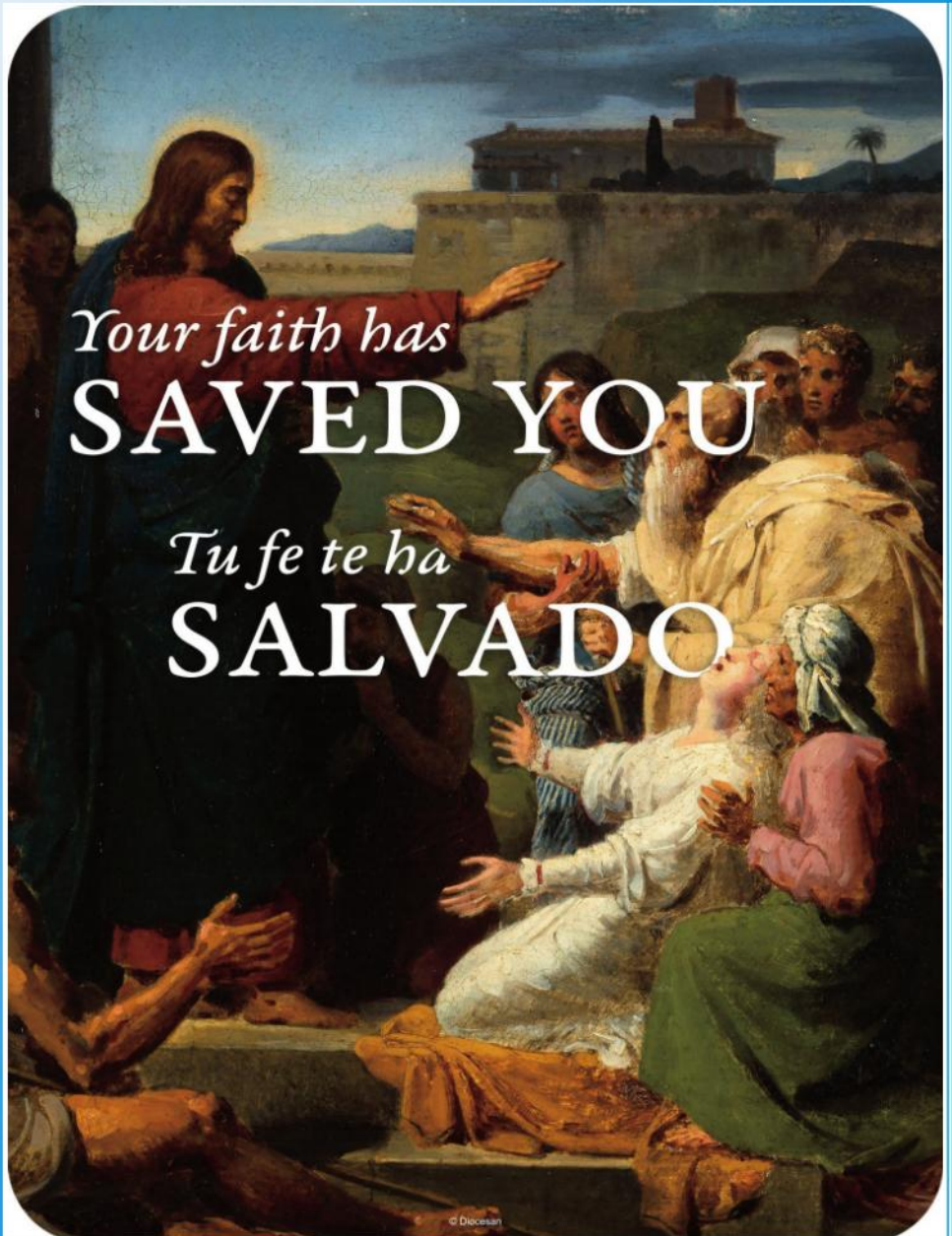

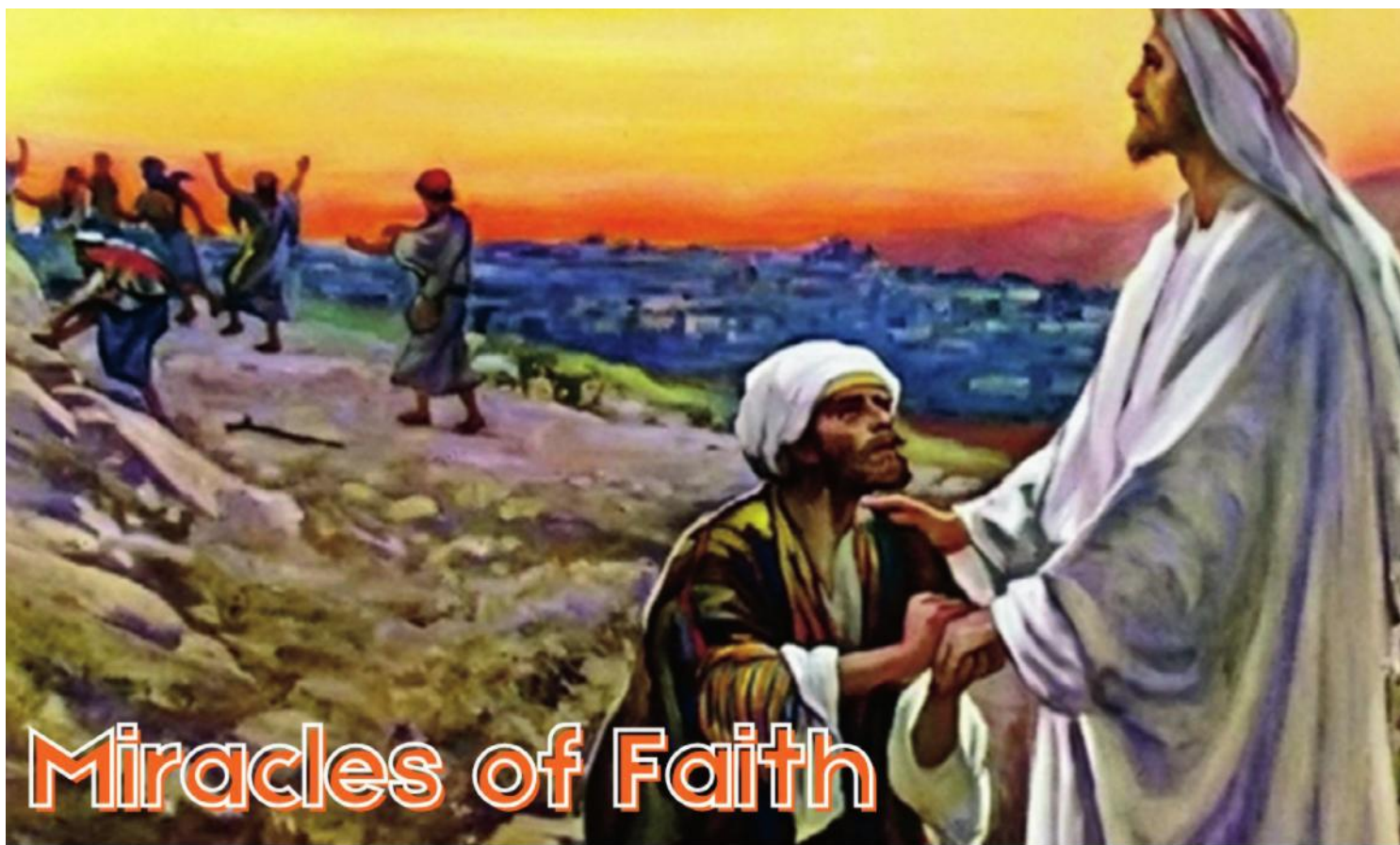

Besides being cured, what do Naaman (first reading) and the leper who thanked Jesus (Gospel) have in common? Both of them began to believe. Naaman proclaims Israel's God to be the only God; he even wants to worship the Lord in his own country. The only leper who returned to thank Jesus was "glorifying God in a loud voice" (Luke 17:15). It makes me wonder, what miracles do we see that help us grow in faith?

For an answer, we can look at a second thing they had in common: they both asked for help. Sometimes we get caught up in self-sufficiency mode, thinking we have to handle all our problems by ourselves. We may miss out on good solutions by not asking for help. Help often comes from someone who shows us a way through our problems, without solving them for us. Perhaps if we talk about the problem with another person, the solution will become obvious to us. If you think asking for help is a sign of weakness, you may be missing a chance for God to act through one of your friends and give you support. And, of course, you can ask God for help in prayer, giving God the chance to speak to your heart with the answer or the encouragement you need.

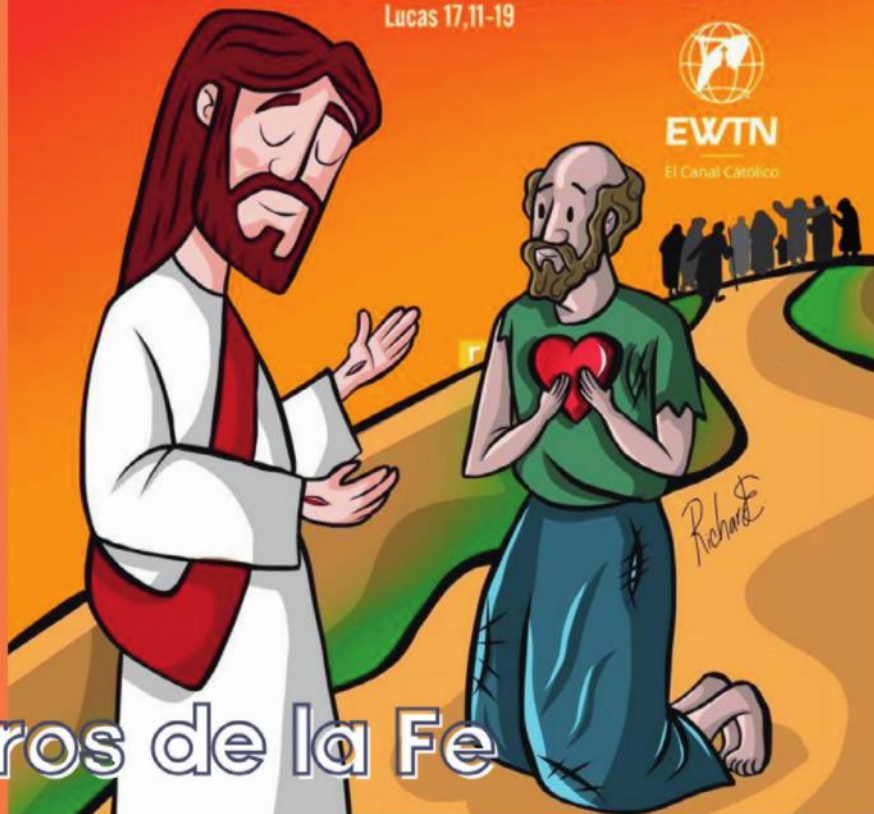
Miracles don't just happen to other people. We may have friends who help us in times of need or inspire us with their faith, but we have to decide to make a leap of faith ourselves. The third thing that Naaman and the leper did in common was express their faith. You can spend your whole life thinking that you are a Christian, but if you never express that faith, it will be no more than a theory. Scientists work with theories all the time, but until they write out the math or do the experiments, the theory is never proven. St. Paul in the second reading, for example, was suffering in prison, but he didn't mind because his suffering demonstrated the importance of Jesus' message to him. So he wrote from prison in the hope that other Christians would be encouraged in their faith. Perhaps you know of someone who inspired you with their faithfulness and dedication. Having a friend who helps us grow in faith can be a very nice miracle indeed.

Milagros de la Fe

Además de la curación, ¿qué tienen en común Naamán en la primera lectura y el leproso que dio gracias a Jesús en el Evangelio? Ambos comenzaron a creer. Naamán proclama que el Dios de Israel es el único Dios; incluso desea adorar al Señor en su tierra. El único leproso que regresó para agradecer a Jesús estaba "alabando a Dios en voz alta" (Lucas 17,15). Me pregunto: ¿qué milagros vemos que nos ayudan a crecer en la fe?

Para encontrar la respuesta, podemos considerar otra cosa que tenían en común: ambos pidieron ayuda. A veces nos dejamos llevar por la autosuficiencia, pensando que tenemos que resolver todos los problemas solos. Podemos perder buenas soluciones por no pedir ayuda. La ayuda a menudo viene de alguien que nos muestra el camino a seguir, sin resolverlos por nosotros. Quizás si hablamos del problema con otra persona, la solución se nos haga evidente. Si crees que pedir ayuda es señal de debilidad, quizás estés perdiendo la oportunidad de que Dios actúe a través de uno de tus amigos y te brinde apoyo. Y, por supuesto, puedes pedirle ayuda a Dios en oración, dándole la oportunidad de hablar a tu corazón con la respuesta o el ánimo que necesitas.

Los milagros no les ocurren solamente a otras personas. Podemos tener amigos que nos ayudan en momentos de necesidad o nos inspiran con su fe, pero nosotros mismos debemos decidir dar un salto de fe. La tercera cosa que Naamán y el leproso hicieron en común fue expresar su fe. Puedes pasarte la vida pensando que eres cristiano, pero si nunca expresas esa fe, no será más que una teoría. Los científicos trabajan con teorías todo el tiempo, pero hasta que no escriben los cálculos o hacen los experimentos, la teoría nunca está probada. San Pablo, en la segunda lectura, por ejemplo, sufría en la prisión, pero no le importó porque su sufrimiento demostraba la importancia del mensaje de Jesús. Así que escribió desde la prisión con la esperanza de que otros cristianos se sintieran alentados en su fe. Quizás conozcas a alguien que te inspiró con su fidelidad y dedicación. Tener un amigo que nos ayude a crecer en la fe puede ser un gran milagro.

DEACON'S CORNER

Discerning God's Will Strikes

The Church teaches that God has a plan for each one of us, and He promises us happiness and fulfillment if we cooperate with Him in His plans for us. This is all well and good, of course; but we encounter two significant problems. The first is discerning just what is God's plan for us, and the second is having the wisdom and strength of will to set aside our own desires for our lives and accept God's will. This week I will address the first problem.

It's likely that God is calling you to some vocation, but how do you know what it is? Is He calling you to the Priesthood; to religious life; to Marriage? Perhaps God isn't calling you to any of these, but just to live as a member of the laity, serving as an example to others by your good works. What makes it so difficult is that it can be very hard to differentiate what God wants for us from what we want for ourselves. It's very easy to convince ourselves that God is calling us to something, if that is also what we desire. We often lead ourselves astray.

I wish I had an easy answer to this problem. That if you just pray three "Hail Mary's" and two "Our Father's" you will get the answer. Unfortunately, there is no easy answer, but I can provide a few suggestions on how to approach the issue.

First, take care of the basics. Go to mass on Sunday, pray daily, and receive the sacrament of Reconciliation on a regular basis. Make sure your relationship with God is strong so you can better hear his voice. Second, be aware of your own desires and try not to allow them to get in the way. Pay attention to thoughts that 'pop' into your head, almost unbidden. Pay attention to what others tell you, especially people you don't know all that well. God works that way, often influencing us through others.

Lastly, God often clears the way when you are truly following His plan, and you will find an inner peace in doing so. If you constantly find obstacles appearing in your path making it impossible to pursue your dreams, you may be pursuing the wrong dreams.

RINCON DEL DIACONO

Discernir la voluntad de Dios impacta

La Iglesia enseña que Dios tiene un plan para cada uno de nosotros y nos promete felicidad y plenitud si cooperamos con Él en sus planes. Esto está muy bien, por supuesto; pero nos enfrentamos a dos problemas importantes. El primero es discernir cuál es exactamente el plan de Dios para nosotros, y el segundo es tener la sabiduría y la fuerza de voluntad para dejar de lado nuestros propios deseos y aceptar la voluntad de Dios. Esta semana abordaré el primer problema.

Es probable que Dios te esté llamando a alguna vocación, pero ¿cómo sabes cuál es? ¿Te está llamando al sacerdocio, a la vida religiosa, al matrimonio? Quizás Dios no te esté llamando a ninguna de estas, sino simplemente a vivir como laico, sirviendo de ejemplo a los demás con tus buenas obras. Lo que lo hace tan difícil es que puede ser muy difícil diferenciar lo que Dios quiere para nosotros de lo que nosotros queremos para nosotros mismos. Es muy fácil convencernos de que Dios nos llama a algo, si eso es también lo que deseamos. A menudo nos desviamos del buen camino.

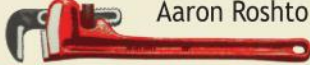
Ojalá tuviera una solución fácil para este problema. Que con solo rezar tres Avemarías y dos Padrenuestros obtendrías la respuesta. Lamentablemente, no hay una solución fácil, pero puedo darte algunas sugerencias sobre cómo abordar el tema.

Primero, cuida lo básico. Ve a misa los domingos, reza a diario y recibe el sacramento de la Reconciliación con regularidad. Asegúrate de que tu relación con Dios sea sólida para que puedas escuchar mejor su voz. Segundo, sé consciente de tus propios deseos y trata de no dejar que te obstaculicen. Presta atención a los pensamientos que te vienen a la cabeza, casi sin querer. Presta atención a lo que te dicen los demás, especialmente a quienes no conoces bien. Dios obra así, a menudo influyéndonos a través de otros.

Por último, Dios a menudo despeja el camino cuando realmente sigues su plan, y al hacerlo encontrarás paz interior. Si constantemente encuentras obstáculos que aparecen en tu camino que te hacen imposible perseguir tus sueños, es posible que estés persiguiendo los sueños equivocados.
