Perseverance



In today's Gospel, Jesus gives a clever example of why we are to persevere in praying, even if we think the prayer is not being heard. The crooked judge just wanted to get that widow off his back. She was lucky her adversary didn't pester the judge, too; he might have gone the other way. So we can pray to God with even more confidence, because we know that God loves us and will answer our prayers.

St. Paul carries that theme of perseverance even further. He is not just talking about prayer here; he encourages Timothy to persevere in proclaiming God's word as well. That command we may find more challenging than prayer. He tells Timothy (and us!) to "convince, reprimand and encourage through all patience and teaching" (2 Timothy 4:2). How can we do that?

"Convince" reminds me that our faith should be reasonable. Not that we can prove all that we believe in a scientific way, but our faith should be realistic; after all, God made the world, so God should know how it works. Jesus' command to love one another, for instance, can be taught much more convincingly by giving examples of love. A mother who hugs her child when he is hurt, forgives him when he is sorry, and encourages him when he feels lost is teaching that command in a way that will be remembered much longer than just telling him to love people. So we can convince others of our faith by showing them examples of love, forgiveness, and encouragement.

Paul also talks about reprimanding each other. That may be what he was thinking when he says that proclaiming the word can sometimes be inconvenient. Most people find it difficult to reprimand someone they are in charge of, much less one who is equal in status. That's where patience comes in. A reprimand can be made patiently and gently, as a sign of concern rather than authority.

Paul lastly mentions teaching. He probably was referring to teaching the Hebrew scriptures and how they were fulfilled in Christ. Parents can do their part by teaching the stories from the Bible, helping children to see God in creation, teaching them to pray, and being good examples of God's love for them. If you send your children to religion classes or the parish school, do what you can to support the teachers so that what the children learn at school is practiced at home. What the children see (or don't see) at home has a much greater effect than a few hours a week in a classroom.



En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús da un ejemplo ingenioso de por qué debemos perseverar en la oración, incluso si creemos que no se escucha nuestra oración. El juez corrupto solo quería quitarse de encima a la viuda. Tuvo la suerte de que su adversario no molestara también al juez; podría haber optado por lo contrario. Así que podemos orar a Dios con aún más confianza, porque sabemos que Dios nos ama y responderá a nuestras oraciones.

San Pablo lleva el tema de la perseverancia aún más lejos. No solo se refiere a la oración; anima también a Timoteo a perseverar en la proclamación de la palabra de Dios. Este mandato puede resultarnos más difícil que la oración. Le dice a Timoteo (¡y a nosotros!): “convence, reprende y exhorta con toda paciencia y sabiduría” (2 Timoteo 4,2). ¿Cómo podemos lograrlo?

“Convencer” me recuerda que nuestra fe debe ser razonable. No es que podamos demostrar científicamente todo lo que creemos, pero nuestra fe debe ser realista; después de todo, Dios creó el mundo, así que Dios debería saber cómo funciona. El mandato de Jesús de amarnos los unos a los otros, por ejemplo, se puede enseñar de forma mucho más convincente dando ejemplos de amor. Una madre que abraza a su hijo cuando está herido, lo perdona cuando se arrepiente y lo anima cuando se siente perdido, está enseñando ese mandato de una manera que se recordará mucho más tiempo que simplemente diciéndole que ame a la gente. Así que podemos convencer a otros de nuestra fe mostrándoles ejemplos de amor, perdón y ánimo.

Pablo también habla de reprendernos unos a otros. Quizás eso era lo que pensaba cuando dice que proclamar la palabra a veces puede ser incómodo. A la mayoría de las personas les resulta difícil reprender a alguien a quien tienen a su cargo, y mucho menos a alguien de igual estatus. Ahí es donde entra la paciencia. Una reprimenda puede hacerse con paciencia y amabilidad, como muestra de preocupación más que de autoridad.

Por último, Pablo menciona la enseñanza. Probablemente se refería a enseñar las escrituras hebreas y cómo se cumplieron en Cristo. Los padres pueden contribuir enseñando las historias de la Biblia, ayudando a los niños a ver a Dios en la creación, enseñándoles a orar y siendo buenos ejemplos del amor de Dios por ellos. Si envían a sus hijos a clases de religión o a la escuela parroquial, hagan lo posible por apoyar a los maestros para que lo que aprenden en la escuela se practique en la casa. Lo que los niños ven (o no ven) en el hogar tiene un efecto mucho mayor que unas horas a la semana en un salón de clases.

DEACON'S CORNER

Discerning God's Will—Part 2

The Church teaches that God has a plan for each one of us, and last week I wrote about the challenge of discerning what His plan might be. This week we take up the challenge of accepting His plan. We know that God has a plan for us, and we know that it will certainly be better than any plan we could come up with on our own. We also know that we will be far happier if we submit to His will and follow His plan. Why then is this so hard for us to do? Why do we resist and stubbornly insist on going our own way? In scripture, God laments that His people would simply not listen to Him, *"So I gave them over to hardness of heart; they followed their own designs" Ps 81:12.*

When God created us, we were given the gifts of free thought and free will. However, the proper use of those gifts should be to lead us to the truth and cause us to choose the good. This will inevitably lead us to God, the source of all truth and goodness. However, because of our brokenness we resist God. We grasp for power and stubbornly insist on doing things our way, instead of God's way. We then rationalize our behavior to justify it. Consider the lyrics of the song "I did it my way" and reflect on how we celebrate this hardness of heart instead of recognizing it as a major stumbling block that usually leads to an unhappy and fruitless life. What causes us to refuse God's guidance in our lives, and to go our own way without it, is pride. There's a reason why this was the first of the seven deadly sins. Pride has great power to lead us astray and cause us to act foolishly. We wind up trying to prove that we are smarter; that we know better. We are still in the Garden of Eden, grasping at the fruit of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, trying to be like God. That's why humility is such an important virtue. It allows us to see clearly the love and goodness of God and to recognize our own shortcomings. There's a saying that the secret of success is to humbly let go and let God. That's also the path to eternal life...but then, isn't that just saying the same thing?

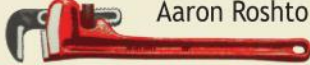
Discernir la voluntad de Dios—2da parte

La Iglesia enseña que Dios tiene un plan para cada uno de nosotros, y la semana pasada escribí sobre el desafío de discernir cuál podría ser su plan. Esta semana asumimos el reto de aceptarlo. Sabemos que Dios tiene un plan para nosotros y sabemos que, sin duda, será mejor que cualquier plan que pudiéramos idear por nuestra cuenta. También sabemos que seremos mucho más felices si nos sometemos a su voluntad y seguimos su plan. ¿Por qué, entonces, nos resulta tan difícil? ¿Por qué nos resistimos e insistimos obstinadamente en seguir nuestro propio camino? En las Escrituras, Dios lamenta que su pueblo simplemente no lo escuchara: «Los entregué, pues, a la dureza de corazón; siguieron sus propios designios» (Salmos 81:12).

Cuando Dios nos creó, recibimos los dones del libre pensamiento y el libre albedrío. Sin embargo, el uso adecuado de esos dones debe ser guiarnos a la verdad y hacer que elijamos el bien. Esto inevitablemente nos llevará a Dios, la fuente de toda verdad y bondad. Sin embargo, debido a nuestra fragilidad, nos resistimos a Dios. Nos aferramos al poder e insistimos obstinadamente en hacer las cosas a nuestra manera, en lugar de a la de Dios. Entonces, racionalizamos nuestro comportamiento para justificarlo. Considera la letra de la canción "Lo hice a mi manera" y reflexiona sobre cómo celebramos esta dureza de corazón en lugar de reconocerla como un gran obstáculo que suele llevarnos a una vida infeliz e infructuosa. Lo que nos lleva a rechazar la guía de Dios en nuestras vidas y a seguir nuestro propio camino sin ella es el orgullo. Hay una razón por la que este fue el primero de los siete pecados capitales. El orgullo tiene un gran poder para desviarnos y hacernos actuar con insensatez. Terminamos intentando demostrar que somos más inteligentes; que sabemos más. Seguimos en el Jardín del Edén, aferrándonos al fruto del árbol del conocimiento del bien y del mal, tratando de ser como Dios. Por eso la humildad es una virtud tan importante. Nos permite ver con claridad el amor y la bondad de Dios y reconocer nuestras propias deficiencias. Dicen que el secreto del éxito es dejarse llevar con humildad y dejar que Dios actúe. Ese es también el camino a la vida eterna... pero, ¿no es eso lo mismo?
