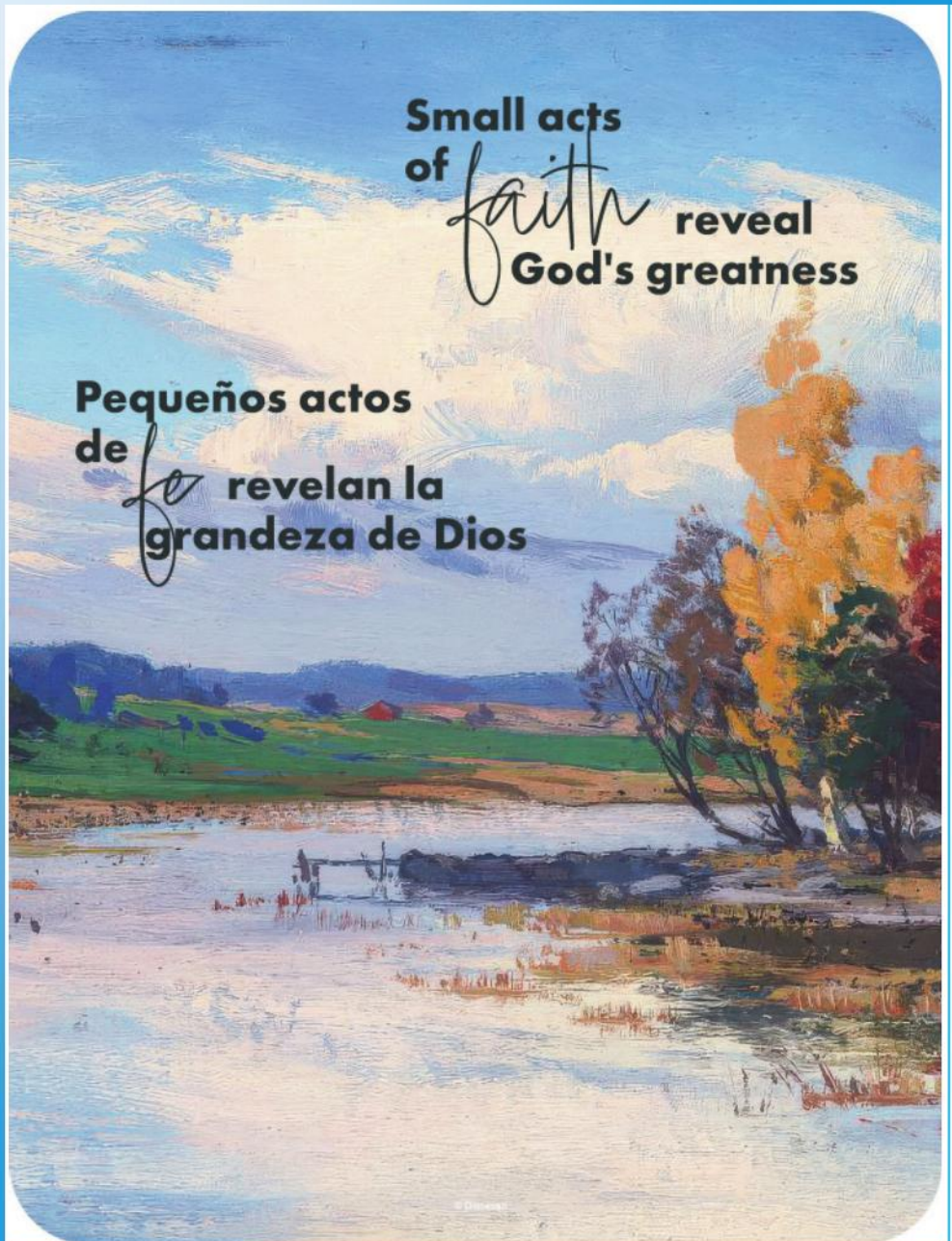

Taking Care of Business

When we were kids, my brothers and sisters and I thought that you were not supposed to say the blessing before meals in a restaurant. You were not supposed to flaunt your faith in public. It probably had more to do with fear of being embarrassed if non-believers saw us praying. I think of that when I hear St. Paul telling Timothy, “God did not give us a spirit of cowardice but rather of power and love and self-control” (2 Timothy 1:7). All three readings mention the difficulties that people of faith will encounter, and each reading has its own way of facing those hardships.

Jesus gives the practical advice: Look at the difficulties of being a disciple as just part of your job. No servant expects to be praised by his master for doing his job. So if the Lord says I must forgive those who hurt me, or be patient with customers, or share what I have with the poor—no problem; it’s part of the job of a disciple. If someone I know is in pain, I’m there to support them. Too tired to go to church after work on a holy day? Just taking care of business.

So how do we get the strength and self-control to roll with the punches? Paul reminds us in the second reading to stir the gifts of the Spirit into flame. If you take time to pray every day, if you look for God in other people, if you see difficulties as your share of the cross—you’ll find those gifts of faith, power, love, and self-control beginning to grow stronger inside.

We can trust that this is more than just wishful thinking by going to the first reading. When the prophet cries out for help with the misery and violence in the world, he hears God’s promise that the vision (of hope for deliverance) will be fulfilled even if it seems to be delayed. We too hear that promise when we start to get discouraged, for God’s promise “will not disappoint” (Habakkuk 2:3).



Haciendo lo que hay que hacer

De niños, mis hermanos y yo pensábamos que no se debía bendecir la comida antes de comer en un restaurante. No se debía hacer alarde de la fe en público. Probablemente tenía más que ver con el miedo a pasar vergüenza si los no creyentes nos veían rezando. Pienso en eso cuando escucho a San Pablo decirle a Timoteo en la segunda lectura: “Porque el Señor no nos ha dado un espíritu de temor, sino de fortaleza, de amor y de moderación” (2 Timoteo 1,7). Las tres lecturas mencionan las dificultades que encontrarán las personas de fe, y cada lectura tiene su propia manera de afrontarlas.

Jesús da un consejo práctico: Considera las dificultades de ser discípulo como parte de tu trabajo. Ningún siervo espera ser elogiado por su amo por hacer su trabajo. Así que, si el Señor me dice que debo perdonar a quienes me ofenden, o ser paciente con los clientes, o compartir lo que tengo con los pobres, no hay problema; es parte del trabajo de un discípulo. Si alguien que conozco sufre, estoy ahí para apoyarlo. ¿Estoy demasiado cansado para ir a la iglesia después del trabajo en un día festivo? No importa, voy de todos modos. Simplemente estoy haciendo lo que hay que hacer.

Entonces, ¿cómo obtenemos la fuerza y el autocontrol para seguir adelante a pesar de los golpes? Pablo nos recuerda en la segunda lectura que debemos avivar los dones del Espíritu hasta que estén encendidos. Si dedicas tiempo a orar cada día, si buscas a Dios en los demás, si ves las dificultades como tu parte de la cruz, descubrirás que esos dones de fe, poder, amor y autocontrol comienzan a fortalecerse en tu interior.

Podemos confiar en que esto es más que una simple ilusión al leer la primera lectura. Cuando el profeta clama por ayuda ante la miseria y la violencia del mundo, escucha la promesa de Dios de que la visión (de esperanza de liberación) se cumplirá aunque parezca demorarse. Nosotros también escuchamos esa promesa cuando empezamos a desanimarnos, porque la promesa de Dios “no fallará” (Habacuc 2,3).

DEACON'S CORNER

When Tragedy Strikes

Last Easter I wrote that we should practice the virtue of hope. There were three stories in recent weeks that demonstrate what I mean by that.

First there was the shooting at Annunciation Catholic School where two children were killed and 17 others, including 14 children, were shot. Many people I spoke to expressed concern that these children would be traumatized for life; that every time they entered church for mass they would fear they might be shot. Certainly, that might happen to some, but I think it's just as likely that they would respond very differently.

When the shooting started many of the older children started go to the younger children who were confused and didn't know what to do and pushed them to the floor under the pews, covering them with their own bodies. There were acts of courage in that church, where people overcame their fear and out of concern for others risked their lives to protect them. Not everyone in the church was a hero, but there were heroes in the church that day. Indeed, in the one interview after the shooting that I saw, a young boy said that it was scary, but he was worried about his friend who was in the hospital. He told us that his friend pushed him down and covered him and how he got shot. Isn't it just as likely that every time this young man goes to mass, he will be re-inspired by the courage of his friend? We should hope that is how all children who were there will respond.

Many people despaired that the image of the shooting of Charly Kirk would forever haunt the memory of the young people who saw that video. But despair is a vice, and we shouldn't allow ourselves to indulge in it. Isn't it far better to have faith that God will not let him die in vain. That through his death many more young people will return the faith. We certainly see signs that this will happen. We should be hopeful!

Lastly, I see that Camp Mystic is going to re-open and again people are concerned. Let us be hopeful that people will remember the acts of courage that night, where older children overcame their own fears to try to help the younger children. When tragedy strikes, let us practice the virtue of hope. That's what brings us closer to God.

RINCON DEL DIACONO

Cuando la tragedia golpea

La Pascua pasada escribí que deberíamos practicar la virtud de la esperanza. Hubo tres historias en las últimas semanas que demuestran lo que quiero decir con eso.

Primero, el tiroteo en la Escuela Católica Annunciation, donde dos niños murieron y otros 17, incluidos 14 niños, recibieron disparos. Muchas personas con las que hablé expresaron su preocupación de que estos niños quedaran traumatizados de por vida; que cada vez que entraran a la iglesia para la misa temieran que les dispararan. Ciertamente, eso podría sucederles a algunos, pero creo que es igual de probable que reaccionaran de manera muy diferente.

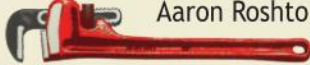
Cuando comenzó el tiroteo, muchos de los niños mayores se acercaron a los más pequeños, quienes estaban confundidos y no sabían qué hacer, y los empujaron al suelo debajo de los bancos, cubriéndolos con sus propios cuerpos. Hubo actos de valentía en esa iglesia, donde la gente superó su miedo y, por preocupación por los demás, arriesgó sus vidas para protegerlos. No todos en la iglesia eran héroes, pero hubo héroes ese día. De hecho, en la única entrevista que vi después del tiroteo, un niño dijo que había sido aterrador, pero que estaba preocupado por su amigo, que estaba en el hospital. Nos contó que su amigo lo empujó y lo cubrió, y cómo recibió el disparo. ¿No es igual de probable que cada vez que este joven vaya a misa, se sienta inspirado por la valentía de su amigo? Esperemos que así reaccionen todos los niños que estuvieron allí.

Mucha gente se desesperaba pensando que la imagen del tiroteo de Charly Kirk atormentaría para siempre la memoria de los jóvenes que vieron el video. Pero la desesperación es un vicio, y no deberíamos permitirnos caer en ella. ¿No es mucho mejor tener fe en que Dios no dejará que muera en vano? Que a través de su muerte muchos más jóvenes recuperarán la fe. Ciertamente vemos señales de que esto sucederá. ¡Debemos tener esperanza!

Por último, veo que el Campamento Místico va a reabrir y, de nuevo, la gente está preocupada. Tengamos la esperanza de que la gente recuerde los actos de valentía de esa noche, donde los niños mayores superaron sus propios miedos para intentar ayudar a los más pequeños. Cuando ocurre una tragedia, practiquemos la virtud de la esperanza. Eso es lo que nos acerca a Dios.
