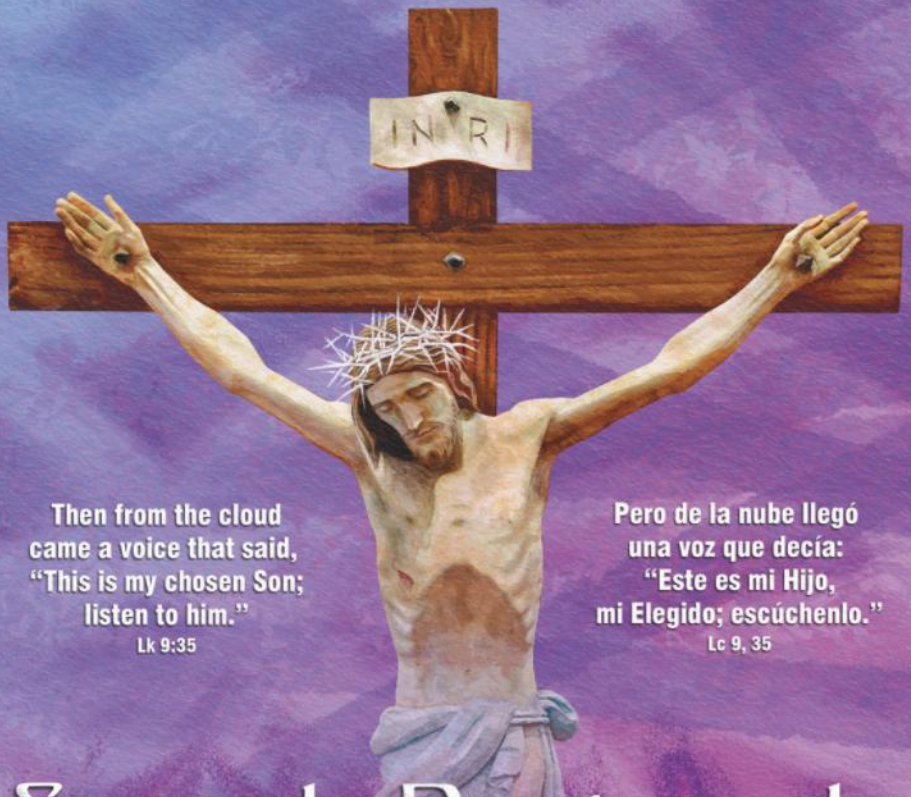

The Transfiguration and Prayer: A Path of Transformation in Lent

The Meaning of Lent

Lent is a time of preparation for Easter, the central event of Christianity. It is not merely about fasting, sacrifices, or penance, but about spiritually preparing ourselves to experience Christ's passage from death to life. Each Sunday of Lent holds special significance: the first focuses on **temptations and the struggles** we face in our faith journey, while the second presents the **Transfiguration of Jesus**, offering us a glimpse of the ultimate goal—the glory of God.

The Transfiguration: A Light in the Journey

The Gospel of the second Sunday of Lent recounts the **Transfiguration of Jesus** on the mountain, where His face shines brilliantly as He is joined by Moses and Elijah. This event not only foreshadows the glory of the Resurrection but also teaches that faith is not solely about suffering—it leads to the fullness of life in God. The Transfiguration is closely linked to the Cross, as Moses and Elijah speak with Jesus about His impending death, highlighting that sacrifice is an essential part of the divine plan.

Disfiguration, Configuration, and Transfiguration

To understand the Transfiguration, Father Pablo Cárdenas explained three key concepts: **figure, disfiguration, and configuration**. God created us in His image and likeness, granting us an original form. However, sin **disfigures** us, distancing us from that divine image. Our mission is to **configure ourselves to Christ**, shaping our lives according to His example so that, one day, we may be **transfigured** in His glory. Every day, we must choose between being disfigured by sin or configured by God's grace.

Prayer as a Path of Transformation

The Gospel underscores the importance of prayer in the spiritual life. Jesus ascends the mountain to pray, and it is in that moment that His **Transfiguration**

takes place. This teaches us that true prayer brings transformation—not by changing external circumstances but by transforming us from within. Prayer does not mean asking for problems to disappear, but rather gaining the strength to face them. Like climbing a mountain, prayer requires effort, discipline, and perseverance. It calls us to detach from superficial distractions and seek God's presence with an open heart.

Listening to God's Voice

During the Transfiguration, a cloud envelops the disciples, and they hear the voice of the Father: "**This is my Son; listen to Him.**" This is a clear call to attentiveness in prayer. Prayer is not merely about speaking to God; it is about listening to His voice in Scripture, in the Church, and deep within our hearts. True prayer is a dialogue in which we allow ourselves to be guided by His will.

Love as the Source of Transformation

Ultimately, Lent is not a time for impossible demands or forced change. More than struggling against our imperfections through sheer effort, we must recognize that **God loves us as we are**. It is His unconditional love that transforms us from within. A heart that knows it is loved is capable of change—not out of obligation, but out of the deep assurance of its worth in God's eyes. The Lenten journey invites us to rediscover that spiritual transformation is not solely the result of human effort, but the fruit of God's grace working in our lives.

La Transfiguración y la Oración: Camino de Cambio en la Cuaresma



El sentido de la Cuaresma

La Cuaresma es un tiempo de preparación para la Pascua, el acontecimiento central del cristianismo. No se trata solo de ayunos, sacrificios o penitencias, sino de disponernos espiritualmente para vivir el paso de la muerte a la vida con Cristo. Cada uno de los domingos de Cuaresma tiene un significado especial: el primero nos habla de las tentaciones y las dificultades que enfrentamos en el camino de la fe, mientras que el segundo nos muestra la meta a la que aspiramos, representada en la **Transfiguración de Jesús**.

La Transfiguración: Luz en medio del camino

El evangelio del segundo domingo de Cuaresma narra la **Transfiguración de Jesús** en el monte, donde su rostro resplandece y aparece acompañado de Moisés y Elías. Este evento no solo anticipa la gloria de la resurrección, sino que también nos enseña que la fe no se queda en el sufrimiento, sino que apunta hacia la plenitud de la vida en Dios. La Transfiguración está directamente relacionada con la cruz, pues Moisés y Elías hablaban con Jesús sobre su muerte, mostrando que el sacrificio es parte del plan divino.

Desfiguración, configuración y transfiguración

Para comprender la Transfiguración, hay que entender tres conceptos clave: **figura**, **desfiguración** y **configuración**. Dios nos creó a su imagen y semejanza, dándonos una figura original. Sin embargo, el pecado nos desfigura, alejándonos de esa imagen divina. Nuestra misión es **configurarnos con Cristo**, moldeando nuestra vida según su ejemplo, para que finalmente podamos ser transfigurados en su gloria. Cada día elegimos entre desfigurarnos con el pecado o configurarnos con la gracia de Dios.

La oración como camino de transformación

El evangelio subraya la importancia de la oración en la

vida espiritual. Jesús sube al monte para orar, y en ese momento ocurre su Transfiguración. Esto nos enseña que la verdadera oración transforma, pero no cambia las circunstancias externas, sino nuestro interior. Orar no significa pedir que desaparezcan los problemas, sino encontrar la fortaleza para enfrentarlos. La oración requiere esfuerzo, disciplina y constancia, como subir un monte: hay que desprenderse de lo superficial y buscar la presencia de Dios con un corazón abierto.

Escuchar la voz de Dios

En la escena de la Transfiguración, una nube cubre a los discípulos y se escucha la voz del Padre: "**Este es mi Hijo, escúchenlo**". Este es un llamado claro a la escucha en la oración. No se trata solo de hablarle a Dios, sino de aprender a escuchar su voz en la Escritura, en la Iglesia y en lo profundo de nuestro corazón. La verdadera oración implica un diálogo en el que nos dejamos guiar por la voluntad divina.

El amor que transforma

Finalmente, la Cuaresma no es un tiempo de exigencias imposibles ni de cambios forzados. Más que luchar contra nuestras imperfecciones con nuestras propias fuerzas, debemos reconocer que **Dios nos ama tal como somos**. Es su amor incondicional el que nos transforma desde dentro. Un corazón que se sabe amado es capaz de cambiar sin esfuerzo, pues la verdadera conversión no nace de la obligación, sino de la certeza de que somos valiosos ante Dios. Así, el camino cuaresmal nos lleva a redescubrir que la transformación espiritual es fruto de la gracia y no solo del esfuerzo humano.

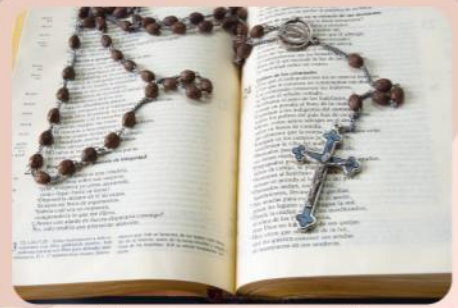

FAQ's about Lent



1. What is Lent?

Lent is a 40-day period of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving leading up to Easter, commemorating Jesus' time of fasting in the desert

2. When does Lent begin and end?

Lent begins on Ash Wednesday and ends on Holy Thursday evening, before the Mass of the Lord's Supper.

3. Why do Catholics fast during Lent?

Fasting is a form of sacrifice that helps Catholics focus on prayer and repentance while uniting with Christ's suffering.

4. What are the fasting and abstinence rules?

Catholics ages 18-59 fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday (one full meal, two smaller meals) and abstain from meat on Fridays during Lent.

5. Can I eat meat on Sundays during Lent?

Yes, Lenten abstinence rules apply only on specific days, and Sundays are not considered abstinence days.

Preguntas frecuentes sobre la Cuaresma

1. ¿Qué es la Cuaresma?

La Cuaresma es un período de 40 días de oración, ayuno y limosna que conduce a la Pascua y conmemora el tiempo de ayuno de Jesús en el desierto.

2. ¿Cuándo comienza y termina la Cuaresma?

La Cuaresma comienza el Miércoles de Ceniza y termina la tarde del Jueves Santo, antes de la Misa de la Cena del Señor.

3. ¿Por qué los católicos ayunan durante la Cuaresma?

El ayuno es una forma de sacrificio que ayuda a los católicos a centrarse en la oración y el arrepentimiento mientras se unen al sufrimiento de Cristo.

4. ¿Cuáles son las reglas de ayuno y abstinencia?

Los católicos de entre 18 y 59 años ayunan el Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo (una comida completa, dos comidas más pequeñas) y se abstienen de comer carne a los viernes durante la Cuaresma.

5. ¿Puedo comer carne los domingos durante la Cuarema?

Sí, las reglas de la abstinencia de Cuaresma se aplican solo en días específicos y los domingos no se consideran días de ayuno.
