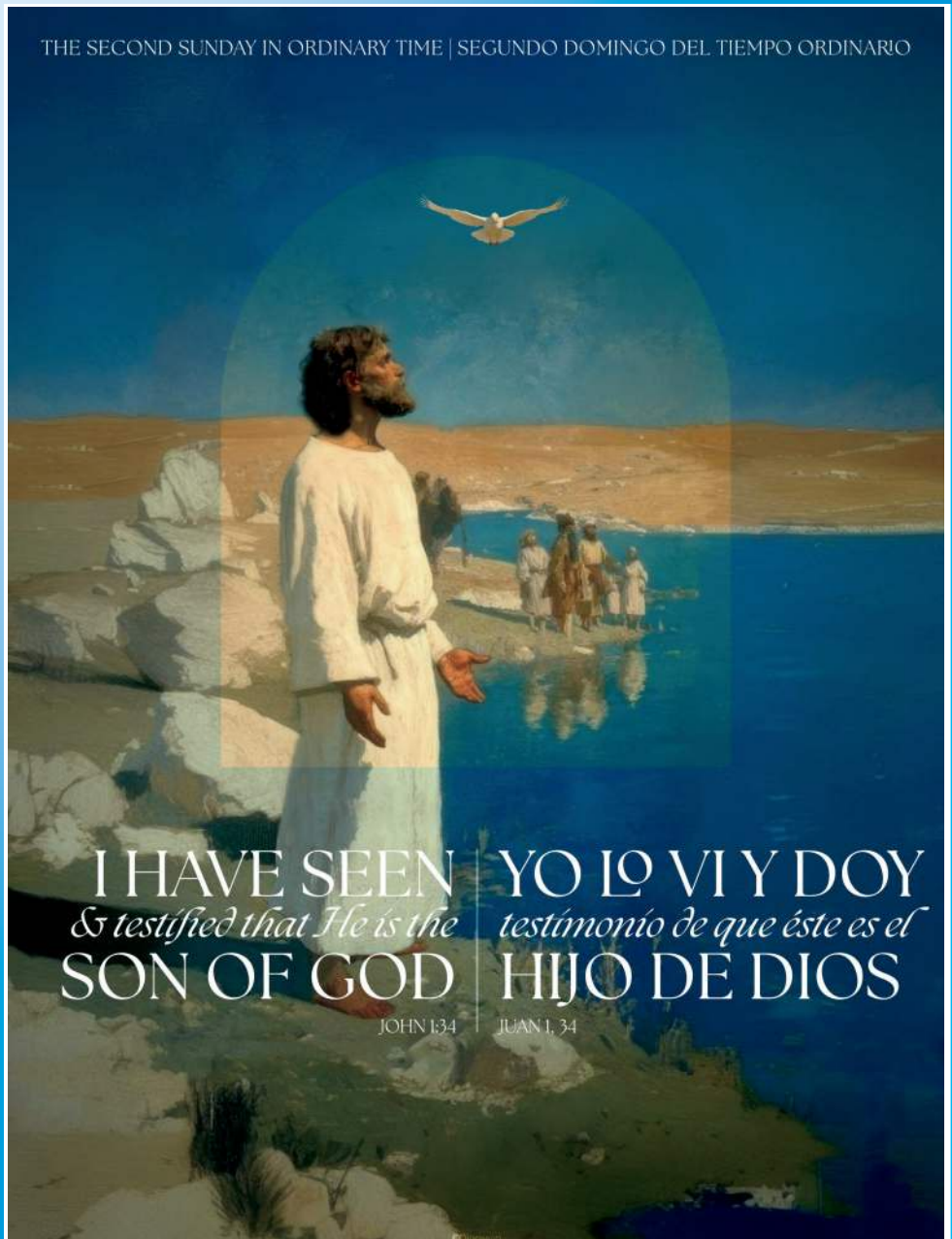

Dear Brothers and Sisters:

Greetings in our Lord, Jesus Christ!

On January 24-25, I have asked our parish priests to participate in our sixth annual *Called by Name Sunday*. God has always known each one of us by name and has given us a particular call to follow. *Called by Name Sunday* is, first, about listening and, then, responding to God's call.

Next Sunday's readings center on the theme of vocation. I have asked our priests to share their own vocation story during the homily. As you listen to the Word of God proclaimed at Mass and reflect upon the priest's vocation story, please consider the following:

1. If you are discerning your life's vocation, be open to God's call to the priesthood or consecrated life. God's calling is a beautiful gift – be courageous and open to his call! Jesus came that we might have life and have it to the full – do not be afraid! If God is calling you to the priesthood or consecrated life, be open to the invitation; you will not be disappointed.
2. Please think of men and women you know and believe might have a calling to the priesthood or consecrated life. While God is the one who calls, he often uses our voices. Please help us reach out to these individuals and come next weekend prepared to share their name(s) and contact information so that a letter of encouragement can be sent to them.

Brothers and sisters, with God's blessing and your help, we can make *Called by Name Sunday* a great success. May all of us listen to God's call and follow where he leads. Be assured of my prayers for you as we continue to strengthen a culture of vocations in our diocese.

Por favor, ayúdenos a alcanzar a aquellos individuos y vengan preparados el próximo fin de semana para compartir su(s) nombre(s) e información de contacto para que les sea enviada una carta alentadora.

Hermanos y hermanas, con la bendición de Dios y su ayuda, podemos hacer del *Domingo del Llamado* un gran éxito. Escuchemos todos el llamado de Dios y sigámoslo a donde nos guíe. DEACON'S CORNER

Behold the Lamb of God

When we use scripture in the mass it's always good to reflect just what was happening in the bible when the words were said, and then just what is happening in the mass. At the beginning of the communion rite in mass, the celebrant will hold up the consecrated host and proclaim, "Behold the Lamb of God! Behold Him who takes away the sins of the world." Why does he do this?

These words are in today's gospel reading from John. What's happening in the bible is that John is at the river Jordan and crowds are coming to him, wanting to hear him and be baptized by him. All the sudden John sees Jesus among the crowds. (John's gift was that he could always recognize Jesus. Even when Mary was pregnant with Jesus and came to visit Elizabeth who was pregnant with John, John in his mother's womb recognized Jesus in Mary's womb.) John points him out to the crowds: "See Him all of you. Yes! He looks like just like everyone else; but see Him as I see Him. See Him through the eyes of faith. He is different. He is God!

That's what's happening in the bible. What's happening in mass?

The priest is holding up the host and repeats John's words, "Behold the Lamb of God! Behold Him who takes away the sins of the world." Yes! It looks just like the bread it was a moment ago; but see it as I see it. See it through the eyes of faith. It is Jesus.

The mass is the source and summit of our Catholic faith; the most important thing we do as Catholics. If you want to better understand the mass, read your bible because the language of the mass is scripture.

RINCON DEL DIACONO

He aquí el Cordero de Dios

Cuando usamos las Escrituras en la misa, siempre es bueno reflexionar sobre lo que sucedía en la Biblia cuando se pronunciaron esas palabras, y luego sobre lo que sucede en la misa. Al comienzo del rito de la comunión, el celebrante levanta la hostia consagrada y proclama: «¡He aquí el Cordero de Dios! ¡He aquí el que quita el pecado del mundo!». ¿Por qué hace esto?

Estas palabras se encuentran en la lectura del Evangelio de hoy, según San Juan. Lo que sucede en la Biblia es que Juan está a orillas del río Jordán y las multitudes acuden a él, deseando escucharlo y ser bautizadas por él. De repente, Juan ve a Jesús entre la multitud. (El don de Juan era que siempre podía reconocer a Jesús. Incluso cuando María estaba embarazada de Jesús y fue a visitar a Isabel, que estaba embarazada de Juan, Juan, en el vientre de su madre, reconoció a Jesús en el vientre de María). Juan lo señala a la multitud: «Mírenlo todos. ¡Sí! Se parece a cualquier otra persona; pero mírenlo como yo lo veo. Mírenlo con los ojos de la fe. Él es diferente. ¡Él es Dios!

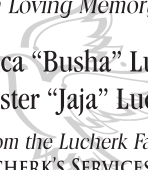
Eso es lo que sucede en la Biblia. ¿Qué sucede en la misa?

El sacerdote levanta la hostia y repite las palabras de Juan: «¡He aquí el Cordero de Dios! ¡He aquí el que quita el pecado del mundo!». ¡Sí! Parece el pan que era hace un momento; pero mírenlo como yo lo veo. Mírenlo con los ojos de la fe. Es Jesús.

La misa es la fuente y la cumbre de nuestra fe católica; lo más importante que hacemos como católicos. Si desean comprender mejor la misa, lean la Biblia, porque el lenguaje de la misa es el de las Escrituras.
