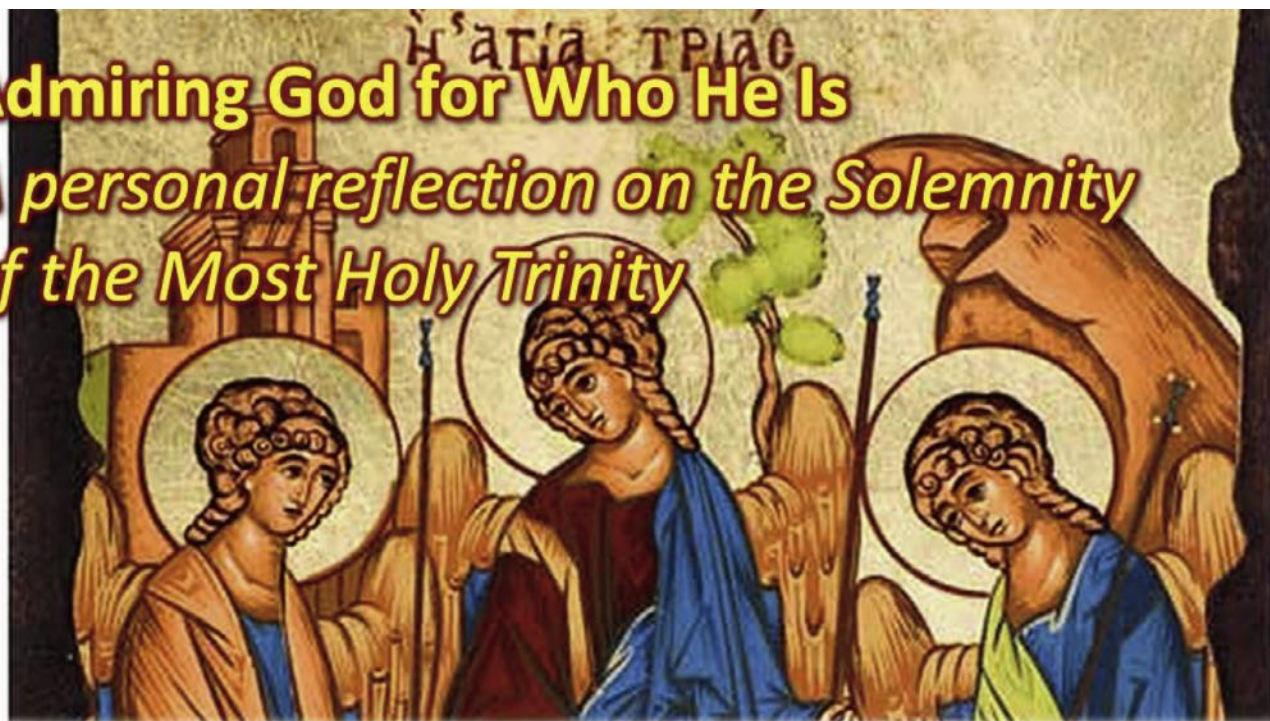

Admiring God for Who He Is

A personal reflection on the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity



Celebrating God for His Own Sake

Today, as we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, I realize that we are not commemorating a specific miracle, a divine intervention, or a concrete manifestation, as we do in other solemnities. Today, we simply celebrate God for who He is. I do not worship Him today because of what He has done for me, but because His very being, His mystery, and His identity as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are worthy of adoration in themselves. It is a celebration that invites me to lift my eyes—not to understand, but to contemplate.

A God Revealed as Family

Understanding God as Trinity frees me from the idea of a distant, isolated, or solitary being. God reveals Himself as a family: three distinct persons, yet one true God. This is not a mathematical formula, but a truth that transcends logic. It is not that He sometimes appears as Father, and at other times as Son or Spirit; no—these are three distinct persons who exist simultaneously, and each is fully God. Comprehending this does not come through concepts alone, but through relationship, communion, and lived experience.

Truth That Is Discovered Along the Way

Jesus said there were still many things He wanted to tell us, but that we were not yet ready to understand them. That is why He sent us the Holy Spirit, who would guide us into all truth. This statement moves me deeply, because it reminds me that truth is not something to be possessed, but Someone to be

encountered. God cannot be confined to formulas; He reveals Himself in time, in life, and through relationship. Truth is God Himself, and thus I can only truly know Him if I allow myself to be guided, if I walk with Him.

The Trinity Is Understood by Living It

I think of those who have never known what it means to have a family. They may read about it, but they cannot truly understand until they have lived it. The same is true of God. I can study Him, know the dogmas, understand the terminology, but if I have not had a living experience of His love, I remain at a distance. Just like in the cartoon *Lilo & Stitch*, when the alien character experiences familial love, his life is transformed. In the same way, when I encounter God as Trinitarian love, something in me changes forever.

God Is a Mystery That Draws Me In

St. Teresa of Ávila expressed it beautifully: "How different it is to experience the Trinity than to merely understand it." And this is true. Like the ocean, I can study and learn much about it, but nothing compares to actually stepping into its waters. To celebrate the Trinity is to stop trying to confine God within a concept, and instead open my life to Him. It is to recognize that He is God, and I am His creature. And thus, with simplicity and reverence, I allow myself to be blessed by this God who is love, unity, and communion: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

Admirar a Dios por Quien Es *Una reflexión personal en la Solemnidad de la Santísima Trinidad*

Celebrar a Dios por Él Mismo

Hoy, al celebrar la fiesta de la Santísima Trinidad, me doy cuenta de que no estamos celebrando un milagro específico, una intervención divina o una manifestación concreta como suele ocurrir en otras solemnidades. Hoy celebramos simplemente a Dios por quien Él es. No lo hago porque haya hecho algo por mí, sino porque su ser, su misterio, su identidad como Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo, merece por sí solo ser adorado. Es una fiesta que me invita a elevar la mirada, no para entender, sino para contemplar.

Un Dios Revelado como Familia

Entender a Dios como Trinidad me libera de la idea de un ser aislado, lejano o solitario. Dios se revela como una familia: tres personas distintas y, sin embargo, un solo Dios verdadero. Esta no es una fórmula matemática, sino una verdad que trasciende la lógica. No es que a veces se manifieste como Padre, otras como Hijo o Espíritu; no, son tres personas distintas que existen simultáneamente, y cada una es plenamente Dios. Comprender esto no se logra por conceptos, sino por relación, por comunión, por experiencia.

La Verdad que se Descubre Caminando

Jesús dijo que aún tenía muchas cosas que revelarnos, pero que no estábamos listos para comprenderlas. Por eso nos envió al Espíritu Santo, quien nos guiará a la verdad plena. Esta afirmación me conmueve, porque me recuerda que la verdad no es un dato que se posee, sino una persona que se encuentra. Dios no se

encierra en fórmulas, Él se revela en el tiempo, en la vida, en la relación. La verdad es Dios mismo, y por eso solo puedo conocerlo realmente si me dejo guiar, si camino con Él.

La Trinidad se Comprende Viviéndola

Pienso en aquellos que no conocen lo que es una familia. Aunque lean sobre ella, no la comprenden hasta que la viven. Así pasa con Dios. Puedo estudiarlo, saber los dogmas, entender los términos, pero si no tengo una experiencia viva de su amor, me quedo corto. Como en la caricatura de *Lilo y Stitch*, cuando el personaje extraterrestre vive el amor familiar, su vida cambia. Así también, cuando yo experimento a Dios como familia trinitaria, algo en mí se transforma profundamente.

Dios es Misterio que Me Atrae

Santa Teresa de Ávila lo expresó bellamente: "¡Cuán diferente es experimentar a Dios Trinidad que solo entenderlo!" Y es verdad. Como el océano, puedo estudiarlo y aprender mucho sobre él, pero nada se compara con mojarme los pies en sus aguas. Celebrar la Trinidad es dejar de intentar encerrar a Dios en una idea y, en su lugar, abrirle espacio en mi vida. Es reconocer que Él es Dios, y yo su criatura. Y así, con sencillez y reverencia, dejarme bendecir por ese Dios que es amor, unidad y comunión: Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo.

Planning a Funeral



Funerals are simple to plan in theory, but in practice, can be quite difficult to manage. The reason is because these events take place in the midst of the grieving process. For many people, planning a funeral is both distressing and frustrating—the responsibility can even seem impossible to manage.

We are here to teach you exactly how to plan a funeral to be held here at St Mary Immaculate Conception, to make the process as simple as possible, that way you can get back to focusing on yourself and your family.

1. When your loved one passes away, call the funeral home of your choice to facilitate taking your loved one to the funeral home. Let the funeral home know that your wishes are to have a Catholic funeral. The funeral home will now contact us to let us know that they have transported your loved one to their facility. Do not call the Church or drop by to plan a funeral as we will be fully aware of your concerns.
2. When the funeral home calls us, we put into motion to see when the Church is available and when a priest or Deacon is available. The funeral home will let us know when they are meeting with you to plan the funeral. At this meeting, a Deacon will be there to confirm the date and time and to make plans for the service.
3. At this meeting with the family and funeral home you have several choices for the type of services that can be held – traditional burial, cremation, and interment in a mausoleum. If you choose to have your remains placed in the Catholic cemetery—Calvary Cemetery in Brenham—the best option would be to celebrate a funeral Mass with the body present. At the conclusion of the Mass, the body would then be taken for cremation. Once the ashes are ready, they would be interred in the Catholic Columbaria located within Calvary Cemetery here in Brenham.
4. Here at St. Mary Immaculate Conception, we offer traditional burial and cremation. As you may be aware, our traditional burial (in-ground) spaces are decreasing with each funeral, and eventually, there will be no more spaces available.
5. Cremation: To many people's surprise, the Catholic Church does not forbid cremation practices. Since 1963, Catholics have been allowed to choose cremation over burial as a means of laying a loved one to rest. Cremation is a popular choice since it is less expensive and more than a full burial. However, it is important to remember the sacredness of the human body.
6. We have spoken with the local funeral homes, and they have provisions to meet our preferences for a cremation service.
7. Graveside services will be provided after the cremation.

Hopefully these guidelines will provide you with help in your time of need.

PLANIFICACIÓN DE UN FUNERAL



Los funerales son fáciles de planificar en teoría, pero en la práctica pueden ser bastante difíciles de gestionar. Esto se debe a que estos eventos ocurren en medio del proceso de duelo. Para muchas personas, planificar un funeral es angustioso y frustrante; la responsabilidad puede incluso parecer imposible de manejar.

Estamos aquí para enseñarle exactamente cómo planificar un funeral que se celebrará aquí en Santa María Inmaculada Concepción, para que el proceso sea lo más sencillo posible y así pueda volver a concentrarse en usted y su familia.

1. Cuando su ser querido fallezca, llame a la funeraria de su elección para facilitar el traslado. Informe a la funeraria que desea un funeral católico. La funeraria se pondrá en contacto con nosotros para informarnos que ya han trasladado a su ser querido a sus instalaciones. No llame a la iglesia ni se acerque a planificar un funeral, ya que estaremos al tanto de sus inquietudes.
2. Cuando la funeraria nos llame, verificaremos la disponibilidad de la iglesia y de un sacerdote o diácono. La funeraria nos avisará cuándo se reunirán con usted para planificar el funeral. En esta reunión, un diácono estará presente para confirmar la fecha y la hora, y para planificar el servicio.
3. En esta reunión con la familia y la funeraria, tendrá varias opciones para los servicios que se pueden realizar: entierro tradicional, cremación y entierro en un mausoleo. Si decide que sus restos sean depositados en el cementerio católico (Cementerio del Calvario en Brenham), la mejor opción sería celebrar una misa funeral con el cuerpo presente. Al finalizar la misa, el cuerpo será llevado a cremación. Una vez listas las cenizas, serán enterradas en el Columbario Católico ubicado dentro del Cementerio del Calvario en Brenham.
4. En Santa María Inmaculada Concepción, ofrecemos entierro tradicional y cremación. Como sabrá, nuestros espacios para entierros tradicionales (en tierra) disminuyen con cada funeral y, eventualmente, no habrá más espacios disponibles.
5. Cremación: Para sorpresa de muchos, la Iglesia Católica no prohíbe la cremación. Desde 1963, los católicos pueden optar por la cremación en lugar del entierro para dar descanso a un ser querido. La cremación es una opción popular, ya que es más económica y ofrece más que un entierro completo. Sin embargo, es importante recordar la sacralidad del cuerpo humano.
6. Hemos hablado con las funerarias locales y cuentan con servicios que se adaptan a nuestras preferencias para el servicio de cremación.
7. Se ofrecerán servicios funerarios después de la cremación..

Esperamos que estas directrices le sean de ayuda en este momento de necesidad.

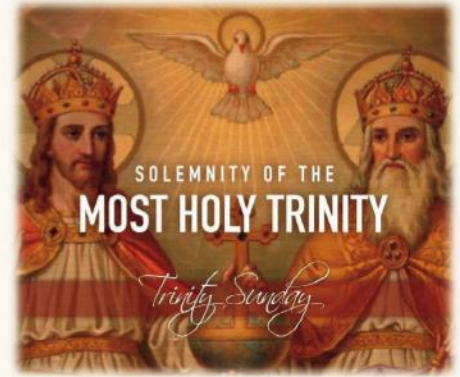

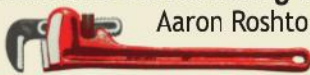
