was formed from dust, hence we shall return to dust when we die. The saying is meant to remind us to be humble on Ash Wednesday as we face mortality, and the ashes symbolize what God said to Adam.

RINCON DEL DIACONO

Aparte de Navidad y Pascua, el Miércoles de Ceniza es una de las misas más concurridas del año para la Iglesia Católica. El Miércoles de Ceniza consiste en abstenerse de comer carne, ir a misa y adornarse la frente con ceniza. Pero, ¿por qué algunas sectas del cristianismo celebran el Miércoles de Ceniza? Además, ¿cómo surgió el Miércoles de Ceniza?

Las iglesias cristianas celebran el Miércoles de Ceniza, también conocido como el “Día de las Cenizas”, el primer día de Cuaresma. La Cuaresma cae entre las fechas del 4 de febrero y el 11 de marzo, dependiendo de la fecha del Domingo de Pascua. “Día de las Cenizas” deriva del Misal Romano, “Dies Cinerum”, y aparece en copias del Sacramentario Gregoriano de los primeros siglos. Se cree comúnmente que el concepto se originó con los católicos romanos en el siglo VI. El origen de este día no está del todo claro, pero se cree que la práctica de marcar la cabeza con cenizas en forma de cruz se originó durante el papado de Gregorio el Grande. Este día religioso, que es un solemne recordatorio de la mortalidad humana, marca también el comienzo de la Cuaresma y la expresión de la penitencia. Al colocar cenizas sobre la cabeza, se suelen pronunciar palabras tradicionales que reflejan el sentimiento de la mortalidad: “Recuerda que de tu polvo, y al polvo volverás”. Esto marca el comienzo de la Cuaresma, que dura un período de 40 días de ayuno devoto. El uso de cenizas como signo de penitencia era tradicionalmente una devoción privada. Con el tiempo, un miembro del clero católico lo realizaba para los penitentes públicos como parte de un rito formal. En este contexto, las cenizas sobre el penitente servían como motivo para que los hermanos cristianos rezaran y se solidarizaran con la persona que regresaba para arrepentirse. En siglos posteriores, el uso de cenizas evolucionó hasta convertirse en el rito actual del Miércoles de Ceniza para iniciar la temporada de Cuaresma.
