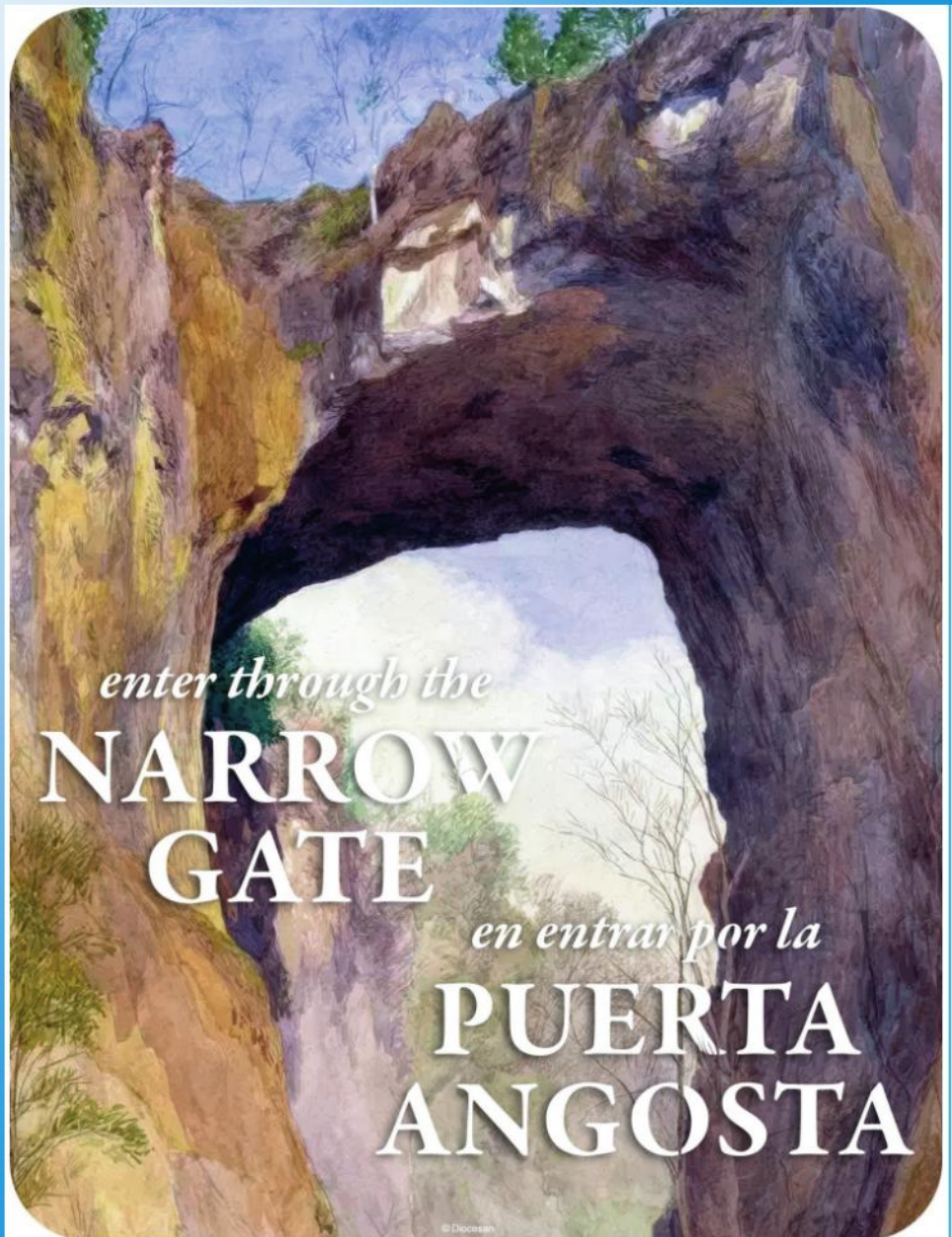

Looking Good



Don't you love it when the underdog wins? When the Astros beat the Dodgers for the championship or the Texans beat the Cowboys, or the Rockets beat anyone? Even when I watch a game with no Texas teams playing, I still like to root for the underdog. That is what I like about today's Gospel: the last will be first and the first will be last.

Some say that Jesus was referring to the Jews, God's chosen people, whom Jesus called first to be his disciples. When they rejected him, the call went out to the Gentiles, who became followers. Or perhaps in Jesus' time, he was talking about the leaders of the Jews, the scribes and Pharisees. These refused to follow Jesus, while ordinary Jews who did not feel threatened by Jesus' teaching became disciples.

In a way, you can understand why the leaders rejected Jesus. They made a nice living out of the offerings made by ordinary Jews. As long as they could decide who could enter the temple, they had a nice income flow. They were smart enough to include the poor, by asking them for smaller offerings. And who could argue with them? They worked for God. How dare Jesus say that they would be cast out, while people from the rest of the world would enter the Kingdom of God!

And how about us? Remember that the Gospel was not written for non-believers. Are we threatened by Jesus' message? Just as the scribes and Pharisees considered themselves important in God's eyes because of their office, do we consider ourselves "saved" because we call ourselves Christians? Do we respect all people, or just the ones we like? Are we generous to the poor, or just to our friends? Do we give good example to the people we work with? Do we follow our conscience or do we follow the crowd?

Entry into the Kingdom of God is not a fashion statement. We don't get there by looking good. We are invited by Jesus to be last on earth so we can be first in the Kingdom

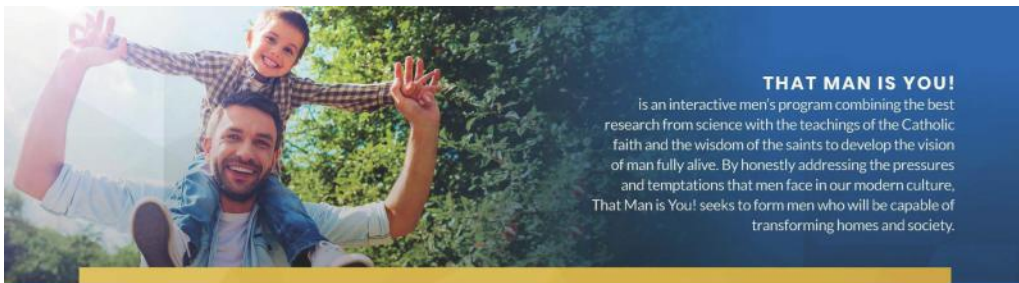

Eso es lo que me gusta del Evangelio de hoy: los últimos serán los primeros y los primeros serán los últimos.

Algunos dicen que Jesús se refería a los judíos, el pueblo elegido de Dios, a quienes llamó primero para ser sus discípulos. Cuando lo rechazaron, el llamado se extendió a los gentiles, quienes se convirtieron en seguidores. O quizás, en tiempos de Jesús, se refería a los líderes judíos, los escribas y fariseos. Estos se negaron a seguir a Jesús, mientras que los judíos comunes que no se sentían amenazados por sus enseñanzas se convirtieron en discípulos.

En cierto modo, se puede entender por qué los líderes rechazaron a Jesús. Se ganaban bien la vida con las ofrendas de los judíos comunes. Mientras podían decidir quién entraba al templo, tenían un buen flujo de ingresos. Fueron lo suficientemente inteligentes como para incluir a los pobres, pidiéndoles ofrendas más pequeñas. ¿Y quién podía discutir con ellos? Trabajaban para Dios. ¿Cómo se atrevía Jesús a decir que serían expulsados, mientras que personas del resto del mundo entrarían en el Reino de Dios!

¿Y nosotros? ¿Nos sentimos amenazados por el mensaje de Jesús? Así como los escribas y fariseos se consideraban importantes a los ojos de Dios por su oficio, ¿nos consideramos "salvos" porque nos llamamos cristianos? ¿Respetamos a todos o solo a los que nos caen bien? ¿Somos generosos con los pobres o solo con nuestros amigos? ¿Damos buen ejemplo a quienes trabajan con nosotros? ¿Seguimos nuestra conciencia o seguimos a la multitud?

Entrar en el Reino de Dios no es una moda. No llegamos allí por lucir bien. Jesús nos invita a ser los últimos en la tierra para poder ser los primeros en el Reino

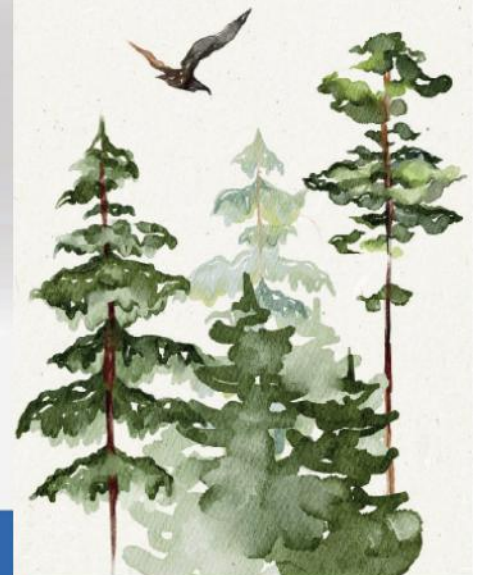

DEACON'S CORNER

In Lk 13:22-24 someone asks Jesus, ***“Lord will only a few people will be saved.”*** Jesus answers: ***“Strive to enter through the narrow gate...many will attempt to enter but will not be strong enough.”***

We find a similar but more detailed passage in Matthew 7:13-14: ***“Enter by the narrow gate; for the gate is wide and the way easy that leads to destruction, and those who find it are many. For the gate is narrow and the way is hard that leads to life and those who find it are few.”*** What are we to make of this seemingly harsh statement of Jesus? Jesus’ statement is parable about who enters heaven (through the small narrow gate) and those who do not (through the wide gates.) One commentator notes: (ICSB note on Matt. 7:13) that cities had walls with wide gates to permit access. There were wide and tall enough for caravans of people and animals to enter the city. Many passed through with ease. Other smaller gates allowed only pedestrian traffic. Only a few entered by the small narrow gates. Likewise the Jerusalem Temple had a series of gates that prohibited entry for the unqualified. Only a privileged few had direct access to God.

The Catechism pp1696 echoes Jesus teaching saying: ***There are two ways, the one of life and the other of death; between the two there is a great difference.*** See also Lk 16:19-31. Jesus’ teaching is a warning to not become complacent in our spiritual life. Don’t let things of this world distract you from your spiritual life. Yes it takes effort to enter through the narrow gate of holiness and submission to and love of God; but with God’s grace it can be done. So many who have gone before us have entered that narrow gate to life with God.

May we be blessed to join them one day!

RINCON DEL DIACONO

En Lucas 13:22-24, alguien le pregunta a Jesús: ***«Señor, solo unos pocos se salvarán».*** Jesús responde: ***«Esfuércense por entrar por la puerta estrecha... muchos intentarán entrar, pero no serán lo suficientemente fuertes».***

Encontramos un pasaje similar, pero más detallado, en Mateo 7:13-14: ***«Entren por la puerta estrecha; porque ancha es la puerta y espacioso el camino que lleva a la perdición, y muchos son los que la hallan. Porque angosta es la puerta y angosto el camino que lleva a la vida, y pocos son los que la hallan».*** ¿Qué debemos interpretar de esta declaración aparentemente dura de Jesús? La declaración de Jesús es una parábola sobre quién entra al cielo (por la puerta estrecha) y quién no (por las puertas anchas). Un comentarista señala (nota de la ICSB sobre Mateo 7:13) que las ciudades tenían murallas con puertas anchas para permitir el acceso. Eran lo suficientemente anchas y altas como para que caravanas de personas y animales entraran en la ciudad. Muchos pasaban sin problemas. Otras puertas más pequeñas solo permitían el paso peatonal. Solo unos pocos entraban por las puertas estrechas. Asimismo, el Templo de Jerusalén tenía varias puertas que prohibían la entrada a quienes no estaban cualificados. Solo unos pocos privilegiados tenían acceso directo a Dios.

El Catecismo, pág. 1696, hace eco de la enseñanza de Jesús: ***«Hay dos caminos: uno de vida y otro de muerte; entre los dos hay una gran diferencia».*** Véase también Lc 16,19-31. La enseñanza de Jesús es una advertencia para no caer en la complacencia en nuestra vida espiritual. No dejes que las cosas de este mundo te distraigan de tu vida espiritual.

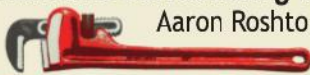
