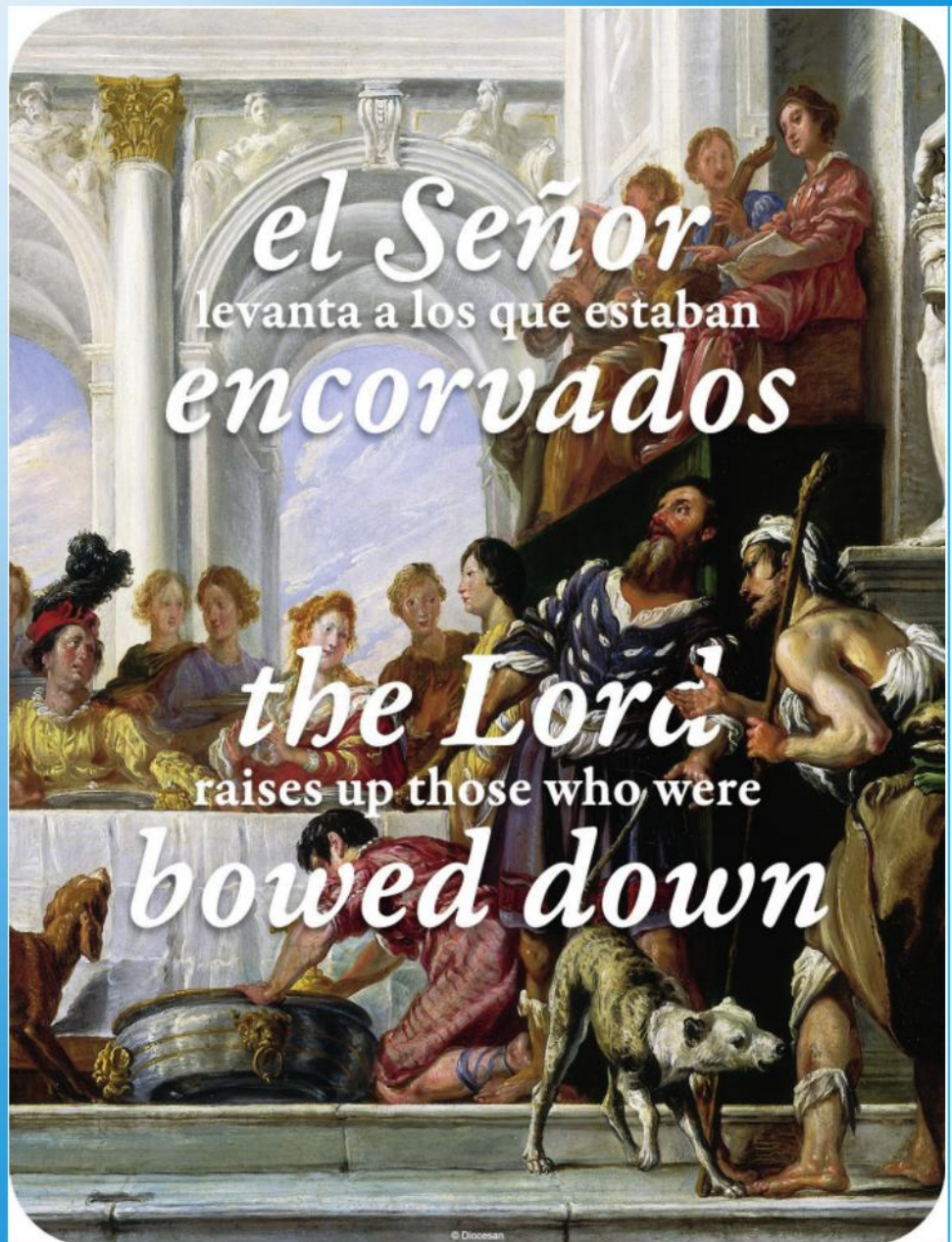

Coach Paul

Today's reading from First Timothy sounds almost like a coach getting his team ready for the big game. This coach has much higher goals than a home run or a touchdown. Instead of pursuing a league championship, he seeks faith, love, patience, and gentleness. How about us? Are we in the game or on the sidelines? Let's look at what Coach Paul is talking about.

We strive for faith when we see it as not just believing that God exists or that Jesus is God's Son. Faith is a relationship with the Lord in which we imitate Jesus' outlook on life, his teachings, his love of God. We struggle with his commands to love our enemies, to turn the other cheek, to forgive all wrongs, and to take up our cross each day. As Paul would say, we are "competing well for the faith."

We pursue love by listening to the Gospel, in which Jesus tells the parable of the rich man who was only concerned with his own comfort. Jesus says that if we truly understood the prophets, such as our first reading from Amos, we would not spend all our energy and wealth on ourselves. We may find that love for our family is much easier than love for strangers or the homeless, but Jesus never said that love would be easy.

As we learn to let go of our need to have everything go our way, we become more patient with people who disagree with us, or with frustrations and problems. We learn to see God in our setbacks as well as in our successes. Striving to see Jesus in everyone, we can become more patient with them. They will begin to see Jesus in us as our devotion to him grows. Experiencing the Lord is the championship we want.



Entrenador Pablo

La lectura de hoy de la primera carta a Timoteo suena casi como la de un entrenador preparando a su equipo para un gran partido. Este entrenador tiene metas mucho más altas que un home run o un touchdown. En lugar de buscar un campeonato de liga, busca la fe, el amor, la paciencia y la amabilidad. ¿Y nosotros? ¿Estamos en el partido o sentado en el banquillo? Veamos a qué se refiere el entrenador Pablo.

Buscamos la fe cuando la entendemos no solo como creer que Dios existe o que Jesús es el Hijo de Dios. La fe es una relación con el Señor en la que imitamos la perspectiva de Jesús sobre la vida, sus enseñanzas, su amor por Dios. Batallamos con sus mandatos de amar a los enemigos, poner la otra mejilla, perdonar todas las ofensas y tomar la cruz cada día. Como diría Pablo, estamos "luchando en el noble combate de la fe".

Buscamos el amor escuchando el Evangelio, en el que Jesús cuenta la parábola del hombre rico que solo se preocupaba por su propia comodidad. Jesús dice que si realmente entiendiéramos a los profetas, como la primera lectura de Amós, no gastaríamos toda nuestra energía y riqueza en nosotros mismos. Quizás descubramos que amar a nuestra familia es mucho más fácil que amar a los desconocidos o a las personas sin hogar, pero Jesús nunca dijo que el amor sería fácil.

Al aprender a dejar de lado la necesidad de que todo salga como nosotros queramos, nos volvemos más pacientes con quienes no están de acuerdo con nosotros, o con las frustraciones y los problemas. Aprendemos a ver a Dios tanto en los fracasos como en los éxitos. Al esforzarnos a ver a Jesús en cada persona, podemos ser más pacientes con ellos. Comenzarán a ver a Jesús en nosotros a medida que crezca nuestra devoción a él. Experimentar al Señor es el campeonato que anhelamos.

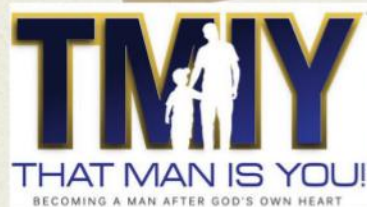

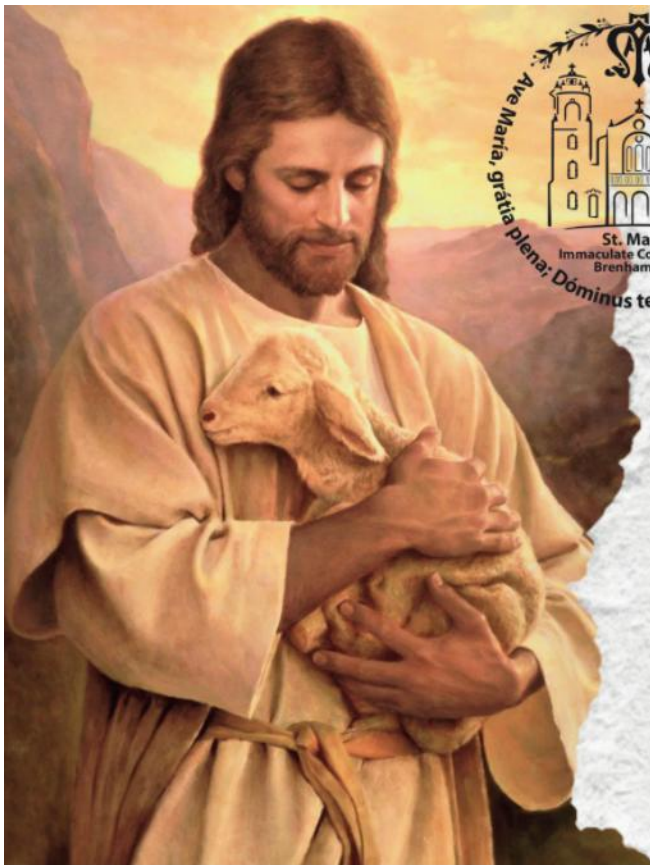

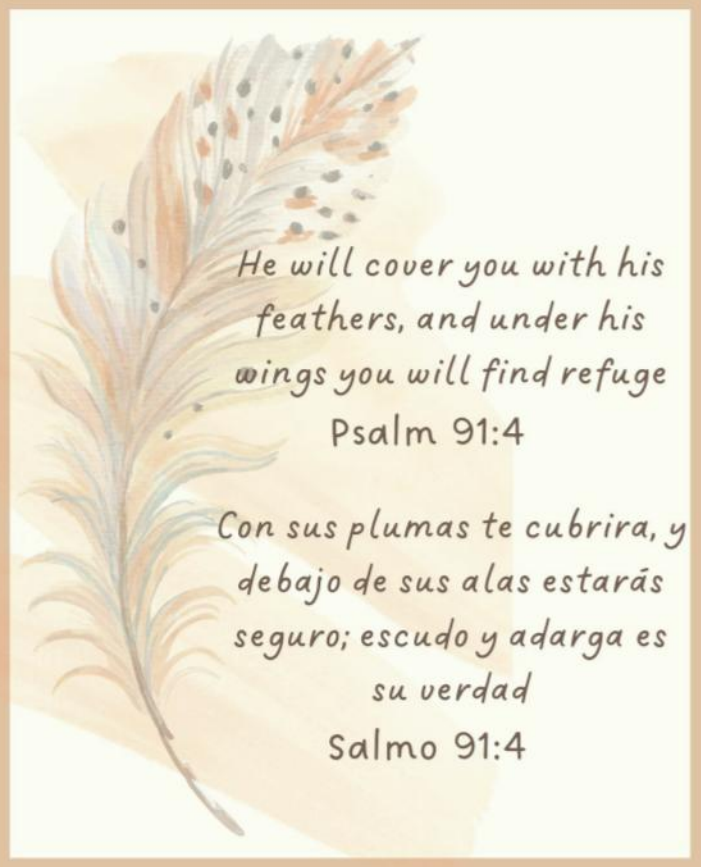

DEACON'S CORNER

In my 22plus years as an ordained Deacon I have been asked many questions about Faith, why's, what is a Deacon, my paycheck and what are my duties as a Deacon. I would like to address the question about duties and the definition of the word "duties."

Being a Deacon is not a job, it is a ministry. We are called to serve others as read for the first time from the Acts of the Apostles in Chapter six. St. Stephen and six other Faith filled men were ordained to minister to the widows. A ministry of service to God and others. That was the beginning of the diaconate in our church and our ministry to others has grown abundantly throughout the years.

"In Roman Catholicism, deacons are the link between the church and the world. They are men who, for the most part, are married and hold full-time jobs in the secular world. But they are also ordained clergy who perform every function in the church except consecrating the Eucharist, anointing of the sick and hearing confessions."

Most Reverend Daniel Garcia, bishop of the Diocese of Austin, has granted to me and all of the Deacons of St. Mary Immaculate Conception the following faculties.

- To Baptize children under the age of seven.
- To distribute the Body and Blood of Christ at Mass and outside of Mass.
- To exercise the office of Deacon in liturgical celebrations.
- To deliver the homily at Mass and to preach at other religious services.
- To preach the Gospel at Mass and to conduct Scripture Services.
- To administer the rite of the sacrament of Matrimony.
- To conduct vigil services at wakes and to preside at a funeral service.

Through all of these faculties we Deacons fulfill the link between the church and the world. You will see us facilitating scripture studies, visiting the sick and homebound, guiding our community in outreach to others, welcoming those who are seeking our Faith, quietly assisting our pastor and many other ways of being a service to our community.

Our paycheck consists of the many blessings we receive as we serve the needs of the church. And the many blessings we have received from God.

RINCON DEL DIACONO

En mis más de 22 años como diácono ordenado, me han hecho muchas preguntas sobre la fe, el porqué, qué es un diácono, mi sueldo y cuáles son mis deberes como tal. Me gustaría abordar la cuestión de los deberes y la definición de la palabra "deberes".

Ser diácono no es un trabajo, es un ministerio. Estamos llamados a servir a los demás, como se lee por primera vez en los Hechos de los Apóstoles, capítulo seis. San Esteban y otros seis hombres llenos de fe fueron ordenados para ministrar a las viudas. Un ministerio de servicio a Dios y al prójimo. Ese fue el comienzo del diaconado en nuestra iglesia, y nuestro ministerio hacia los demás ha crecido enormemente a lo largo de los años.

En el catolicismo romano, los diáconos son el vínculo entre la Iglesia y el mundo. Son hombres que, en su mayoría, están casados y tienen trabajos de tiempo completo en el mundo secular. Pero también son clérigos ordenados que desempeñan todas las funciones en la Iglesia, excepto la consagración de la Eucaristía, la unción de los enfermos y la escucha de confesiones.

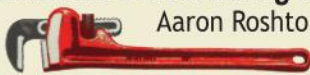

- *Bautizar a niños menores de siete años.*
- *Distribuir el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo en la Misa y fuera de ella.*
- *Ejercer el oficio de diácono en las celebraciones litúrgicas.*
- *Predicar la homilía en la Misa y predicar en otros servicios religiosos.*
- *Predicar el Evangelio en la Misa y dirigir los Servicios Bíblicos.*
- *Administrar el rito del sacramento del Matrimonio.*
- *Celebrar los servicios de vigilia en los velorios y presidir los funerales.*

A través de todas estas facultades, los diáconos construimos el vínculo entre la iglesia y el mundo. Nos verán facilitando estudios bíblicos, visitando a enfermos y personas confinadas en sus hogares, guiando a nuestra comunidad en la ayuda a los demás, dando la bienvenida a quienes buscan nuestra fe, ayudando discretamente a nuestro párroco y de muchas otras maneras de servir a nuestra comunidad.
