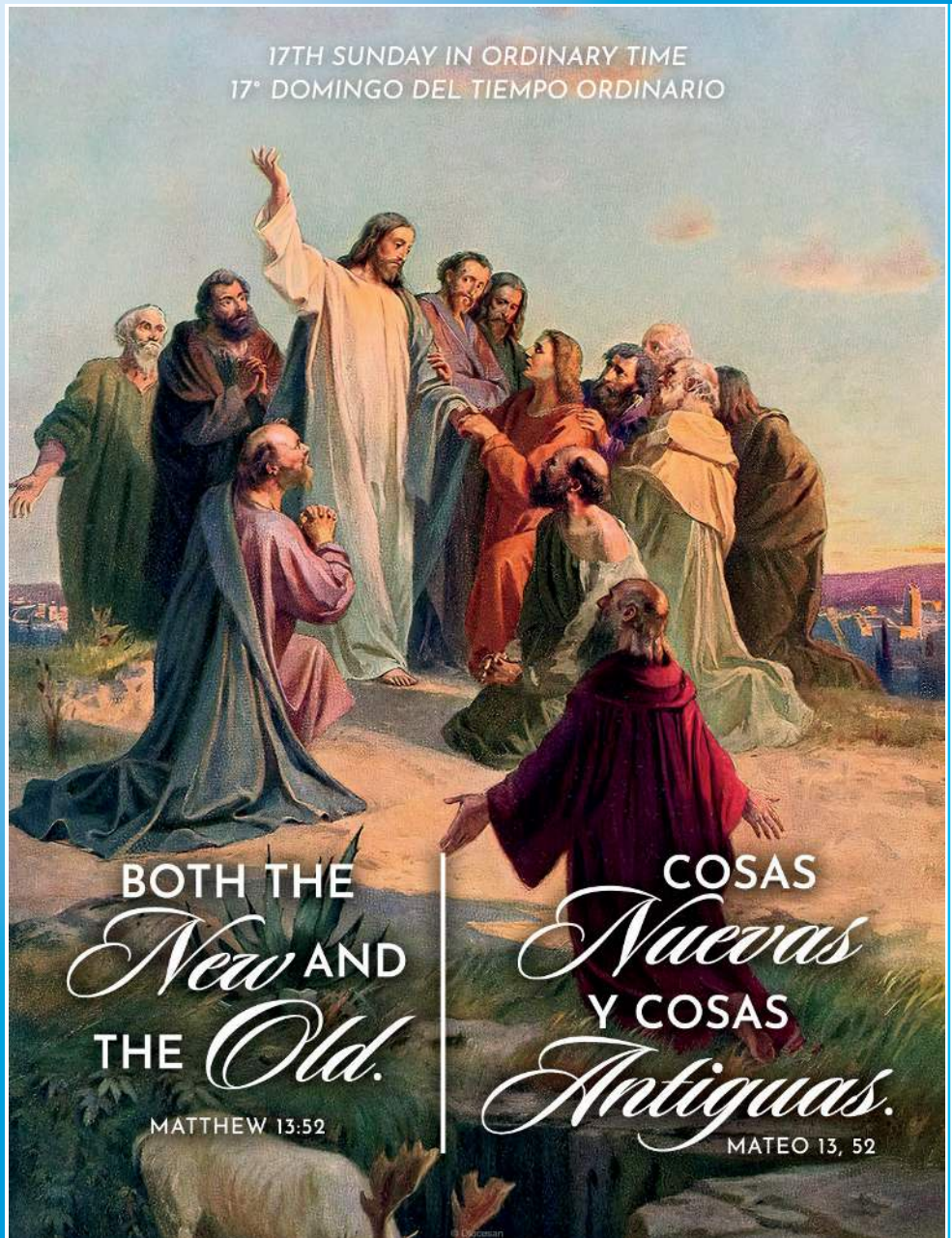

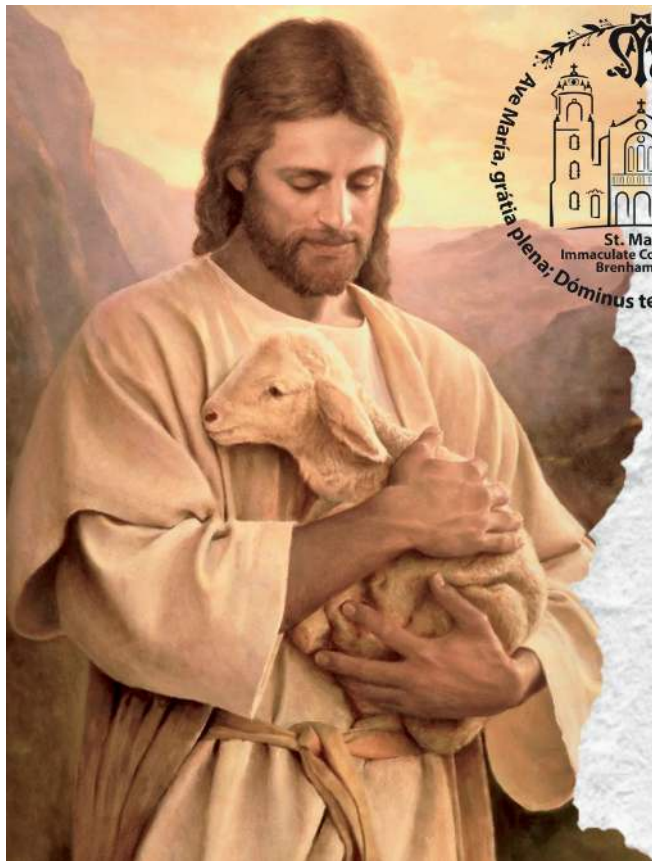

Emergency Response Quick-Guide • Guía Rápida de Emergencia



ACT FAST! • ¡ACTÚE RÁPIDO!



**IN AN EMERGENCY: CALL 911 IMMEDIATELY
EN UNA EMERGENCIA: LLAME AL 911 DE INMEDIATO**

1. CRITICAL ACTIONS

Directing Help: Don't just yell. Point at a specific person:

"YOU, call 911 and come back to tell me when it is done!"

Cardiac Arrest

- **Unresponsive + No Breathing:** Start CPR immediately (100–120 bpm).
- Direct someone to get the AED immediately.

Choking (Conscious)

- **Adults:** Abdominal thrusts (In & Up).
- **Infants (<1 yr):** 5 back slaps / 5 chest thrusts.

2. TRAUMA & FALLS

- **Head / Neck / Back:** **DO NOT MOVE** the person. Wait for EMS.
- **Bleeding:** Apply firm, direct pressure with clean gauze.

3. MEDICAL ISSUES

- **Seizure:** Protect head. Place in recovery position (on side) after shaking stops.
- **Stroke:** Check face droop / speech difficulty. Note the exact time.
- **Allergy:** If trouble breathing, use EpiPen (outer thigh).

1. ACCIONES CRÍTICAS

Pedir Ayuda: No solo grite. Señale a alguien directamente:

"¡USTED, llame al 911 y regrese a decirme cuando lo haya hecho!"

Paro Cardíaco

- **Inconsciente + No respira:** Inicie RCP de inmediato (100–120 bpm).
- Ordene a alguien que traiga el DEA de inmediato.

Atragantamiento (Despierto)

- **Adultos:** Compresiones abdominales (Hacia adentro y arriba).
- **Bebés (<1 año):** 5 golpes en la espalda / 5 compresiones en el pecho.

2. TRAUMATISMOS Y CAÍDAS

- **Cabeza / Cuello / Espalda:** **NO MUEVA** a la persona. Espere a la ambulancia.
- **Sangrado:** Presión firme y directa con gasa limpia.

3. PROBLEMAS MÉDICOS

- **Convulsión:** Proteja la cabeza. Ponga de lado (posición de recuperación) al terminar.
- **Infarto Cerebral:** Revise asimetría facial / habla. Anote la hora exacta.
- **Alergia:** Si hay asma o hinchazón severa, use EpiPen (muslo externo).

DEACON'S CORNER

Truth and Wisdom

In our first reading this week, we have King Solomon asking God for an “understanding heart”, so that he can govern his people wisely. God approves his request and even today, the name of King Solomon is synonymous with wisdom. But what is wisdom? What is it that wisdom is able to discern, that we value it so highly? Is it not simply the ability to determine what is true, and what isn't?

Many voices today, even voices in our great institutions of higher education, loudly proclaim that there is no objective truth. That everything is relative and each of us decides for ourselves what is true. This idea is the work of the evil one and indeed, is the very first temptation in the Bible that led to the downfall of man. The serpent comes to Eve and tells her that if she eats the fruit of the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil, she will be like God. She will be the one to decide what is true.

Our faith lets us know that God exists and that He is the source of all truth. Our God does not change and therefore, neither does His truth. When we try to subordinate God's truth to our own opinions, we don't change the nature of God, we don't change the world, and we don't change what is true. All we do is deceive ourselves, just as the father of lies desires and by blinding ourselves to the truth we remain in darkness.

Wisdom is the gift of the Holy Spirit that allows us to know what is true. Wisdom allows us to see what is truly beautiful. Wisdom allows us to choose what is good and reject what is evil. By guiding us to what is good, beautiful and true, wisdom leads us inevitably to God. Therefore, it would be pleasing to God if each day you were, like Solomon, to pray for the gift of an understanding heart, so that, girded with the gift of wisdom, no one will lead you astray.

RINCON DEL DIACONO

La verdad y la sabiduría

En nuestra primera lectura de esta semana, vemos al rey Salomón pidiendo a Dios un «corazón comprensivo» para poder gobernar a su pueblo con sabiduría. Dios aprueba su petición y, aún hoy, el nombre del rey Salomón es sinónimo de sabiduría. Pero, ¿qué es la sabiduría? ¿Qué es aquello que la sabiduría es capaz de discernir para que la valoremos tanto? ¿No es acaso, sencillamente, la capacidad de determinar qué es verdad y qué no lo es?

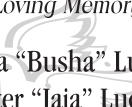
Hoy en día, muchas voces —incluso voces en nuestras grandes instituciones de educación superior— proclaman con fuerza que no existe una verdad objetiva; que todo es relativo y que cada uno de nosotros decide por sí mismo qué es verdad. Esta idea es obra del maligno y, de hecho, es la primera tentación que aparece en la Biblia y que condujo a la caída del hombre. La serpiente se acerca a Eva y le dice que, si come del fruto del árbol del conocimiento del bien y del mal, será como Dios. Ella será quien decida qué es verdad.

Nuestra fe nos hace saber que Dios existe y que Él es la fuente de toda verdad. Nuestro Dios no cambia y, por tanto, tampoco cambia su verdad. Cuando intentamos subordinar la verdad de Dios a nuestras propias opiniones, no cambiamos la naturaleza de Dios, no cambiamos el mundo ni cambiamos lo que es verdad. Lo único que hacemos es engañarnos a nosotros mismos —tal como desea el padre de la mentira— y, al cegarnos ante la verdad, permanecemos en las tinieblas.

La sabiduría es el don del Espíritu Santo que nos permite conocer la verdad. La sabiduría nos permite ver lo que es verdaderamente bello. La sabiduría nos permite elegir el bien y rechazar el mal. Al guiarnos hacia lo bueno, lo bello y lo verdadero, la sabiduría nos conduce inevitablemente a Dios. Por ello, sería grato a los ojos de Dios que cada día pidieras, como Salomón, el don de un corazón comprensivo para que, revestido del don de la sabiduría, nadie te extravíe.
