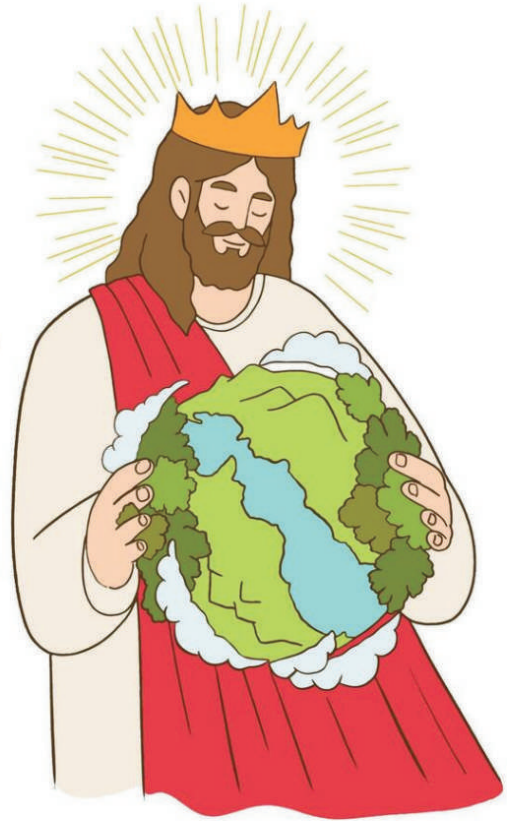

Jesus, Remember Me



The man who hung on the cross next to Jesus asks him to “remember me when you come into your kingdom.” Of all the people who took part in the crucifixion of Jesus, only this man sincerely acknowledges Jesus as King. Only he receives the promise of joining Jesus in paradise that very day. I wonder if he knew what Jesus’ kingdom meant?

The second reading gives us a better idea of the extent of that kingdom. Paul uses images of things visible and invisible, of dominions, principalities, and powers. While the latter terms refer to types of angels, we can stretch our imagination even further. Notice one short phrase that appears six times in that reading: “all things.” So do we really believe that Jesus is King of all things?

Some astronomers say that the universe is infinite. At first I thought, “That couldn’t be right; only God is infinite.” But it occurred to me that an infinite God would want the universe to be a sign of divine glory, so why couldn’t God make an infinite universe? So Jesus is King of that universe. While that sounds impressive, it might tempt us to forget about things closer to home.

If Christ is King of all things, that includes our possessions. We might keep that in mind, not only when deciding how much we give to the poor or to the Church, but also how we use the things we own. The things we watch on TV, the foods we eat, the books we read—all are under Jesus’ kingship. Our own bodies belong not just to us, but also to Christ. I might even drive more carefully if I remember that my car belongs to the Lord.

Even our life is under his reign. That can remind us to trust Jesus more, as well as to ask for the guidance of his Spirit in our decisions. If we let the Lord guide our lives, we know that anything that happens to us is either God’s will or something that Jesus can lead us through, on our way to paradise



Jesús, Acuérdate de Mí

El hombre que colgaba de la cruz junto a Jesús le pide: “Señor, cuando llegues a tu Reino, acuérdate de mí”. De todas las personas que participaron en la crucifixión de Jesús, solo este hombre reconoce sinceramente a Jesús como Rey. Sólo él recibe la promesa de unirse a Jesús en el paraíso ese mismo día. Me pregunto si sabía lo que significaba el reino de Jesús.

La segunda lectura nos da una mejor idea de la extensión de ese reino. Pablo usa imágenes de cosas visibles e invisibles, de dominios, principados y potestades. Si bien estos últimos términos se refieren a tipos de ángeles, podemos ampliar nuestra imaginación aún más. Observen la palabra corta que aparece varias veces en esa lectura: “todo”. Entonces, ¿realmente creemos que Jesús es el Rey de todo?

Algunos astrónomos dicen que el universo es infinito. Al principio pensé: “Eso no puede ser cierto; solo Dios es infinito”. Pero se me ocurrió que un Dios infinito podría querer que el universo fuera un signo de gloria divina, entonces, ¿por qué Dios no pudo crear un universo infinito? Jesús es el Rey del universo también. Aunque suene impresionante, podría tentarnos a olvidarnos de las cosas más cercanas.

Si Cristo es Rey de todas las cosas, eso incluye nuestras posesiones. Debemos tenerlo presente, no solo al decidir cuánto damos a los pobres o a la Iglesia, sino también cómo usamos nuestras posesiones. Lo que vemos en la televisión, lo que comemos, los libros que leemos: todo está bajo el reinado de Jesús. Nuestros cuerpos no solo nos pertenecen a nosotros, sino también a Cristo. Incluso podría conducir con más cuidado si recordara que mi carro pertenece al Señor.

Incluso nuestra vida está bajo su reinado. Eso puede recordarnos que debemos confiar más en Jesús, así como pedir la guía de su Espíritu en nuestras decisiones. Si dejamos que el Señor guíe nuestras vidas, sabemos que todo lo que nos sucede o es la voluntad de Dios o Jesús puede guiarnos a través de ello en camino al paraíso.

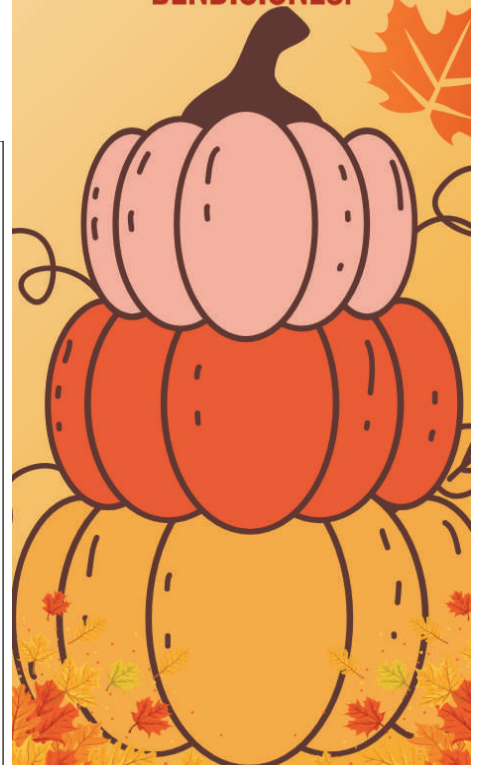

DEACON'S CORNER

Today we celebrate the feast of Christ the King, instituted in 1925 by Pope Pius XI in order to promote Christ as King. Christ is truly King, the long-expected messiah-King of Israel, who redeemed us, inaugurated God's Kingdom on earth and leads us into the eternal Kingdom of Heaven.

When Jesus began his ministry, Israel had no Jewish King. King David's throne is vacant. Herod, a non-Jew, sits as a puppet King, put there by Caesar the Emperor of Rome, the King of the world. In today's Gospel Jesus our King is not on a throne of gold but nailed to a throne of a wooden cross; a throne of painful love for us. Rather than praise him, soldiers, authorities and the crucified criminals verbally abuse and revile Jesus, actually blaspheming; a fulfillment of Psalm 22:7. Those passing by say "Aha! You who would destroy the temple and build it up in three days, save yourself and come down from that cross! (Mk 15:29). The chief priests and the scribes say "Come down and save yourself that we may believe!" In other words, prove yourself Jesus! The bad thief says are you not the Christ? Save us!

The other crucified criminal usually referred to as the "good thief" may have sneered at Jesus previously (ICSB) but has a conversion saying that he has been condemned justly but that Jesus has done nothing wrong. He says "*Jesus remember me when you come into your Kingdom*" (Lk 23:42). By saying this the criminal's faith has saved him and Jesus says "*Amen I say to you today you will be with me in paradise*" (Lk: 43:43.)

One author points out that Jesus must remain on the cross to be the savior. Only after His passion is complete will others remove Him from the cross. Jesus' passion is complete when He says "it is finished."

Jesus offers His salvation to every one of us. He loved every one of us so much that He died for us so that we join Him in His Kingdom beginning here on earth and after our death in heaven with the angels and saints and those who have gone before us. Do we want to be with Him in the Kingdom of Heaven? ***Do we want to be with Christ the King! Viva Cristo Rey! Long Live Christ the King!***

RINCON DEL DIACONO

Hoy celebramos la fiesta de Cristo Rey, instituida en 1925 por el Papa Pío XI para exaltar a Cristo como Rey. Cristo es verdaderamente Rey, el Mesías-Rey de Israel tan esperado, quien nos redimió, inauguró el Reino de Dios en la tierra y nos conduce al Reino eterno de los Cielos.

Cuando Jesús comenzó su ministerio, Israel no tenía un rey judío. El trono del rey David estaba vacante. Herodes, un no judío, reinaba como un rey títere, impuesto por César, el emperador de Roma, el rey del mundo. En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús, nuestro Rey, no está en un trono de oro, sino clavado en un trono de madera; un trono de amor doloroso por nosotros.

En lugar de alabarlo, soldados, autoridades y criminales crucificados lo insultan y lo vilipendian, blasfemando; un cumplimiento del Salmo 22:7. Los que pasaban decían: «¡Ajá! Tú que destruirías el templo y lo reconstruirías en tres días, ¡sálvate y baja de esa cruz!» (Mc 15,29). Los sumos sacerdotes y los escribas decían: «¡Baja y sálvate para que creamos!» En otras palabras, ¡ demuéstalo, Jesús! El ladrón malo dice: "¿No eres el Cristo? ¡Sálvanos!"

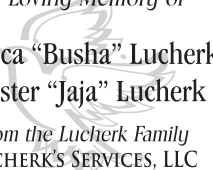
El otro criminal crucificado, conocido como el "buen ladrón", quizás se burló de Jesús antes (ICSB), pero se convierte y afirma que ha sido condenado justamente, pero que Jesús no ha hecho nada malo. Dice: "Jesús, acuérdate de mí cuando vengas en tu reino" (Lc 23:42). Al decir esto, la fe del criminal lo salva y Jesús dice: "En verdad te digo que hoy estarás conmigo en el paraíso" (Lc 43:43).

Un autor señala que Jesús debe permanecer en la cruz para ser el salvador. Solo después de que su pasión se complete, otros lo bajarán de la cruz. La pasión de Jesús se completa cuando dice: "Consumado es".

*Jesús nos ofrece su salvación a cada uno de nosotros. Nos amó tanto que murió por nosotros para que nos unamos a Él en su Reino, comenzando aquí en la tierra y después de nuestra muerte en el cielo con los ángeles, los santos y quienes nos han precedido. ¿Queremos estar con Él en el Reino de los Cielos? **¿Queremos estar con Cristo Rey? ¡Viva Cristo Rey!***

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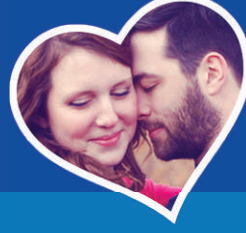
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
