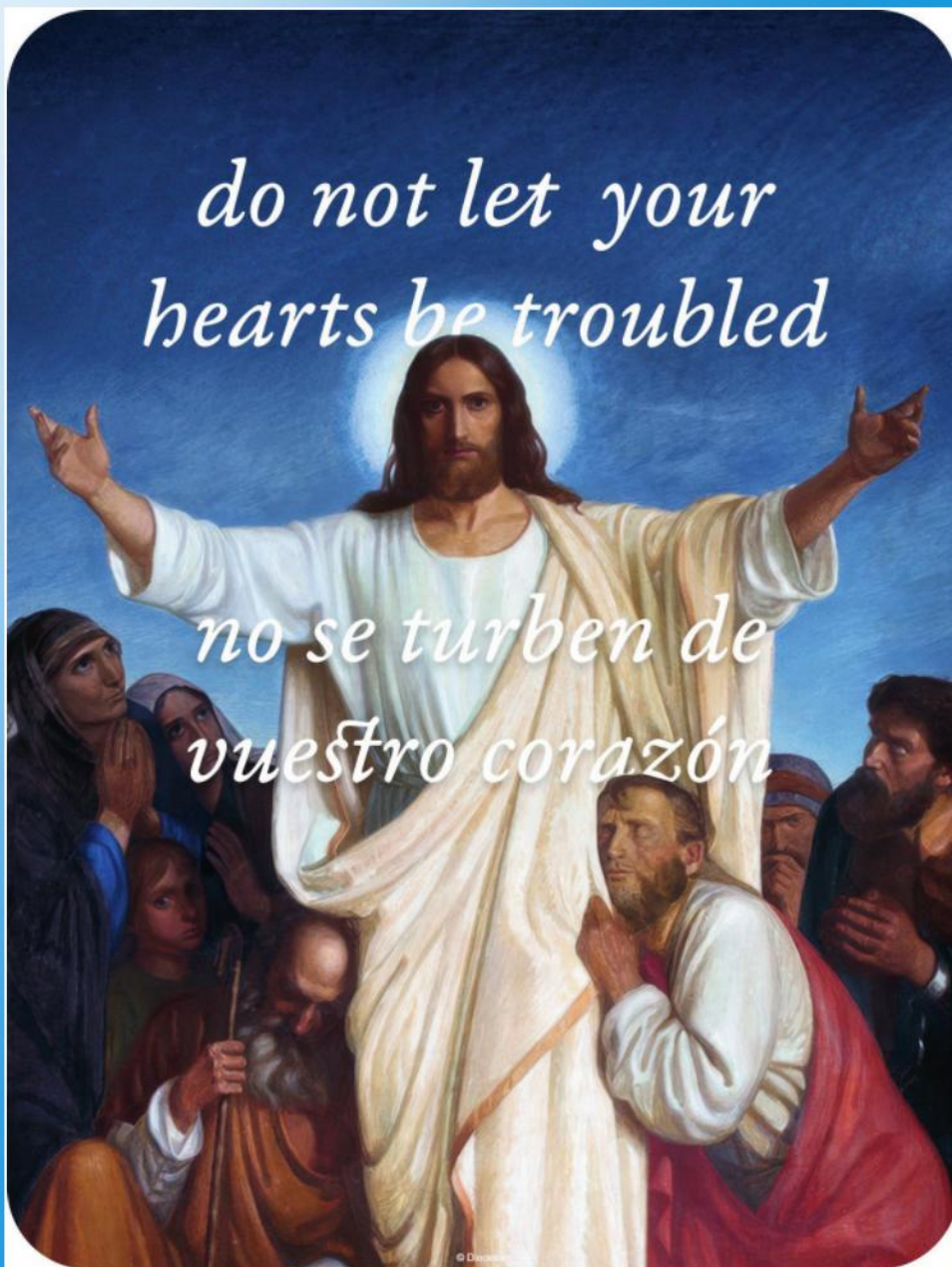

"God Desires to Dwell Within Your Heart"



A Liturgy Rich in Wisdom

Today's Scripture readings are filled with deep meaning and divine wisdom. In the first reading, we witness how the apostles, facing numerous challenges in the early Christian community, gather in council and allow God to guide their discernment. The second reading from the Book of Revelation reminds us of our living hope in the New Jerusalem—a future where all things will be made new and where God comes to dwell among us. The Gospel, ever direct and realistic, confronts us not only with the word of God but with God Himself knocking at the door of our hearts.

From Knowledge to the Experience of Love

Jesus speaks to us with great tenderness and depth: "If anyone loves me, he will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our dwelling with him." This is more than a theological truth—it is an invitation to a profound personal experience. God is not content with being distant, nor merely present among us. He desires to dwell within us. These are not conditions for being loved, but a path to truly experience divine love: to love God and to keep His word. Love becomes the door that moves us from knowledge to intimate communion.

Loving God from the Depths of the Soul

To experience God's love, we must freely respond with our own love. Jesus makes this clear: to keep His word is to let Him enter our lives. Just as those in love do not settle for knowing they are loved but yearn to feel that love, so too are we called to open our hearts. With the help of the Holy Spirit, the desire to love God springs naturally from within us. It is not a burden but

a movement of the soul that has rediscovered its origin and destiny in God. The Spirit engraves this longing on our hearts, making love and obedience a joyful response.

A Peace That Is Not Lost but Surrendered

Christ also leaves us His peace—not as the world gives, but a peace that flows from love. This peace cannot be taken from us; it can only be surrendered when we fail to guard it. Even in the midst of difficulties, arguments, or trials, it is we who choose whether to hold on to peace or let it slip away. The example of Saint Felicitas, who maintained her peace even in the face of martyrdom, shows us that no one can steal peace when it is protected. Jesus invites us to treasure it, for peace is where we grow, mature, and encounter God Himself.

God Desires to Make His Home Within You

This is the central message of today: God does not wish to dwell in temples made by human hands but within the human heart. Do not settle merely for knowing that God loves you—take the next step and begin to love Him in return by keeping His commandments. In doing so, you allow Him to enter and make His dwelling within you. He is a God of love, peace, and justice who never imposes Himself but patiently waits for our response. Love Him, open your heart to Him, and you will discover how good the Lord truly is. May you have a blessed and grace-filled Sunday.

“Dios quiere habitar en tu corazón”

Una liturgia llena de sabiduría

Hoy, las lecturas que nos presenta la liturgia están cargadas de significado y sabiduría. Desde la primera lectura vemos cómo los apóstoles, ante los desafíos en la comunidad cristiana naciente, se reúnen en un concilio donde el mismo Dios les guía. En la segunda lectura, el Apocalipsis nos recuerda la esperanza viva de la Nueva Jerusalén: todo será nuevo, Dios viene hacia nosotros. Y el Evangelio, siempre tan directo y realista, nos confronta con la verdad de que no solo es palabra de Dios, sino que es Dios mismo tocando nuestro corazón.

Del conocimiento a la experiencia del amor

Jesús nos habla con ternura y profundidad: “Si alguno me ama, guardará mi palabra, y mi Padre lo amará, y vendremos a él, y haremos morada en él”. Este mensaje no es teoría, es una invitación a vivir una experiencia interior. Dios no se conforma con estar lejos ni solo entre nosotros. Él desea habitar en nuestro interior. No se trata de condiciones para ser amados, sino del camino para experimentar ese amor: amar a Dios y guardar su palabra. El amor se convierte así en puerta de entrada, no solo al conocimiento, sino a la vivencia del amor divino.

Amar a Dios desde lo más profundo

Experimentar el amor de Dios requiere una respuesta libre y amorosa: amarlo a Él. Jesús nos lo dice claramente: guardar su palabra es dejar que Él entre en nuestra vida. Como los enamorados que no se conforman con saber que son amados, sino que desean sentir ese amor, así también nosotros estamos

llamados a abrir el corazón. Con la ayuda del Espíritu Santo, ese deseo de amar a Dios brota de lo más profundo. No es una carga. Es un impulso natural del alma que ha descubierto su origen y su destino en Dios.

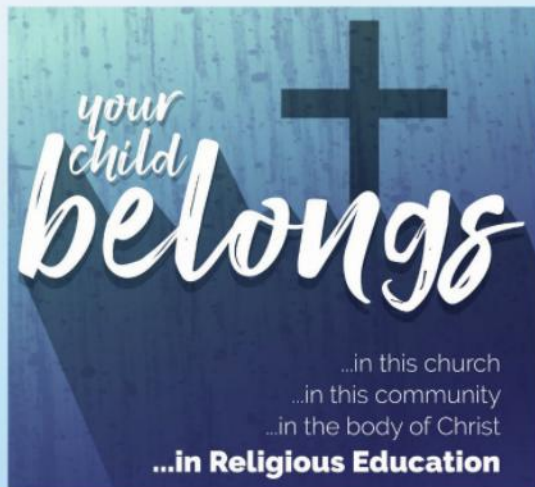
La paz que no se pierde, se regala

Jesús también nos deja su paz, no como la da el mundo, sino una paz profunda que nace del amor. Esta paz no se pierde, sino que se entrega cuando no la cuidamos. En medio de problemas, discusiones o dificultades, somos nosotros quienes decidimos si la conservamos o la dejamos ir. El ejemplo de santa Felicitas, que conservó la paz aún frente a sus verdugos, nos recuerda que nadie puede quitarnos la paz si decidimos cuidarla. Jesús nos invita a custodiar ese tesoro, pues es en la paz donde encontramos a Dios.

Dios quiere hacer morada en ti

Este es el gran mensaje de hoy: Dios no desea habitar en templos de piedra, sino en el corazón humano. No te conformes con saber que Dios te ama; da el paso y empieza a amarlo tú, guardando sus mandamientos. Así permitirás que Él viva dentro de ti, que haga de tu interior su morada. Él es un Dios de amor, de justicia y de paz, que nunca forzará tu respuesta, pero que espera con ternura a que tú le abras la puerta. Ámalo, déjalo entrar, y verás cuán bueno es el Señor. Que tengas un bendecido domingo.

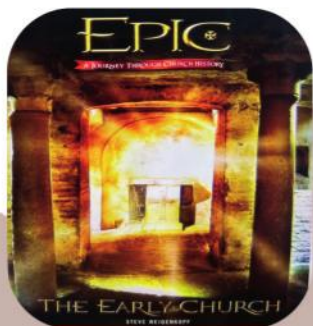

DEACON'S CORNER

Our second reading continues where we left it last week with the apocalyptic book of John's Revelation. John has a vision of a heavenly Jerusalem, the New Jerusalem, the city of God. The earthly Jerusalem city and

temple were destroyed in 70 AD by the Romans.

This new heavenly city and its temple are not constructed of stone, wood, gold or human labor. They are not earthly. Rather, the New Jerusalem comes down from heaven; gleaming with God's radiance like precious jewels. The massive wall of this new city has twelve gates each guarded by angels on which are written the names of the twelve tribes of Israel. The names of the twelve apostles are written on the twelve courses of stones that serve as the city's foundation. This city is the heavenly New Jerusalem and it has a New Heavenly Temple.

The Lord God Almighty and the Lamb of God, Jesus Christ slain for our sins are the New Temple in the New Jerusalem. Therefore is no need of fire, candles, electric lights or even the light from the moon or sun to illuminate this city and its New Temple. Rather God's glory and the Lamb, the resurrected and glorified Jesus Christ provide the light.

Does the light of Christ shine in our hearts? Does it shine before others? Has our soul become a Temple of God, where the light of Christ illuminates us as followers of Christ? Does this light show us the way to eternity in the Holy City? Or has our light grown a little dim? Psalm 27 says: **The Lord is my light and my salvation whom do I fear?** It also says: **one thing I ask of the Lord; this I seek: to dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life to gaze on the Lord's beauty, to visit his temple.** Does psalm 27 express our beliefs and desires? May it be so!

RINCON DEL DIACONO

Nuestra segunda lectura continúa donde la dejamos la semana pasada con el libro apocalíptico del Apocalipsis de Juan. Juan tiene una visión de una Jerusalén celestial, la Nueva Jerusalén, la ciudad de Dios. La ciudad y el templo terrenales de Jerusalén fueron destruidos en el año 70 d. C. por los romanos.

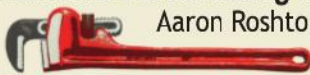
Esta nueva ciudad celestial y su templo no están contruidos con piedra, madera, oro ni trabajo humano. No son terrenales. Más bien, la Nueva Jerusalén desciende del cielo, resplandeciendo con el resplandor de Dios como joyas preciosas. La imponente muralla de esta nueva ciudad tiene doce puertas, cada una custodiada por ángeles, en las que están escritos los nombres de las doce tribus de Israel. Los nombres de los doce apóstoles están escritos en las doce hileras de piedras que sirven de cimiento a la ciudad. Esta ciudad es la Nueva Jerusalén celestial y tiene un Nuevo Templo Celestial.

El Señor Dios Todopoderoso y el Cordero de Dios, Jesucristo, inmolado por nuestros pecados, son el Nuevo Templo en la Nueva Jerusalén. Por lo tanto, no se necesita fuego, velas, luz eléctrica ni siquiera la luz de la luna o el sol para iluminar esta ciudad y su Nuevo Templo. Más bien, la gloria de Dios y el Cordero, Jesucristo resucitado y glorificado, proveen la luz.

¿Brilla la luz de Cristo en nuestros corazones? ¿Brilla ante los demás? ¿Se ha convertido nuestra alma en un templo de Dios, donde la luz de Cristo nos ilumina como seguidores de Cristo? ¿Nos muestra esta luz el camino a la eternidad en la Ciudad Santa? ¿O se ha atenuado un poco nuestra luz? El Salmo 27 dice: «El Señor es mi luz y mi salvación; ¿a quién temo?». También dice: «Una cosa pido al Señor; esto busco: habitar en la casa del Señor todos los días de mi vida, contemplar su hermosura y visitar su templo». ¿Expresa el Salmo 27 nuestras creencias y deseos? ¡Que así sea!
