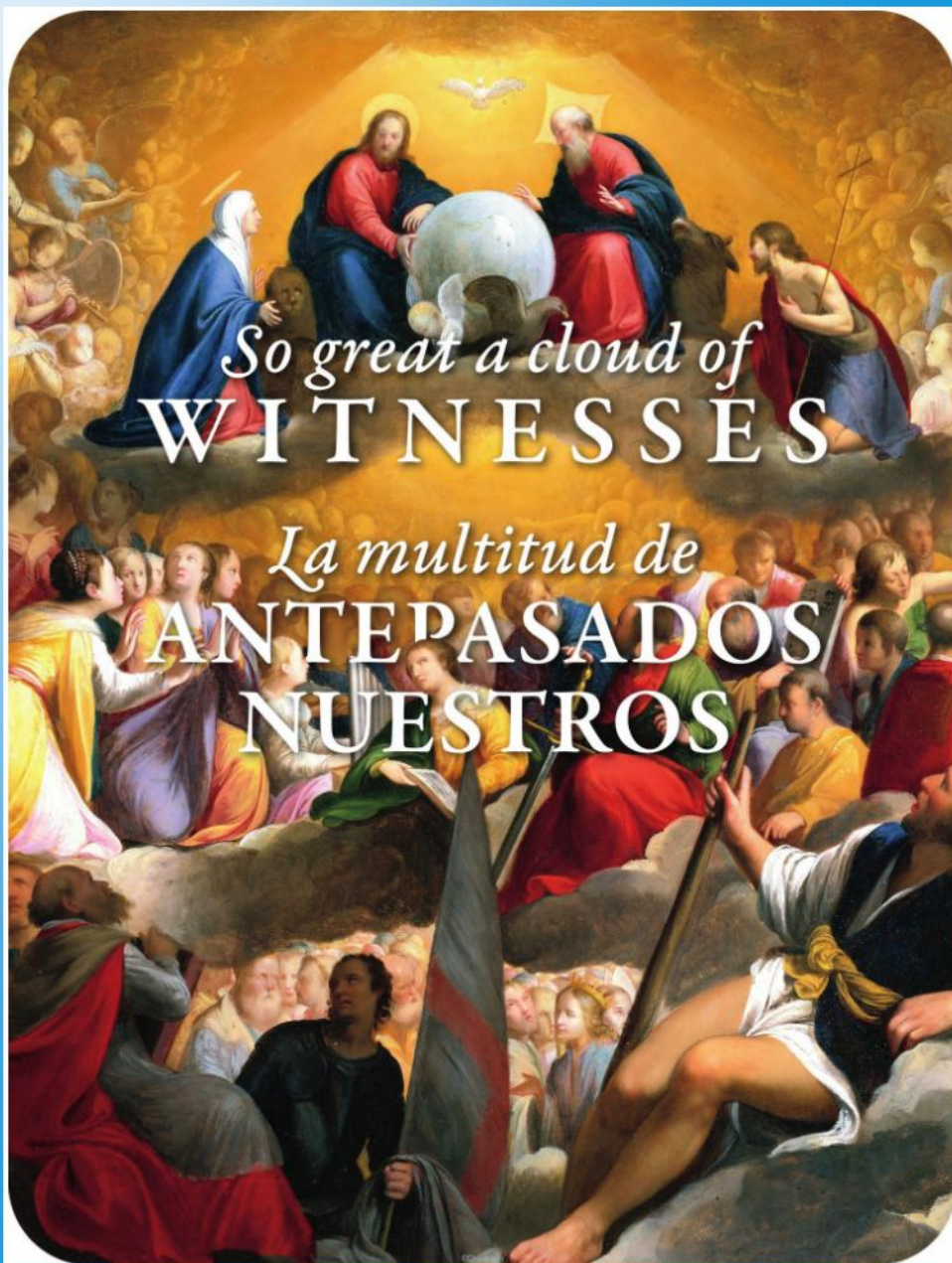

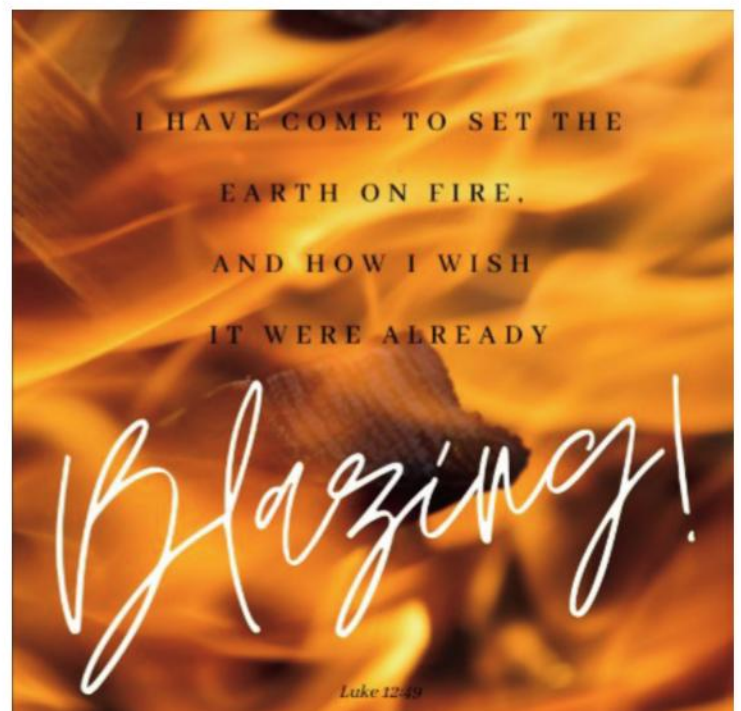

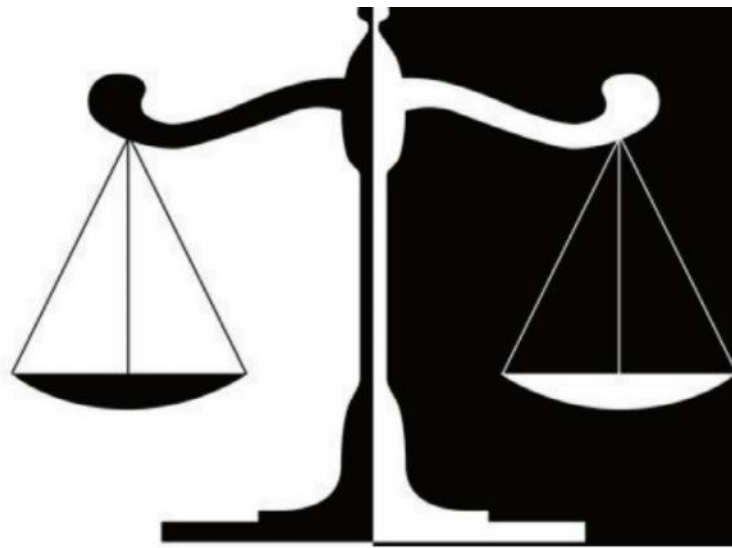
How much is good enough? How much is too much? How do we know when we've given all that is required of us? How do we know when we have been generous enough or faithful enough to please the Lord? How do we know we have done enough to avoid sin?

Although I do not for one minute believe that God is sitting up in heaven next to a giant scoreboard keeping a tally of our good and bad deeds, we will be judged at the end of our lives. Today's second reading provokes self analysis in this regard: "In your struggle against sin you have not yet resisted to the point of shedding blood." While this may most often be interpreted as becoming a martyr, it also makes me think of Jesus in the Garden of Gethsemani. He sweat drops of blood because His whole being resisted the idea of enduring His Passion and Death.

How does our body react when we sin? Do we give into temptation so often that we don't even feel a ping to our conscience? Do we instantly regret what we have done and seek forgiveness from the person we have wronged? Do we look for the next available confession time? Do we let our sins pile up one upon the other and only seek the Sacrament when we can no longer stand it?

Our Lord revealed to St. Faustina sheds light on how much our sins hurt His Sacred Heart. If we truly took that to heart, we would flee from sin so much more often. It would become repugnant to us. During the Divine Mercy Novena, we read "bring to me all mankind, especially sinners, and immerse them in the ocean of My mercy. In this way you will console Me in the bitter grief into which the loss of souls plunges Me" (*Diary of St. Maria Faustina Kowalska*).

So let us turn away from sin and instead spread love and joy and truth. Let us set the earth on fire with the blazing love of God! (see today's Gospel)



¿Cuanto?

¿Cuánto es suficiente? ¿Cuánto es demasiado? ¿Cómo sabemos que hemos dado todo lo que han requerido de nosotros? ¿Cómo sabemos que hemos sido lo suficientemente generosos o fieles para agradar al Señor? ¿Cómo sabemos que hemos hecho lo suficiente para evitar el pecado?

Aunque no creo ni por un instante que Dios esté sentado en el cielo junto a un marcador gigantesco que lleva la cuenta de nuestras buenas y malas acciones, es cierto que seremos juzgados al final de nuestras vidas. La segunda lectura de hoy me invita a un autoanálisis al respecto: “todavía no han llegado a derramar su sangre en la lucha contra el pecado”. Si bien esto suele interpretarse como convertirse en mártir, también me recuerda a Jesús en el Huerto de Getsemaní. Sudó gotas de sangre porque todo su ser se resistió a la idea de padecer su Pasión y Muerte.

¿Cómo reacciona nuestro cuerpo cuando pecamos? ¿Cedemos a la tentación tan a menudo que ni siquiera sentimos un pequeño remordimiento de conciencia? ¿Nos arrepentimos al instante de lo que hemos hecho y buscamos el perdón de la persona a la que hemos ofendido? ¿Buscamos la próxima oportunidad para ir a confesarnos? ¿Dejamos que nuestros pecados se amontonen y solo buscamos el Sacramento cuando ya no podemos soportarlo más?

Nuestro Señor le reveló a Santa Faustina cuánto hiere el pecado a su Sagrado Corazón. Si realmente lo tomáramos en serio, huiríamos del pecado con mucha más frecuencia. Nos resultaría repugnante. Durante la Novena a la Divina Misericordia, leemos: “Trae a mí a toda la humanidad, especialmente a los pecadores, y sumérgelos en el océano de mi misericordia. Así me consolarás en el amargo dolor en que me sume la pérdida de las almas” (*Diario de Santa María Faustina Kowalska*).

Así que, alejémonos del pecado y, en cambio, derramemos amor, alegría y verdad. ¡Encendemos la tierra con el amor ardiente de Dios! (ver el Evangelio de hoy)

DEACON'S CORNER

Today's readings show that can be difficult to be God's disciples. It's not always easy to follow Jesus. **We might have to suffer.** Our first reading is from the book of the prophet Jeremiah.

Born about six hundred years before Jesus, God called Jerimiah as a young man to prophesy against Israel because Israel had turned away from God in many ways including worshipping false gods. Jeremiah tried to call the people back to God but he did not like being a prophet. He even asked God to relieve him of his prophetic ministry because of the suffering and hardship he endured. Jeremiah's preaching caused division and anger among the people. He was denounced, arrested, imprisoned even put on public display in shackles. In today's Gospel we hear the people put him in a dry well and left him to starve to death. But Jeremiah remained loyal to God and to his ministry in spite of his suffering. Finally he had to flee Israel and died in Egypt, his ministry an apparent failure. His ministry cost Jeremiah greatly but he remained loyal to God and today we consider him one of the greatest Old Testament prophets. In fact he was one of the prophets who predicted the coming of the messiah. It was the same for St. Paul. Paul's ministry caused division among the people. Paul suffered. He was beaten with rods, stoned and imprisoned. He suffered shipwreck at sea and spent a night floating on the water. Finally, the Romans beheaded him. His ministry cost him greatly but like Jeremiah, Paul remained loyal to God in spite of rejection, suffering and death. In fact in Colossians 1:24 Paul, says I rejoice in my sufferings for the sake of the Church!(Col. 1:24). Finally, Jesus also suffered. Like Jerimiah and Paul Jesus' ministry cost him everything. Jesus remained loyal to His Father even though many rejected him. He knew his ministry would be divisive. In today's Gospel he says **I have come to cause division**: even within families! **What can we learn from these readings?** It's the same for us as it was for Jerimiah, Paul and even Jesus. Jesus calls us to be his disciples to follow and witness to Him even though people may reject, revile, ridicule or persecute us. Discipleship has a cost! It can be difficult. Are we his disciples even when it is difficult, embarrassing or dangerous? Are we his disciples?

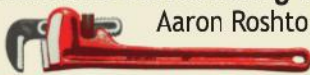
RINCON DEL DIACONO

*Las lecturas de hoy muestran lo difícil que puede ser ser discípulos de Dios. No siempre es fácil seguir a Jesús. **Puede que tengamos que sufrir.** Nuestra primera lectura es del libro del profeta Jeremías.*

*Nacido unos seiscientos años antes de Jesús, Dios llamó a Jeremías de joven para profetizar contra Israel, ya que este se había alejado de Dios de muchas maneras, incluyendo la adoración de dioses falsos. Jeremías intentó llamar al pueblo a Dios, pero no le gustaba ser profeta. Incluso le pidió a Dios que lo liberara de su ministerio profético debido al sufrimiento y las dificultades que padeció. La predicación de Jeremías causó división e ira en el pueblo. Fue denunciado, arrestado, encarcelado e incluso exhibido públicamente con grilletes. En el Evangelio de hoy, escuchamos cómo el pueblo lo arrojó a un pozo seco y lo abandonó a morir de hambre. Pero Jeremías permaneció fiel a Dios y a su ministerio a pesar de su sufrimiento. Finalmente, tuvo que huir de Israel y murió en Egipto; su ministerio fue un aparente fracaso. Su ministerio le costó mucho a Jeremías, pero él permaneció fiel a Dios y hoy lo consideramos uno de los grandes profetas del Antiguo Testamento. De hecho, fue uno de los profetas que predijo la llegada del Mesías. Lo mismo le ocurrió a San Pablo. El ministerio de Pablo causó división en el pueblo. Pablo sufrió. Fue azotado con varas, apedreado y encarcelado. Naufragó en el mar y pasó una noche flotando. Finalmente, los romanos lo decapitaron. Su ministerio le costó mucho, pero al igual que Jeremías, Pablo permaneció fiel a Dios a pesar del rechazo, el sufrimiento y la muerte. De hecho, en Colosenses 1:24, Pablo dice: «Me regocijo en mis sufrimientos por la Iglesia» (Col. 1:24). Finalmente, Jesús también sufrió. Al igual que Jeremías y Pablo, el ministerio de Jesús le costó todo. Jesús permaneció fiel a su Padre a pesar del rechazo de muchos. Sabía que su ministerio sería divisivo. En el Evangelio de hoy, dice: **«He venido a causar división, ¡incluso dentro de las familias!»**. **¿Qué podemos aprender de estas lecturas?** Para nosotros es igual que para Jeremías, Pablo e incluso Jesús. Jesús nos llama a ser sus discípulos, a seguirlo y dar testimonio de él aunque nos rechacen, nos insulten, nos ridiculicen o nos persigan. ¡El discipulado tiene un precio! Puede ser difícil. ¿Somos sus discípulos incluso cuando es difícil, vergonzoso o peligroso? ¿Somos sus discípulos?*
