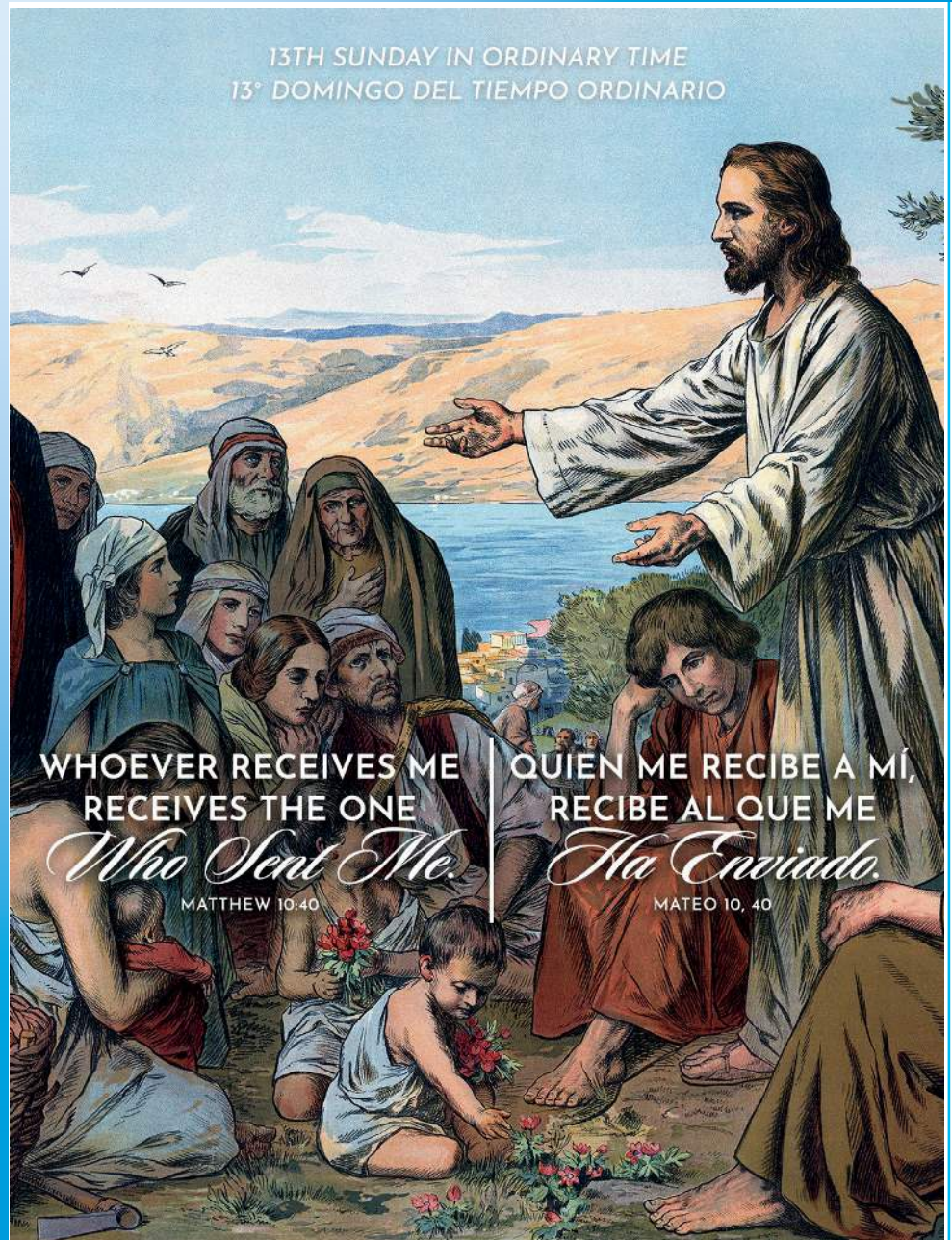

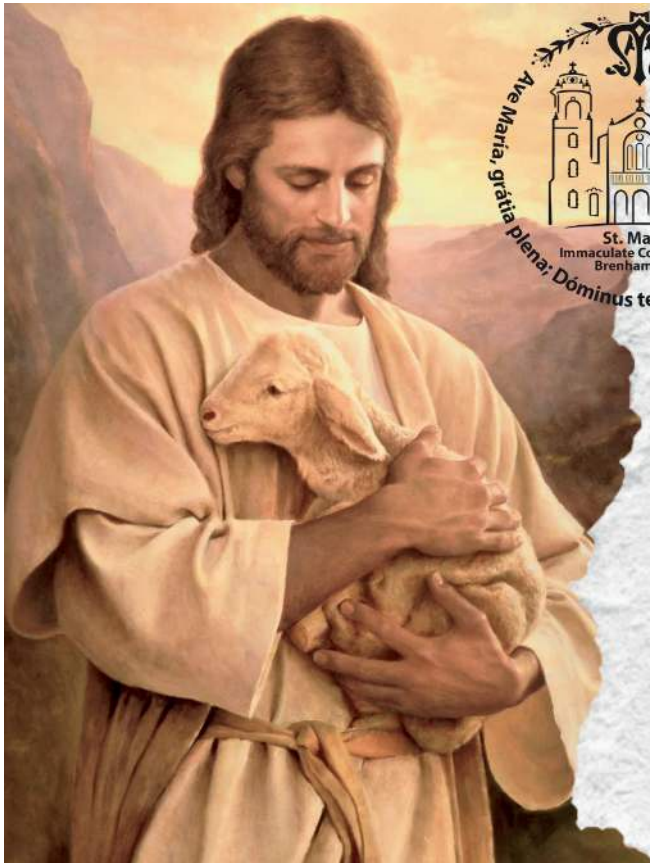

My name is John Hefferly. I am an incoming junior in high school, and I was confirmed into the Catholic Church a few months ago. I'm the oldest with three younger siblings, I enjoy many sports such as football, baseball, basketball, and hockey, and I play football, bowling, and run track. I've been born and raised in Texas, and I've lived here in Brenham since 2013. I've always been blessed to be part of this amazing parish since then, especially now that I'm a confirmed Catholic.

The thing I love about this parish by far is how much it's helped me grow in my faith. It's been really special to be an alter server for the past 8 years and I hope I will get to continue. All of my CCE and confirmation teachers throughout the years have been really special have helped me significantly with my faith. I would also likely to thank my confirmation sponsor, Mark Asmussen, for always being there for me and helping me grow in my faith, especially as my uncle and godfather.

My faith journey hasn't been the easiest, nor will it ever be, but it's always worth it and I'm glad I've taken the steps so far. When I was younger, I wouldn't look forward to going to mass and would never pay attention, plus most of it never made much sense. The first real change I've ever had was in my 5th grade CCE class. My teacher was Mr. Don Barnett, and he was an amazing teacher. He actually helped us grow in our faith, and that was the first time I started to take it seriously. But, I was still very inconsistent and almost never read the bible or prayed or any of that. But starting in the summer between 8th and 9th grade, my faith really began to grow. That summer, I went to a Catholic camp that I've been to before, but this time I actually learned something there, and that's when I started believing in Jesus truly being present in the Eucharist. However, I still fell back into old habits and inconsistencies. While I don't have a precise turning point, throughout my freshman year I started praying more and going to or at least watching daily mass. Then the next year at the same camp, I remember the adoration that Wednesday night. It was the most special adoration of my life. Instead of feeling bored or getting distracted, I knelt and prayed. Everything in my mind finally connected to my heart. I went to confession, sang some praise and worship, prayed and did my penance with intention, and surrendered to God and gave him everything. Later that night, our cabin was talking about the day, and we all opened up about our personal and faith struggles. We all prayed for each other, and created goals to achieve when we came back. Even though I didn't achieve everything and still slip back into bad habits and things get hard, that week has changed my faith life forever and I now know what to do when I'm lost or struggling, I go to the Lord.

I am still working and growing in my faith, but by God's grace, I'm slowly starting to learn what it means to submit to Him and live for Him. Even the most holy people have went through hard times in their faith, and struggled with temptation. Especially with Monday's technology, it makes it harder to stay consistent and close with God, and this is why I chose Saint Carlo Acutis as my confirmation saint. He was a computer whiz who built a website in Eucharistic miracles, and he also did normal teen stuff like play video games, play an instrument, and play sports. But, he was disciplined and always put the Lord first in his life. I want to be disciplined with my faith like him and I know I'll never be perfect, but I confidently know that when I fall, the Lord is always there for me and he will pick me up.

Thank you to Father Raphael and Father Edwin for being great priests and parish leaders, the Sisters for religious education, and to my family and everyone at our parish who's helped me grow in my faith. I pray that we will continue to grow closer together to the Lord and that we may grow as a parish and as a community. God Bless!

Me llamo John Hefferly. Voy a empezar el tercer año de preparatoria (high school) y recibí el sacramento de la Confirmación en la Iglesia Católica hace unos meses. Soy el mayor de cuatro hermanos; disfruto de muchos deportes como el fútbol americano, el béisbol, el baloncesto y el hockey, y practico fútbol americano, bolos y atletismo. Nací y crecí en Texas, y vivo aquí en Brenham desde 2013. Me siento bendecido por haber formado parte de esta maravillosa parroquia desde entonces, especialmente ahora que soy un católico confirmado.

Lo que más me gusta de esta parroquia es cuánto me ha ayudado a crecer en mi fe. Ha sido algo muy especial servir como monaguillo durante los últimos 8 años y espero poder seguir haciéndolo. Todos mis maestros de catequesis (CCE) y de preparación para la Confirmación a lo largo de los años han sido muy especiales y me han ayudado enormemente en mi fe. También quisiera agradecer a mi padrino de Confirmación, Mark Asmussen, por estar siempre ahí para mí y ayudarme a crecer en la fe, especialmente en su papel de tío y padrino.

Mi camino de fe no ha sido el más fácil, ni lo será nunca, pero siempre vale la pena y me alegra haber dado los pasos que he dado hasta ahora. Cuando era más joven, no me entusiasmaba ir a misa y nunca prestaba atención; además, la mayor parte de lo que ocurría no tenía mucho sentido para mí. El primer cambio real que experimenté ocurrió en mi clase de catequesis de quinto grado. Mi maestro era el Sr. Don Barnett, y fue un profesor increíble. Él realmente nos ayudó a crecer en nuestra fe, y fue entonces cuando empecé a tomármela en serio. Sin embargo, seguía siendo muy inconstante y casi nunca leía la Biblia, ni rezaba, ni nada por el estilo. Pero a partir del verano entre octavo y noveno grado, mi fe realmente comenzó a crecer. Ese verano asistí a un campamento católico al que ya había ido antes, pero esta vez realmente aprendí algo allí; fue entonces cuando empecé a creer que Jesús está verdaderamente presente en la Eucaristía. No obstante, volví a caer en viejos hábitos e inconsistencias. Aunque no hubo un momento decisivo exacto, durante mi primer año de bachillerato comencé a rezar más y a asistir a misa a diario, o al menos a verla por internet. Al año siguiente, en ese mismo campamento, recuerdo especialmente la adoración del miércoles por la noche; fue la más especial de mi vida. En lugar de aburrirme o distraerme, me arrodillé y recé. Todo lo que tenía en la mente finalmente conectó con mi corazón. Me confesé, canté alabanzas, recé y cumplí mi penitencia con verdadera intención; me entregué a Dios y le ofrecí todo. Más tarde esa noche, en nuestra cabaña conversamos sobre el día y todos nos abrimos sobre nuestras luchas personales y de fe. Oramos unos por otros y nos propusimos metas para alcanzar al regresar. Aunque no logré cumplirlo todo —y a veces recaigo en malos hábitos o las cosas se ponen difíciles—, esa semana cambió mi vida de fe para siempre. Ahora sé qué hacer cuando me siento perdido o en dificultades: acudo al Señor.

Sigo trabajando y creciendo en mi fe, pero por la gracia de Dios, poco a poco voy aprendiendo lo que significa someterme a Él y vivir para Él. Incluso las personas más santas han pasado por momentos difíciles en su fe y han luchado contra la tentación. La tecnología actual hace que sea más difícil mantener la constancia y la cercanía con Dios; por eso elegí a San Carlo Acutis como mi santo de confirmación. Él era un genio de la informática que creó un sitio web sobre milagros eucarísticos, pero también hacía cosas propias de un adolescente normal, como jugar videojuegos, tocar instrumentos y practicar deportes. Sin embargo, era disciplinado y siempre ponía al Señor en primer lugar en su vida. Quiero tener esa misma disciplina en mi fe; sé que nunca seré perfecto, pero tengo la certeza de que, cuando caiga, el Señor siempre estará ahí para levantarme.

Agradezco al Padre Raphael y al Padre Edwin por ser grandes sacerdotes y líderes parroquiales, a las religiosas encargadas de la educación religiosa, y a mi familia y a todos en nuestra parroquia que me han ayudado a crecer en la fe. Rezo para que sigamos acercándonos más al Señor y para que crezcamos como parroquia y como comunidad. ¡Que Dios los bendiga!

## DEACON'S CORNER

In my 23 plus years as an ordained Deacon I have been asked many questions about Faith, why's, what is a Deacon, what are my duties as a Deacon and how much am I paid. I would like to address the question about duties and the definition of the word "duties."

Being a Deacon is not a job, it is a ministry. We are called to serve others as read for the first time from the Acts of the Apostles in Chapter six. St. Stephen and six other Faith filled men were ordained to minister to the widows. A ministry of service to God and others. That was the beginning of the diaconate in our church and our ministry to others has grown abundantly throughout the years.

"In Roman Catholicism, deacons are the link between the church and the world. They are men who, for the most part, are married and hold full-time jobs in the secular world. But they are also ordained clergy who perform every function in the church except consecrating the Eucharist and hearing confessions."

Most Reverend Daniel Garcia, bishop of the Diocese of Austin, has granted to me and all of the Deacons of St. Mary Immaculate Conception the following faculties.

- To Baptize children under the age of seven.
- To distribute the Body and Blood of Christ at Mass and outside of Mass.
- To exercise the office of Deacon in liturgical celebrations.
- To deliver the homily at Mass and to preach at other religious services.
- To preach the Gospel at Mass and to conduct Scripture Services.
- To administer the rite of the sacrament of Matrimony.
- To conduct vigil services at wakes and to preside at a funeral service.

Through all of these faculties we Deacons fulfill the link between the church and the world. You will see us facilitating scripture studies, visiting the sick and homebound, guiding our community in outreach to others, welcoming those who are seeking our Faith, quietly assisting our pastor and many other ways of being a service to our community. The word "job" or "duties" does not enter into our vocabulary.

Our paychecks reflect the true heart of a Deacon. To put to rest the question that I have heard a few times here at this parish is "how much are we paid." We each receive a nice tidy sum of \$0.00. Our paycheck consists of the many blessings we receive as we serve the needs of the church. And the many blessings we have received from God.

### RINCON DEL DIACONO

*En mis más de 23 años como diácono ordenado, me han hecho muchas preguntas sobre la fe, sobre los porqués, sobre qué es un diácono, cuáles son mis deberes como tal y cuánto cobro. Me gustaría abordar la cuestión de los deberes y la definición de la palabra "deberes".*

*Ser diácono no es un trabajo, es un ministerio. Estamos llamados a servir a los demás, tal como se relata por primera vez en el capítulo seis de los Hechos de los Apóstoles. San Esteban y otros seis hombres llenos de fe fueron ordenados para atender a las viudas; un ministerio de servicio a Dios y al prójimo. Ese fue el comienzo del diaconado en nuestra Iglesia, y nuestro ministerio hacia los demás ha crecido abundantemente a lo largo de los años.*

*"En el catolicismo romano, los diáconos son el vínculo entre la Iglesia y el mundo. Son hombres que, en su mayoría, están casados y tienen empleos a tiempo completo en el mundo secular. Pero también son clérigos ordenados que desempeñan todas las funciones en la Iglesia, excepto consagrar la Eucaristía y escuchar confesiones".*

*Monseñor Daniel García, obispo de la Diócesis de Austin, nos ha concedido a mí y a todos los diáconos de la parroquia de Santa María de la Inmaculada Concepción las siguientes facultades:*

- Bautizar a niños menores de siete años.*
- Distribuir el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo durante la Misa y fuera de ella.*
- Ejercer el oficio de diácono en las celebraciones litúrgicas.*
- Pronunciar la homilía en la Misa y predicar en otros servicios religiosos.*
- Proclamar el Evangelio en la Misa y dirigir servicios basados en las Sagradas Escrituras.*
- Administrar el rito del sacramento del Matrimonio.*
- Dirigir servicios de vigilia en los velatorios y presidir las exequias.*

*A través de todas estas facultades, nosotros, los diáconos, cumplimos la función de ser el vínculo entre la Iglesia y el mundo. Nos verán facilitando estudios bíblicos, visitando a los enfermos y a quienes no pueden salir de casa, guiando a nuestra comunidad en la labor de llegar a los demás, acogiendo a quienes buscan nuestra fe, asistiendo discretamente a nuestro párroco y sirviendo a nuestra comunidad de muchas otras maneras. Las palabras "trabajo" o "deberes" no forman parte de nuestro vocabulario.*

*Nuestra remuneración refleja el verdadero corazón de un diácono. Esto sirve para aclarar la pregunta que he escuchado varias veces aquí en la parroquia: "¿cuánto nos pagan?". Cada uno de nosotros recibe una bonita y redonda suma de 0,00 dólares.
