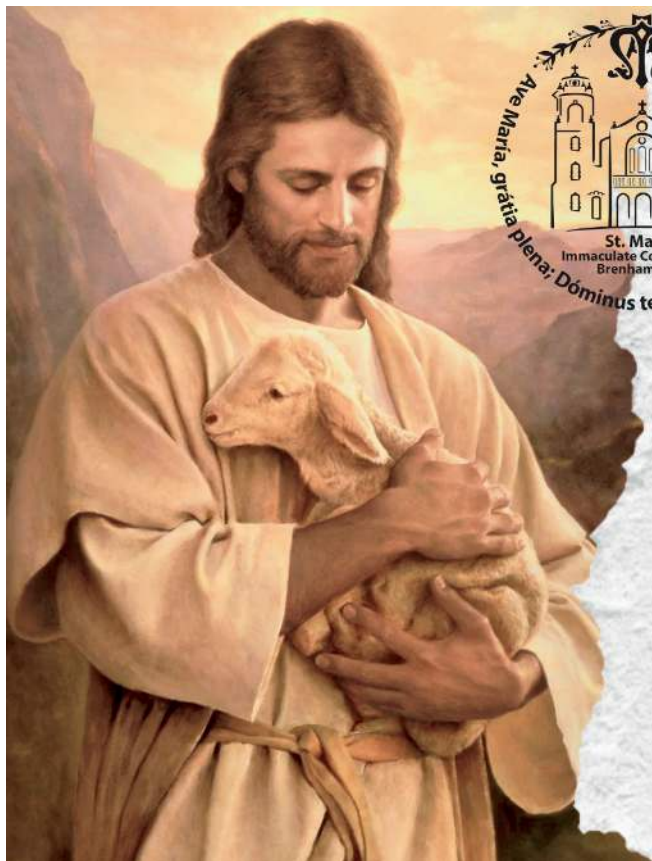

ST. THÉRÈSE OF LISIEUX

St. Thérèse of Lisieux was a young French woman who loved Jesus very much. She was born in 1873 and became a Carmelite nun when she was only 15 years old.

Thérèse believed that we don't have to do big, amazing things to become holy. Instead, we can show our love for God through small things done with great love—like being kind, helping others, praying, and being patient. She called this her “Little Way.”

Thérèse died when she was only 24 years old, but her simple life of love inspired people all over the world.

She is also known as “The Little Flower.”

A lesson from St. Thérèse: *Even the smallest act of kindness can be a beautiful gift to God when we do it with love.*



SANTA TERESITA DEL NIÑO JESUS

Santa Teresita de Lisieux fue una joven francesa que amaba profundamente a Jesús. Nació en 1873 y se hizo monja carmelita cuando tenía solo 15 años.

Teresita creía que no hace falta realizar grandes y extraordinarias hazañas para alcanzar la santidad. En cambio, podemos demostrar nuestro amor a Dios a través de pequeñas acciones hechas con gran amor, como ser amables, ayudar a los demás, orar y tener paciencia. Ella llamó a esto su «Caminito».

Teresita falleció cuando tenía apenas 24 años, pero su vida sencilla y llena de amor inspiró a personas de todo el mundo.

También se la conoce como «La Pequeña Flor».

Una enseñanza de Santa Teresita: hasta el acto de bondad más pequeño puede ser un hermoso regalo para Dios cuando lo hacemos con amor.

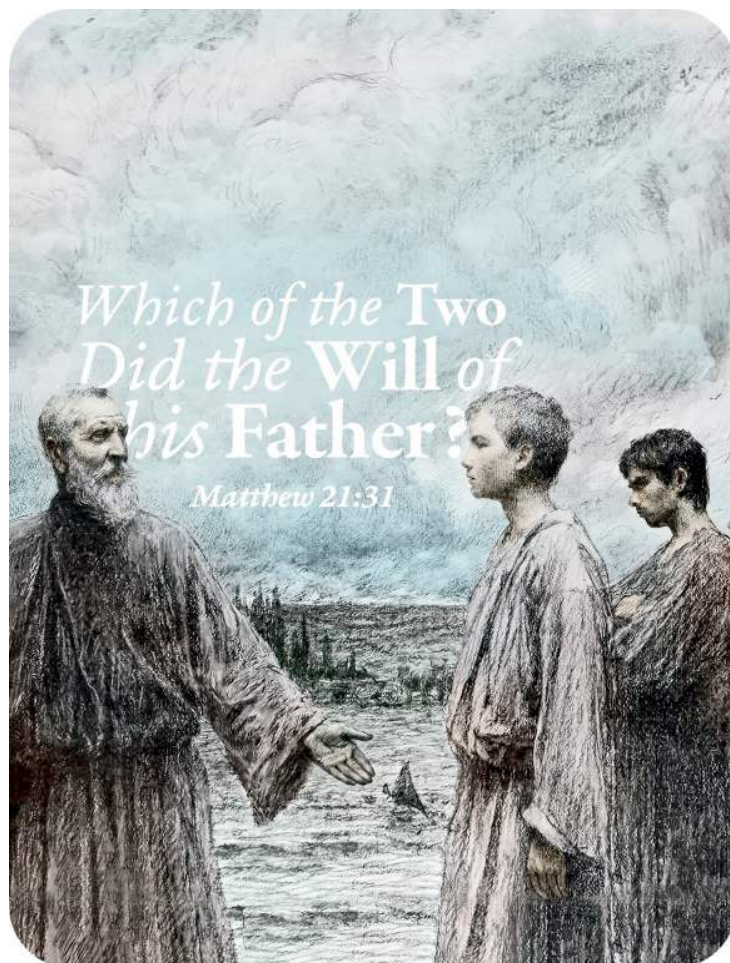

DEACON'S CORNER

This Sunday we are treated to one of the most beautiful passages about Jesus in the entire Bible. It is found in the Letter of St. Paul to the Philippians. St. Paul begins by telling the people to be kind, and loving, and merciful to each other. They, we, are to put the interests of others above ourselves. And then he tells us about Jesus. He says that we should have the same attitude in life as Jesus had. He was forever God, but he did not regard this as something to be grasped. Instead, He emptied Himself of his divinity. He became a human being. More than this, he became a slave for all of us. And he obeyed His Father for our sakes, even when this obedience led to His death on the cross.

“Be like Him,” St. Paul says in the first reading. “Serve others. Stop being selfish. Look at others as more important than yourself.” This is difficult. We would like to think that the world revolves around us and our wants. But it does not. The world is the Lord’s.

With the Grace of God, we can do the work of God. But this is work, and work is hard. Work takes time and strength. Work means exhausting ourselves to be understanding, in your case, of your husband or wife, your children, your parents. In my case, the people God calls me to serve. Doing the work of the Lord means emptying ourselves.

It also means doing everything we can to stay away from all that could hurt us. It takes work to control that temper. It takes work to be spiritual in our homes. It takes work to turn a house into a place of prayer, a little Church. This is the work of Jesus, who humbled Himself for others, for us.

What is the reality of Jesus in your lives, in my life? How real is He to you? Can we all realize that through the Grace of God, Jesus’ presence is stronger and His Life is more meaningful now than ever before? This is not a matter of feeling, it is a matter of recognizing reality. Everything is for Jesus. Everything that matters in the world flows from Him and leads to Him.

He is ours. And we are His. We pray today for the courage to serve the Father as He served Him, emptying ourselves of our selfishness, humbling ourselves before our God, loving Him until the day that we are totally united to our Tremendous Lover.

RINCON DEL DIACONO

Este domingo se nos presenta uno de los pasajes más hermosos sobre Jesús en toda la Biblia. Se encuentra en la Carta de San Pablo a los Filipenses. San Pablo comienza exhortando a la gente a ser amable, cariñosa y misericordiosa los unos con los otros. Ellos —y nosotros— debemos anteponer los intereses de los demás a los nuestros. Y luego nos habla de Jesús. Dice que debemos tener la misma actitud ante la vida que tuvo Jesús. Él era Dios desde siempre, pero no consideró esto como algo a lo que aferrarse. En cambio, se despojó de su divinidad. Se hizo ser humano. Más aún, se hizo esclavo por todos nosotros. Y obedeció a su Padre por nuestro bien, incluso cuando esa obediencia lo llevó a la muerte en la cruz.

«Sean como Él», dice San Pablo en la primera lectura. «Sirvan a los demás. Dejen de ser egoístas. Consideren a los demás más importantes que a ustedes mismos». Esto es difícil. Nos gustaría pensar que el mundo gira en torno a nosotros y a nuestros deseos. Pero no es así. El mundo pertenece al Señor.

Con la gracia de Dios, podemos realizar la obra de Dios. Pero esto es trabajo, y el trabajo es arduo. El trabajo requiere tiempo y fortaleza. Trabajar implica esforzarse al máximo por comprender —en su caso— a su esposo o esposa, a sus hijos, a sus padres; y en mi caso, a las personas a las que Dios me llama a servir. Hacer la obra del Señor significa vaciarnos de nosotros mismos.

También significa hacer todo lo posible por alejarnos de aquello que pueda hacernos daño. Cuesta esfuerzo controlar el mal genio. Cuesta esfuerzo vivir la espiritualidad en nuestros hogares. Cuesta esfuerzo convertir una casa en un lugar de oración, en una pequeña iglesia. Esta es la obra de Jesús, quien se humilló por los demás, por nosotros.

¿Cuál es la realidad de Jesús en sus vidas, en mi vida? ¿Cuán real es Él para ustedes? ¿Podemos todos comprender que, gracias a la gracia de Dios, la presencia de Jesús es más fuerte y su vida cobra más sentido ahora que nunca? No se trata de sentimientos, sino de reconocer la realidad. Todo es para Jesús. Todo lo que importa en el mundo brota de Él y conduce a Él.

*Él es nuestro. Y nosotros somos suyos. Hoy oramos por la valentía de servir al Padre como Él le sirvió, despojándonos de nuestro egoísmo, humillándonos ante nuestro Dios y amándole hasta el día en que estemos totalmente unidos a nuestro Grandioso Amante. **Diacono Al***
