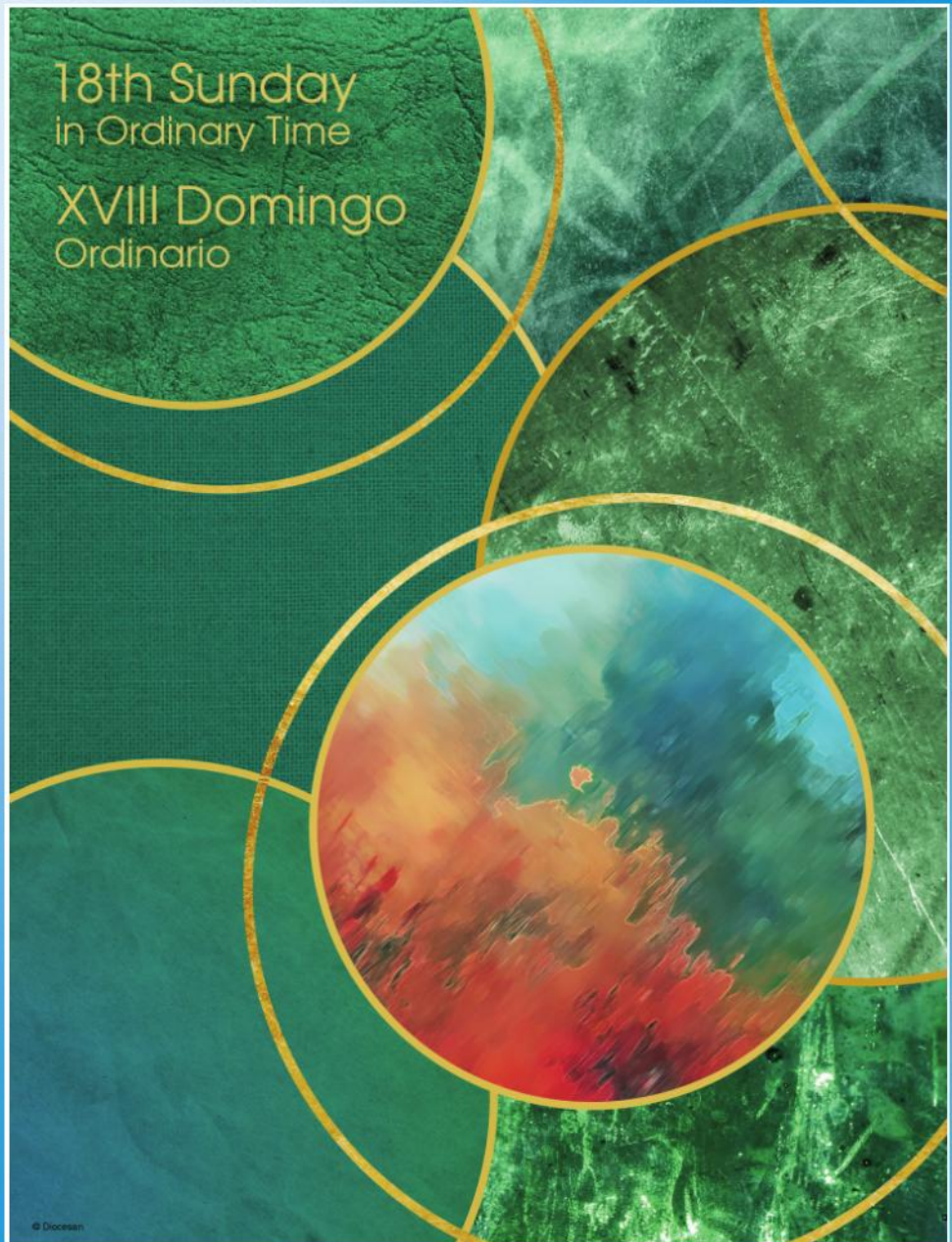

Robbing a Bank



The second reading from the Letter to the Colossians goes well with the first reading and the Gospel. Those passages warn how useless material wealth will be when we die. St. Paul continues this warning by reminding us that we have already died with Christ in baptism and risen to new life. To live this new life we must put to death whatever tendencies keep us from Christ.

Wealth can be a gift from God. The abuse is not necessarily in the possession of wealth. More likely, we abuse wealth either in the ways we attain it or use it—or both. How do we abuse the attainment of wealth? I can give an obvious answer, such as robbing a bank, but this makes it too easy to justify myself. Do I work a full day for my pay, or do I spend a lot of time visiting with other employees, surfing the Web, taking extra-long breaks, or texting my friends? Am I honest with my customers, charging only for work I have done?

As for using our wealth, we usually think of family first. Do we spoil our kids, so they can “have the things I couldn’t afford when I was young”? Or do we teach them to work for what they get? Do we also think of the poor and homeless? Do we teach our children to be generous to others?

Notice that Paul does not mention wealth. Instead he goes deeper, pointing out the thoughts and desires that lead to a life centered in wealth. In baptism, we put to death passion and greed, tendencies that push us to own more or to control another person. Paul uses the image of taking off these vices as if they were clothing and putting on a new self that shows Christ in us. When we have been renewed that way, then Christ becomes visible in all people. We no longer have reason to look down on anyone for being poor or sickly or of another race. We begin to see Christ in them, for as Paul says, “Christ is all and in all”(Colossians 3:11).



Robando un Banco

La segunda lectura de la Carta a los Colosenses encaja perfectamente con la primera lectura y el Evangelio. Estos pasajes nos advierten que las riquezas materiales serán inútiles al morir. San Pablo continúa esta advertencia recordándonos que ya hemos muerto con Cristo en el bautismo y resucitamos a una vida nueva. Para vivir esta vida nueva, debemos dar término a cualquier tendencia que nos aleje de Cristo.

La riqueza puede ser un don de Dios. El abuso de ella no existe necesariamente en poseerla. Lo más probable es que abusemos de la riqueza o en la forma que la obtenemos o cómo la utilizamos, o ambas cosas. ¿Cómo abusamos de obtener riquezas? Podría dar una respuesta obvia, como robar un banco, pero esto se me hace demasiado fácil justificarme. ¿Trabajo un día completo por mi sueldo o dedico mucho tiempo a visitar a otros empleados, navegar por internet, tomar descansos muy largos o enviar mensajes de texto a mis amigos? ¿Soy honesto con mis clientes y les cobro solo por el trabajo realizado?

En cuanto al uso de la riqueza, solemos pensar primero en la familia. ¿Consentimos a nuestros hijos para que puedan tener las cosas que yo no podía tener de joven? ¿O les enseñamos a trabajar por lo que obtienen? ¿Pensamos también en los pobres y en las personas sin hogar? ¿Enseñamos a nuestros hijos a ser generosos con los demás?

Observemos que Pablo no menciona la riqueza. En cambio, va más a fondo, señalando los pensamientos y deseos que conducen a una vida centrada en la riqueza. En el bautismo, damos término a la pasión y la avaricia, tendencias que nos impulsan a poseer más o a controlar a otra persona. Pablo utiliza la imagen de despojarse de estos vicios como si fueran ropas y revestirse de un nuevo ser que demuestra a Cristo dentro de nosotros. Cuando nos hemos renovado de esa manera, Cristo se hace visible en todas las personas. Ya no tenemos motivos para menospreciar a nadie por ser pobre, enfermo o de otra raza. Comenzamos a ver a Cristo en ellos, porque, como dice Pablo: “Cristo es todo en todos” (Colosenses 3,11).

DEACON'S CORNER

"Vanity of vanities all is vanity. This statement from our first reading sets the stage for all of the readings this weekend. Taken as a whole they caution and inform us to not consider earthly things of this life the most important things of our existence. Do not give most importance to attachment to things of this world. In the second reading Paul says to get rid of immorality of all kind rather put these things to death! In the Gospel Jesus warns us about what happens to those whose store up treasures of this world but are not rich in the things of God.

Of course we do have things in the life that we should attend to. For example parents have to instruct their children in the ways of God. We need money to live. Most of us need to work. Even Jesus and St. Paul worked; Jesus as a carpenter and Paul as a tent maker. The apostles were fishermen until Jesus gave them a higher calling. While many saints were clergy and religious, many were not: e.g., for example Mary and Joseph. We have other saints who were married with children and others who were single. We also have saints that were children or young adults. Before mass I meet with the altar servers to pray. We end the prayer asking St. Tarcisus the patron saint of altar servers to pray for us. His image is in one of the stained-glass windows in the Sunday sacristy. As a young man one day he was carrying the Blessed Sacrament to prisoners. He preferred death at the hands of a mob rather than deliver the Blessed Sacrament to them.

All is vanity. The enticements of the world will all pass away one day. Jesus says this much in the Gospel. Money, and prestige will mean nothing. Focusing our attention solely on these earthly things will not get us to heaven. What is Jesus calling us to do? What do we give most of our attention to? What is most important in our lives? What will lead us to an eternity in heaven. *Do we want to be a saint?*

RINCON DEL DIACONO

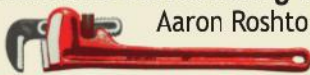
Vanidad de vanidades, todo es vanidad. Esta afirmación de nuestra primera lectura sienta las bases para todas las lecturas de este fin de semana. En conjunto, nos advierten e informan que no debemos considerar las cosas terrenales de esta vida como lo más importante de nuestra existencia. No demos la máxima importancia al apego a las cosas de este mundo. En la segunda lectura, Pablo dice que debemos deshacernos de toda inmoralidad, ¡más bien dar muerte a estas cosas! En el Evangelio, Jesús nos advierte sobre lo que les sucede a quienes acumulan tesoros de este mundo pero no son ricos en las cosas de Dios.

Por supuesto, tenemos cosas en la vida que debemos atender. Por ejemplo, los padres deben instruir a sus hijos en los caminos de Dios. Necesitamos dinero para vivir. La mayoría de nosotros necesitamos trabajar. Incluso Jesús y San Pablo trabajaron: Jesús como carpintero y Pablo como fabricante de tiendas. Los apóstoles fueron pescadores hasta que Jesús les dio una vocación superior. Si bien muchos santos eran clérigos y religiosos, muchos no lo eran, por ejemplo, María y José. Tenemos otros santos que estaban casados y tenían hijos, y otros que... Eran solteros. También tenemos santos que eran niños o jóvenes. Antes de la misa me reúno con los monaguillos para rezar. Terminamos la oración pidiendo a San Tarcisio, el santo patrón de los monaguillos, que rece por nosotros. Su imagen está en uno de los vitrales de la sacristía dominical. Un día, de joven, llevaba el Santísimo Sacramento a los presos. Prefirió morir a manos de una turba antes que entregárselo.

Todo es vanidad. Las tentaciones del mundo pasarán algún día. Jesús lo dice en el Evangelio. El dinero y el prestigio no significarán nada. Centrar nuestra atención únicamente en estas cosas terrenales no nos llevará al cielo. ¿A qué nos llama Jesús? ¿A qué dedicamos la mayor parte de nuestra atención? ¿Qué es lo más importante en nuestras vidas? ¿Qué nos llevará a la eternidad en el cielo? ¿Queremos ser santos?
