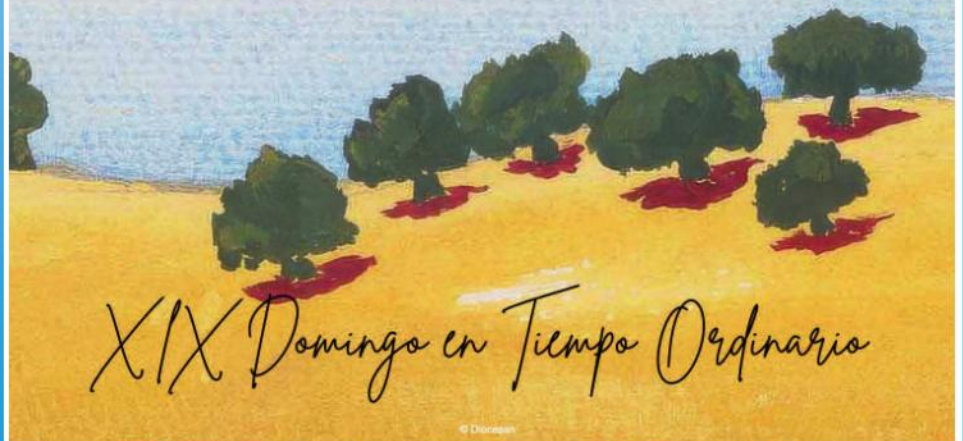

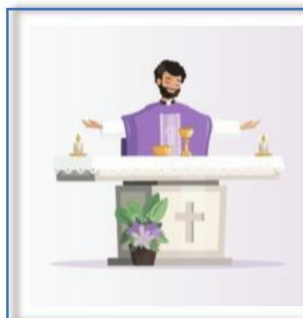

Are you talking to me?



In today's Gospel Jesus talks about being prepared, using the parable of the servants waiting for their master's return from a wedding. Parables usually have a surprise twist and this one is no exception. Jesus pictures the master coming back at a late hour and finding the servants ready for him. The master is so pleased that he begins to wait on the servants—he serves them a meal. (I can almost hear the disciples saying, "No way!")

Peter is a man who is not afraid to speak up or ask a question. That may be one of the reasons Jesus made him the head of the apostles. Perhaps Peter was thinking, "Surely we will be prepared when Jesus comes again. He must be talking about the rest of the people." When he asks Jesus whom the parable is meant for, Jesus ignores him! At least it seems that way at first. Jesus expands on the theme of readiness by describing the servant who took advantage of the master's absence—he will be punished severely. To answer Peter's question, Jesus warns that the servant who knew his duties would be punished more than one who was ignorant of those expectations. Peter and the disciples should have seen themselves as the servants who knew what was expected.

That warning is one for us to hear also. We may look down on non-Christians or wonder if they will get to heaven. But the Lord doesn't expect as much from those who don't know God. Instead of judging them, we would be better off looking at ourselves. Am I serious about my faith, serious enough to show it in my actions? Has my good example ever brought a non-believer to the Church? If I can see Jesus in someone who doesn't know the Lord, the respect I show that person could draw them to believe.

There are examples of this even in your own parish. If you have been in the parish for many years, you could be expected to notice a newcomer more readily. How do you welcome them? Do you get so comfortable with your friends that you don't think about reaching out to a visitor? I think Jesus would expect those of us who feel at home in our church to make an effort to bring new members into our circle. "So how much does Jesus expect of me?" The answer could be in how well you know Jesus.



¿Me Hablas a Mí?

En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús habla de estar preparados, utilizando la parábola de los criados que esperaban el regreso de su señor de una boda. Las parábolas suelen tener un giro inesperado, y esta tiene uno también. Jesús describe al señor regresando tarde y encontrando a los criados listos. El señor está tan contento que se pone a atenderlos a ellos y les sirve una comida. (Casi puedo oír a los discípulos decir: "¡No puede ser!").

Pedro es un hombre que no teme hablar ni hacer preguntas. Puede ser que esa sea una de las razones por las que Jesús lo nombró jefe de los apóstoles. Quizás Pedro pensaba: "Seguramente estaremos preparados cuando Jesús regrese. Debe estar hablando del resto de la gente". Cuando le pregunta a Jesús a quién va dirigida la parábola, ¡Jesús lo ignora! Por lo menos así parece al principio. Jesús desarrolla el tema de la preparación al describir al siervo que se aprovechó de la ausencia de su señor: será castigado severamente. Para responder a la pregunta de Pedro, Jesús advierte que el criado que conocía sus deberes sería más castigado que uno que no conociera las expectativas. Pedro y los discípulos deberían haberse visto a sí mismos como los criados que sabían lo que se esperaba de ellos.

Esa advertencia también nos corresponde a nosotros. Podemos menospreciar a los no cristianos o preguntarnos si llegarán al cielo. Pero el Señor no espera tanto de quienes no conocen a Dios. En lugar de juzgarlos, sería mejor que nos examináramos a nosotros mismos. ¿Soy serio en mi fe, lo suficientemente serio como para demostrarlo con mis acciones? ¿Alguna vez mi buen ejemplo ha atraído a un no creyente a la Iglesia? Si puedo ver a Jesús en alguien que no conoce al Señor, el respeto que le demuestro podría atraerlo a creer.

Hay ejemplos de esto incluso en tu propia parroquia. Si llevas muchos años en la parroquia, podrían esperar de ti que te des cuenta más fácilmente cuando llega alguien nuevo. ¿Cómo le das la bienvenida? ¿Te sientes tan cómodo con tus amigos que ni siquiera piensas en acercarte a una visita? Creo que Jesús esperaría que quienes nos sentimos a gusto en nuestras parroquias nos esforzáramos por traer a nuevos miembros dentro de nuestro círculo. "Así que ¿cuánto espera Jesús de mí?" Podrías encontrar la respuesta en cuánto conoces a Jesús.

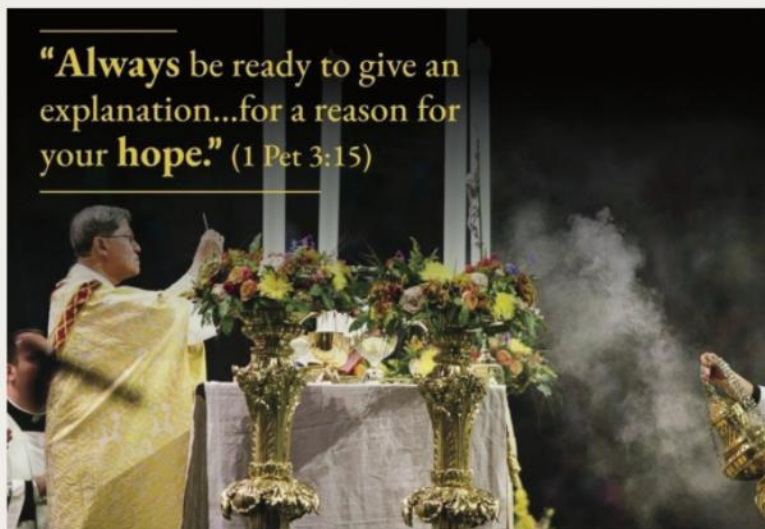

DEACON'S CORNER

This weekend's readings speak of faith, especially Abraham's faith. In fact the word faith occurs six times in the second reading. Abraham's faith in God was so great that the Church calls Abraham our father in faith. Abraham had faith in God's promise of a son and many descendants, even though Abraham and Sarah his wife were advanced in years. And so it was, his son Isaac was born.

Then God told Abraham to sacrifice his son Isaac. This had to be very difficult for Abraham. Why would God tell Abraham to sacrifice his only son? Primarily to test Abraham's faith. In fact Abraham's faith was so strong that he believed that God would raise Isaac from the dead!

While Abraham and Isaac travelled to the place of sacrifice Isaac carried the wood for the sacrifice, an image, a precursor of Jesus carrying the wood of His cross to the sacrifice of Calvary. Isaac asks "where is the lamb for the sacrifice?" Abraham answered God will provide the lamb; and so it was. God stopped Abraham from sacrificing his son by providing a lamb. What does this have to do with us? This whole event points to the fact that God the Father was willing to sacrifice His Son Jesus the Lamb of God to save us from our sins. Isaac was spared because God provided the lamb for sacrifice. Likewise God, provides His son, Jesus the Lamb of God sacrificed to save us of our sins.

Abraham had great faith. **Is our faith as strong as Abraham's faith?** While sometimes our faith may be tested, God probably won't demand as great a proof of faith as He did of Abraham. But he does want us to live a life of faith. Not only believing and living religious teachings but turning over our life to Him and developing a deep relationship with Him. He loved us enough to die save us. Let us live to reciprocate that love.

RINCON DEL DIACONO

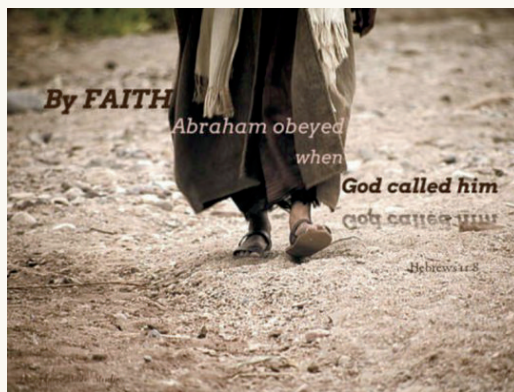
Las lecturas de este fin de semana hablan de la fe, especialmente de la fe de Abraham. De hecho, la palabra fe aparece seis veces en la segunda lectura. La fe de Abraham en Dios era tan grande que la Iglesia lo llama nuestro padre en la fe. Abraham tenía fe en la promesa de Dios de un hijo y una descendencia numerosa, a pesar de que Abraham y su esposa Sara eran de edad avanzada. Y así nació su hijo Isaac.

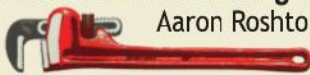
Entonces Dios le dijo a Abraham que sacrificara a su hijo Isaac. Esto debió ser muy difícil para Abraham. ¿Por qué le diría Dios a Abraham que sacrificara a su único hijo? Principalmente para probar su fe. De hecho, la fe de Abraham era tan fuerte que creyó que Dios resucitaría a Isaac de entre los muertos.

Mientras Abraham e Isaac viajaban al lugar del sacrificio, Isaac llevaba la leña para el sacrificio, una imagen, un precursor de Jesús llevando la leña de su cruz al sacrificio del Calvario. Isaac pregunta: "¿Dónde está el cordero para el sacrificio?". Abraham responde: Dios proveerá el cordero; y así fue. Dios impidió que Abraham sacrificara a su hijo al proporcionarle un cordero. ¿Qué tiene esto que ver con nosotros? Todo este acontecimiento señala que Dios Padre estuvo dispuesto a sacrificar a su Hijo Jesús, el Cordero de Dios, para salvarnos de nuestros pecados. Isaac fue perdonado porque Dios proporcionó el cordero para el sacrificio. De igual manera, Dios proporciona a su hijo, Jesús, el Cordero de Dios, sacrificado para salvarnos de nuestros pecados.

Abraham tuvo una gran fe. ¿Es nuestra fe tan fuerte como la de Abraham? Aunque a veces nuestra fe pueda ser puesta a prueba, Dios probablemente no exigirá una prueba de fe tan grande como la que le exigió a Abraham. Pero sí quiere que vivamos una vida de fe. No solo creyendo y viviendo las enseñanzas religiosas, sino entregándole nuestra vida y desarrollando una profunda relación con él. Nos amó lo suficiente como para morir por nosotros. Vivamos para corresponder a ese amor.
