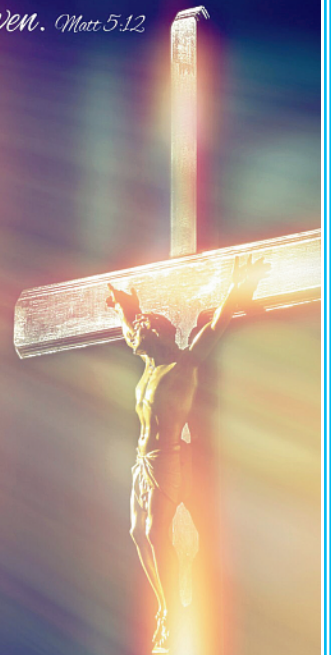

The Church Suffering

One of the most beautiful aspects of our Catholic faith is the Communion of Saints. Whether it be the Church Militant still fighting the good fight here on earth, or the Church Suffering enduring their final time of purification in Purgatory, or the Church Triumphant rejoicing with our Lord in heaven, we are all united together in faith. We are one Church, united in the mysteries of the passion, death and resurrection of our Lord.

What makes this reality so beautiful is our ability to pray for one another, no matter what state of life we find ourselves in. Those on earth can pray to lessen the time in purgatory of one of their brothers, and those in Purgatory can offer up their sufferings for those on earth. Those in Heaven can pray for both those on earth and those in Purgatory. It is an incredible circle of love and care that won't end until Christ comes again.

Today we celebrate the Church Suffering. It is a day to remember "those who have gone before us marked with the sign of faith." In other words, all of our departed brothers and sisters who have been baptised in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Since our souls must be completely cleansed before entering the heavenly banquet, many of us will be required to endure this time of purification. Others will be permitted to undergo great hardships here on earth and be cleansed through them, with the aid of the sacraments.

Sometimes we may wonder why our aunt suffers from alzheimers, or why our grandfather must continue to live through the discomforts of old age. We may wonder why our nephew was allowed to get in that car accident or our own child had to endure the aftereffects of a burst appendix. But all of these trials, when lived with faith, can be opportunities for purification for ourselves and others. "Offer it up" is no longer a cliché, but rather a reminder to direct our minds and hearts to God during times of difficulty.

Today, let us pray for all the souls in purgatory, that they may soon gaze upon the glorious face of our Saviour, and may they in turn pray for us, that we may one day join them in Heaven



Uno de los aspectos más hermosos de la fe católica es la Comunión de los Santos. Ya sea la Iglesia Militante que aún lucha la buena batalla aquí en la tierra, la Iglesia Sufriente que soporta su último tiempo de purificación en el Purgatorio, o la Iglesia Triunfante que se regocija con nuestro Señor en el cielo, todos estamos unidos en la fe. Somos una sola Iglesia, unida en los misterios de la pasión, muerte y resurrección de nuestro Señor.

Lo que hace esta realidad tan hermosa es nuestra capacidad de orar unos por otros, sin importar el estado de vida en que nos encontremos. Quienes están en la tierra pueden orar para acortar el tiempo en el purgatorio de uno de sus hermanos, y quienes están en el Purgatorio pueden ofrecer sus sufrimientos por quienes están en la tierra. Quienes están en el Cielo pueden orar tanto por quienes están en la tierra como por quienes están en el Purgatorio. Es un círculo increíble de amor y compasión que no terminará hasta que Cristo vuelva.

Hoy celebramos la Iglesia sufriente. Es un día para recordar a “quienes nos han precedido, marcados con el signo de la fe”. En otras palabras, a todos nuestros hermanos y hermanas difuntos que fueron bautizados en el nombre del Padre, del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo. Dado que nuestras almas deben ser completamente purificadas antes de entrar al banquete celestial, muchos de nosotros tendremos que pasar por este tiempo de purificación. A otros se les permitirá pasar por grandes dificultades aquí en la tierra y ser purificados a través de ellas, con la ayuda de los sacramentos.

A veces nos preguntamos por qué nuestra tía sufre de Alzheimer, o por qué nuestro abuelo debe seguir soportando las incomodidades de la vejez. Quizás nos preguntemos por qué nuestro sobrino tuvo ese accidente de carro o por qué nuestro propio hijo tuvo que soportar las secuelas de una apendicitis reventada. Pero todas estas pruebas, cuando se viven con fe, pueden ser oportunidades de purificación para nosotros y para los demás. “Ofrécelo” ya no es un cliché, sino un recordatorio para dirigir nuestra mente y corazón a Dios en momentos de dificultad.

Oremos hoy por todas las almas del purgatorio, para que pronto puedan contemplar el rostro glorioso de nuestro Salvador, y que ellas, a su vez, oren por nosotros, para que un día podamos unirnos a ellas en el Cielo.

Cemetery Expansion Update

Slabs are poured and the Columbaria are being constructed. We will begin pre-construction sales for niches immediately following All Souls Day.

The pre-construction cost will be \$1,500 per niche. Each niche will hold two (2) cremated remains (urns); for a married couple this calculates to \$750 each. Once the columbaria are installed, the pricing will be \$2,000 per niche.

In-ground plots remain available for deceased parishioners only.
The cost of an in-ground plot remains \$2,000 for a single casket burial.

Actualización sobre la ampliación del cementerio

Se han vertido las losas de hormigón y se están construyendo los columbarios. Comenzaremos la venta de nichos en preventa inmediatamente después del Día de todos los fieles difuntos.

El precio de preventa será de \$1,500 por nicho. Cada nicho tendrá capacidad para dos urnas con cenizas; para una pareja casada, esto equivale a \$750 por persona. Una vez instalados los columbarios, el precio será de \$2,000 por nicho.

Los terrenos para entierros tradicionales siguen disponibles solo para feligreses fallecidos.
El costo de un terreno para entierro tradicional sigue siendo de \$2,000 para un solo ataúd.

DEACON'S CORNER

CCC 1030-31: All who die in God's grace and friendship, but **still imperfectly purified**, are assured of their eternal salvation; but after death undergo purification to achieve the holiness necessary to enter heaven. The Church gives the name Purgatory to this final purification for those who are on their way to heaven: a purification that is entirely different from the punishment of hell CCC 1031.

This weekend we celebrate the feast of All Souls. We pray for those elect who are still undergoing their final purification before entering heaven. Prayers for the dead are found several places in scripture, e.g. 2 Macc. 12:46. From the beginning the Church honored the memory of the dead and offered prayers for them especially the Eucharistic sacrifice CCC 1032. But why is this purification necessary? **Because nothing unclean can enter heaven** Lk 12:59 and Rev: 21:27. Purification is therefore necessary for those who die with unforgiven venial sins and/or unremitted temporal punishment due to sins already forgiven (this is one reason a priest gives us a penance in confession). Ways to eliminate temporal punishment for both the deceased and for ourselves include, various acts of prayer, indulgences, works of penance etc.

Here is a simple example of some punishment remaining after the forgiveness of a sin. A young boy likes to play soccer. His mother tells him to not kick the soccer ball in the front yard as it could break a window at the front of the house. He goes and does exactly what his mother tells him not to do. He kicks the ball and it breaks the window. Obviously his mother is angry and upset. The son expresses his sorrow to his mother and she forgives him. But there is still a debt to be paid. She tells him that he has to make up for what he did. He has to use his allowance pay for a new window.

Let us pray: Eternal rest grant unto them O Lord and let perpetual light shine upon them. May their souls and the souls of all the faithful departed through the mercy of God rest in peace.

RINCON DEL DIACONO

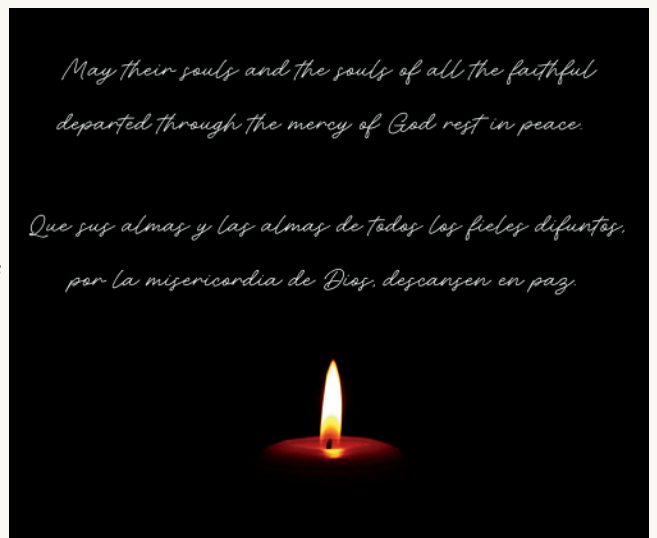
CCC 1030-31: Todos los que mueren en la gracia y la amistad de Dios, **pero aún imperfectamente purificados**, tienen asegurada su salvación eterna; pero después de la muerte se someten a una purificación para alcanzar la santidad necesaria para entrar en el cielo. La Iglesia llama Purgatorio a esta purificación final para quienes están en camino al cielo: una purificación completamente diferente del castigo del infierno (CCC 1031).

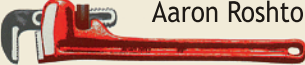
Este fin de semana celebramos la fiesta de Todos los Santos. Oramos por aquellos elegidos que aún están pasando por su purificación final antes de entrar en el cielo. Las oraciones por los difuntos se encuentran en varios pasajes de la Escritura, por ejemplo, 2 Macabeos 12:46. Desde el principio, la Iglesia ha honrado la memoria de los difuntos y ha ofrecido oraciones por ellos, especialmente el sacrificio eucarístico (CCC 1032). Pero, ¿por qué es necesaria esta purificación? **Porque nada impuro puede entrar en el cielo** (Lucas 12:59 y Apocalipsis 21:27). Por lo tanto, la purificación es necesaria para quienes mueren con pecados veniales no perdonados y/o con la pena temporal debida a pecados ya perdonados (esta es una de las razones por las que un sacerdote nos impone una penitencia en la confesión). Las maneras de eliminar la pena temporal, tanto para los difuntos como para nosotros mismos, incluyen diversos actos de oración, indulgencias, obras de penitencia, etc.

He aquí un ejemplo sencillo de una pena que permanece después del perdón de un pecado. A un niño le gusta jugar al fútbol. Su madre le dice que no patee la pelota en el jardín delantero, ya que podría romper una ventana de la casa. Él va y hace exactamente lo que su madre le dijo que no hiciera. Patea la pelota y rompe la ventana. Obviamente, su madre está enojada y molesta. El hijo le expresa su arrepentimiento a su madre y ella lo perdona. Pero aún queda una deuda por pagar. Ella le dice que tiene que reparar el daño. Tiene que usar su paga para comprar una ventana nueva.

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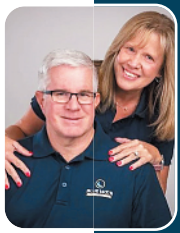
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
